The station will be active some days before the Contest and the special CQ2C will probably be used. Operators: Pedro (CT1DNF), Jose (CT1EEB), Miguel (CT1ENQ), Luis (CT1ESO) Ruben (CT1ETZ), Rui (CT1FAK), Pedro (CT1FDR), Celestino (CT1ASU) and Rui (CT1ERY). - VP8_ant- Steve, VP8CQC, is active from the British antarctic base Faraday (WABA G-04) and he is often QRV on 20 mtrs around 14280/290 KHz. QSL via: Steve Cuthbertson, c/o Faraday Base, Via Port Stanley, Falkland Is., U.K.
- VP8_ssh- Andy, VP8CQS, from South Shetland Islands, is active on 40 meters, both in CW and SSB. He has been heard with good signals on 7004 Khz about 2100Z and on 7050 KHz about 2145Z. QSL via DL1EHH.
- VP9 Until 26 July, G3AVJ/VP9 will be active on 14133 KHz (+/- QRM) during evenings and early mornings.

Meanwhile, there are many doubts about the validations of activities in CW and cross-mode SSB/CW on list, as VU2JPS passes only the report (59 or 599) without repeating the call of the station in QSO leaving that OM in the doubt if the report was really sent him and also if VU2JPS has correctly written the call in the log. Many stations have been heard repeating the call during the QSO, without receiving any kind of confirmation.
- W4 Alan, K4GLU, lives in Chincoteague Isl. (NA-083) and wants to be active particularly on WARC and in CW. Alan plans to join the IOTA Contest, mainly in CW. QSL via bureau (excepts for U.S. stations from which he prefers direct requests to his new address: Alan Merriman, P.O.Box 734, Chincoteague, VA 23336-0734, U.S.A.).
- XT Ed, XT2CH, from Burkina Faso, has been hear on 14160 KHz around 1945Z. QSL via XT2CH op. Ed, c/o American Embassy Burkina Faso, Department of State, Washington, DC 20521-2440.
- Krane, YT1AD reports that 3V8AA QSL (he is the manager) will be ready to be sent from the second half of July.
- Following what published in previous number UT2UA, UT3UY, UT3UX and UX4UM are in Lybia until 24 July, when they plan to back in Kiev. It's an official visit on a local Bureau of Communications invitation. They want to found a Radio Club then they are sure to have the licences, with the 5A3UY and 5A2UA calls. The expedition costs ws covered by the operators, using also bank loans, and now they hope to receive helps from International DX community, but only after the operations and the validation by DXCC desk; in this case QSL will be handled by INDEXA, personally by W4FRU.
- 9N Satish, 9N1AA (who is now active in Pactor, Baudot and Amtor) and Richard, 9N1ARB (an American working with U.N. and who will remain in Nepal for about 5 years) want to build a club station with the late Father Moran's call, 9N1MM. They hope to activate the club station from September.

DXAC VOTATIONS -> The ARRL DX Advisory Committee (DXAC) voted 15 to 1 to suspend further study of the status on Aruba until the Netherlands and Aruba

have announced a change in the current move towards independence for Aruba originally slated for 1996. In the same ballot the DXAC voted 9 to 7 against recommending the addition of Scarborough Reef to the DXCC countries List. Those who voted against the recommendation cited membership opinion within their respective divisions. Some went on to state an opinion that the rocks that comprise the reef do not constitute islands, and for that reason no operation from the reef can be considered ''land based.'' Those who voted in favor felt that Scarborough Reef meets the criteria that were in effect at the time the petition was received. Several cited membership opinion in their divisions. In membership correspondence to the entire DXAC 157 persons (72) were against adding Scarborough and 61 were in support of new country status. DXAC Chair Garth Hamilton, VE3HO, stated, "The Minimum-Size Rule was not applied to this petition. DXAC members made a judgment in accordance with the DX communities they represent."

DXCC: P5 ADDED -> The ARRL DXCC Desk announced that documentation for P5/OH2AM has been approved. In accordance with a news release dated July 16 1991, North Korea (Democratic People's Republic of Korea) will now be added to the DXCC Countries List. The DXCC Desk will accept QSL cards for this new country starting October 1, 1995. QSL cards received at the DXCC Desk before October 1, 1995 will be returned without action.

LU -> Sante, IKOHBN, reports that he his receiving many requests for Argentinian stations LU8DFH and LU8DZJ. Unfortunately IKOHBN is not the QSL manager for these stations and therefore Sante, who always sents back the requests at his own expenses, asks to verify the correct QSL routes.

F6KEQ -> Didier (F5OGL/S92AA/TR8GL), Director of the F6KEQ Radio Club, reports that the Club is handling QSL for the following stations: TZ6FIC (only for QSO after 1 January 1993), FM5FM (from 1991), TM5FER (1994) and TM0TRS (1995). Didier reports also that Radio Club can manage QSLs also for other stations as the Club works with three 486DX computers to handle logs that can be received from DX stations in different ways (i.e. FM5FM logs are received via packet).
