The callsign has not been assigned yet, but they expect to be issued with either 3D2P or 3D20R, with 3D2A/R as an alternative. Current operators include VK4AN, 3D2DD and VK4FW; they are seeking expressions of interest from experienced CW, SSB and digital operators and possibly a 6m enthusiast. [TNX DX World]
