DX INFORMATION

3B6 - Rachid, 3B8FQ has received a license for 3B6, and will activate the Agalega Islands (AF-001) for 48-72 hours between 14 and 17 April. This will be a working trip. Time will be shared with maintenance duties on the island, but Rachid will be as active as possible when not on duty. He will operate as 3B6FQ primarily on SSB, with some CW, on 10-80 metres. Operations are expected to begin around 18.30 UTC on 14 April. Equipment will be battery powered at 70W, with simple antennas. QSL via K5XK. [TNX K5XK]
