DX INFORMATION

3A - Andrea, IZ2LSC will be active as 3A/IZ2LSC from Monaco on 30 April and 1 May. He will be running 100 watts into a multiband vertical antenna, with planned activity on 40-10 metres SSB and QRS CW. QSL via home call (bureau preferred) and LoTW.



3A - Special callsign 3A2CWG will be in use on 1-31 May to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Monaco Telegraphy Group (3A-CW-G). QSL via 3A2LF.

3D2_cr - The 3D2C activity from Conway Reef [425DXN 1007] is now planned to take place on 1-6 October. However, the team is considering going to Rotuma instead. They already have the callsign 3D2R and are working on getting a landing permit. Bookmark www.yt1ad.info/3d2c/index.html for updates.

4J - YL2GM will be active as 4K3AC from Azerbaijan from 25 April to 3 May. He will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on all bands with 100 watts. QSL via YL2GM. [TNX NG3K]

4J - Special callsign 4JV3AM will be in use on 4-20 May to celebrate the 66th anniversary of the end of World War II and honour Azerbaijani hero Mamish Abdullayev. QSL via RW6HS (direct only). [TNX RW6HS]

4W - 4W6A is the callsign to be used from **Atauro Island (OC-232)**, Timor-Leste on 16-26 September [425DXN 1032]. Steve 9M6DXX, John 9M6XRO, Tim M0URX, Ant MW0JZE, Oliver VK8DX and Stuart VK8NSB will operate SSB, CW and RTTY on 10-160 metres with four stations. This is not specifically an IOTA DXpedition, rather it is a DXCC DXpedition that happens to be from a rare IOTA group and the team will try "to give amateurs around the world a new DXCC band-mode counter on as many bands as possible". For instance, MD0ABC (Isle of Man), MI0ABC (Northern Ireland), MJ0ABC (Jersey), MM0ABC (Scotland), MU0ABC (Guernsey), MW0ABC (Wales) and M0ABC (England) may all be amended to MR0ABC. RUSSIA JOINS CEPT ● The Russian State Radio Frequencies Commission decided on 10 March 2011 that the Russian Federation shall join CEPT Recommendation T/R 61-01 and ECC Recommendation (05)06 (CEPT Novice), thus making it possible for every CEPT License holder to operate on the territory of the Russian Federation, within a limit of three months, without any additional permission. MT. ATHOS VISIT

I have just returned from my 2 week visit to Greece and pilgrimage to Mt. Athos. From the minute that I stepped off the plane in Athens to the minute that I left Greece two weeks later I was treated with true "ham hospitality" by SV1JG, SV2ASP/A and SV2BOH.

Monk Apollo, SV2ASP/A greeted me with open arms in Mt. Athos. He spent the entire week making sure that I was comfortable. I participated in all of their church prayer services and I was also able to work for 2 long days with the monks cleaning crystal and silver chandeliers in preparation for Easter services. Monk Apollo gave me the keys to his Land Rover and told me to, "go...explore...take your time". I was able to visit many of the 20 monasteries on the peninsula.

I was able to make a donation of various pieces of radio equipment to his monastery which will allow him to operate from two or more portable hilltop locations in Mt. Athos. SEMDXA members provided him with a new MFJ Keyer, LDG antenna tuner and a Heil BM-10 headset. Budd, W3FF and his son Chris donated a complete Buddipole Antenna system. The ARRL donated 8 log books, band plan charts and a backpack for the portable equipment transportation. Monk Apollo never asked for anything. I simply showed up with the gifts for the monastery. Asian hams will soon be able to work Mt. Athos for a new DXCC Entity. Both portable locations have clear 360 degree views to all directions unlike the Docheiariou Monastery which has a large mountain blocking signals to and from Asia.

Father Apollo is a very busy monk. His radio time is limited because of church services that last up to 8 hours per day, 7 days per week. After services he is busy working on construction projects for the monastery. He is presently active on the radio daily between 1700-2100z on 160m, 30m, 17m and 12m CW-SSB-RTTY. He is building a new ham shack which will be ready in a few months. Once he is in the new QTH he will install his new 40 foot tubular tower and a Step-IR 3 element yagi that was donated to him by Dominik, DL5EBE.

The most exciting part of my trip was to be able to see precious relics of Saints and the Miracle producing Icons of The Virgin Mary. Mt. Athos is by far one of the most beautiful places on Earth.

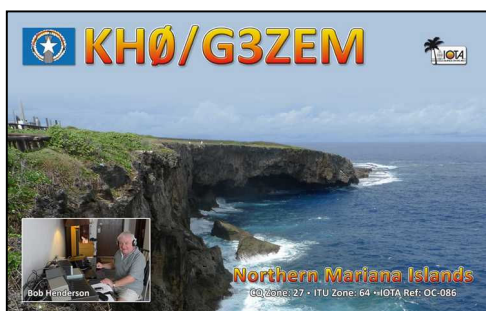
