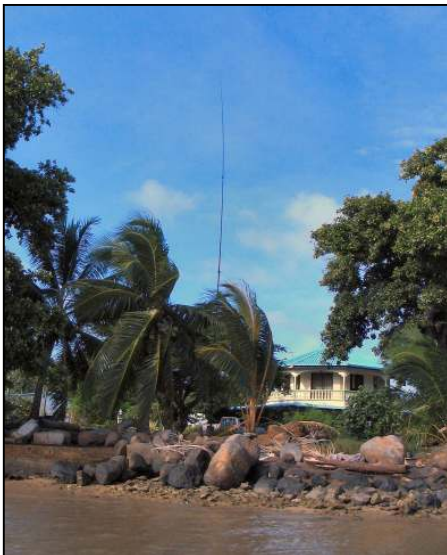

DX INFORMATION



3C0 - Elmo, EA5BYP and Javier, EA5KM have announced the dates for their activities from Equatorial Guinea and Annobon [425DXN 1082]. They will leave Spain on 21 February, and be active as 3C6A from Malabo (Bioko Island, AF-010) on 22-26 February. On the 27th they will depart for Annobon Island (AF-039), where

they will be QRV as 3C0E from 28 February to 11 March. They plan to operate CW, SSB and RTTY on 160-6 metres. QSL for both callsigns direct to EA5BYP. The log will be uploaded to LoTW "a few months after the DXpedition". The website for the expedition is at www.gdgdxc.net/3c0e/ for updates. [TNX EA5BYP]



3DA - Phil, G3SWH and John, EA5ARC (G3OLU) will be active as 3DA0PW from Swaziland on 21-29 February [425DXN 1078]. They will operate CW only on 80-10 metres with two stations. There will be no 160, 60, 6 metres or EME activity.

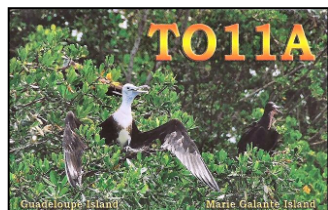
E5_sc - John, N5JB plans to be active as E51NJB from Rarotonga (OC-013), South Cook Islands on 13-21

The activity honours the memory of the ship's chief wireless operator, Jack Phillips, born and bred in Godalming, whose Morse distress messages

led to the saving of hundreds of lives. The callsign's suffix letters MGY were the Titanic's radio callsign back in 1912, while the prefix stands for Godalming Remembers. Two 400-watt stations will be on the air on 80-10 metres CW; SSB will be used on 14 and 15 April, when the station is open to the public (from noon to 4pm). 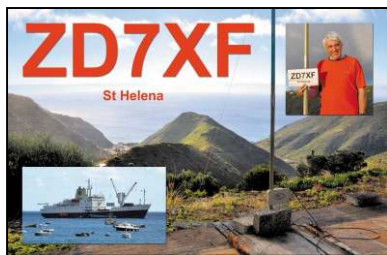

Administratively at HQ, we will not make the necessary changes to the DXCC system until after the final data processing for 2011 is complete - this includes the tables shown in Logbook of The World. DXCC members will see their current entity totals drop by one on their Mixed awards, and on the bands and modes where MVI credit is given. They will also see their DXCC Challenge totals drop commensurately".

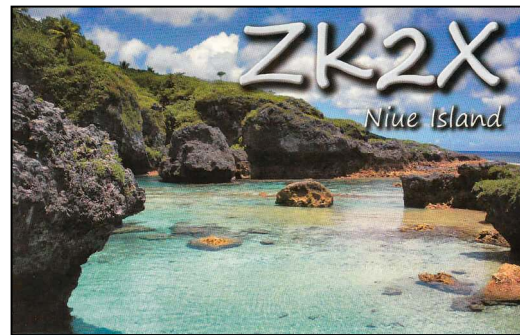
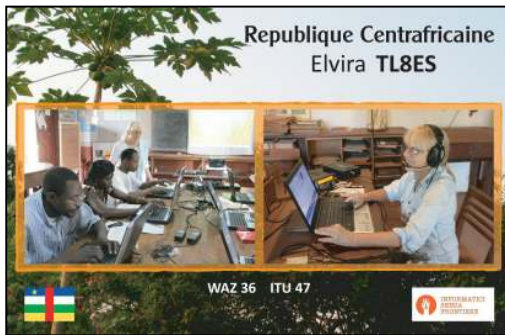

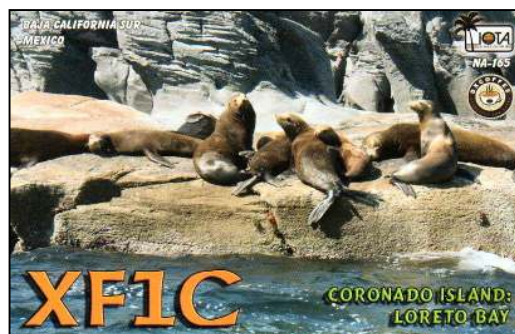
