DX INFORMATION

3B7 - Rachid, 3B8FQ, is planning to operate as 3B7FQ from St. Brandon in October (dates to be determined). This will be a working trip, with on-air activities shared with meteorological maintenance duties. QSL via K5XK. Further information is expected in due course.

3DA - David, G14FUM (E14DJ) will be operating from Swaziland as 3DA0DJ on 17-27 October. He was a member of the IRTS DXpedition to Swaziland in March 2007; this year he will be with Daniel, ZS6JR and they will be using the same equipment and antennas that were used for the CQ WPX SSB operation last year (3DA0EI). David and Daniel will also operate as 3DA0JOTA for the annual Jamboree On The Air (18-19 October). Activity will be on all HF bands SSB. [TNX G14FUM]

3V - Dmitry, RW4WM will be active as 3V8SS from Sousse, Tunisia between 29 September and 8 October. He plans to operate CW and SSB, with some RTTY. QSL for this operation via RW4WM, direct or bureau. [TNX RW4WM]

I | Kenth Johansson, SM6DYK passed away on 26 August at 62 years of age. A well known DXer, he was the SK6M Contest Team leader.

I | Theo See, DJ1RL passed away on 5 September at 80 years of age. A well-known CW operator, with a main interest in 160 and 80 metres, between the early Seventies and the late Nineties he operated from several DX locations (3D2, 5R, 9J, C2, C21, C56, FH, FO, ZK1 and others).

I | Other recently reported Silent Keys include Thomas M. Rose, K0ZM (ex KC0EI), Victor A. Ohrimenko (UA1QBH), Ivan Sesartic, YU1BQ, one of Serbia's veteran operators and a pioneer in ARDF, and Ramon Morales Castro (CO7RM). Ramon was only 58 years old, and died of a massive heart attack. CO7PH says he had been licenced for more than forty years, and was a skilful CW operator.

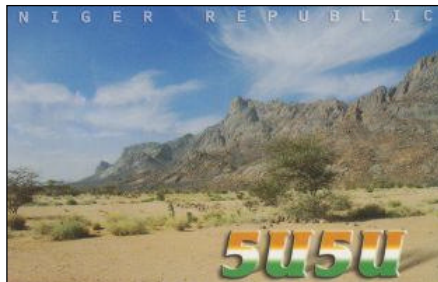

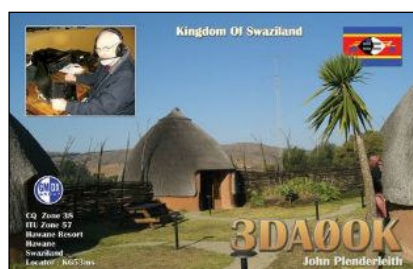
