THAILAND I John, HS1CHB is co-ordinating with the National Telecommunications Commission on impending permission to operate on the WARC bands and low-bands on a temporary basis until the end of the year [425DXN 788]. His latest progress report is not encouraging. Apparently, officials now say that they need to wait for the National Broadcasting Commission to be formed before they can do this. In the meantime the low bands may be activated during contests on weekends as before. [TNX G4UZN/HSOZGH]

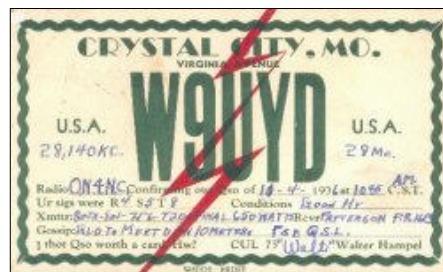

THE WAY WE WERE

A selection of information published by 425DXN in September 1996

5X – Peter, ON6TT will be active again (also on 160 and 80 metres) from Uganda as 5X1T starting on 7 September. QSL via ON5NT. He will go QRT for three months starting from 1 December to join the DXpedition to Heard Island.

9Q – Fernando, EA4BB will be active again (SSB and CW) as 9Q5BB from Zaire starting 9 September for one year. QSL via W3HMK.

A3 – Paul, A35RK has been QRT for a couple of weeks, but now he is active again on 40-15 metres CW and RTTY from Nuku'alofa (OC-049). In two or three weeks Paul will be relocating on Lifuka Island (OC-169), and he should be active starting around 1 October on 80-10 metres. QSL via W7TSQ.

D2 – Alex, PA3DZN expects to be active as D25L from Angola for at least six months starting around mid-October. Alex expects to emphasize operation on 80 and 160 metres, as well as RTTY, in addition to the usual extensive use of CW on all other bands. QSL via PA3DMH.

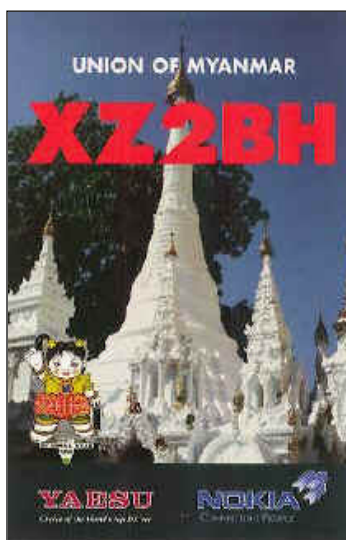
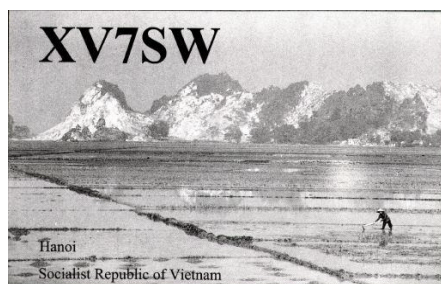
XV – Rolf, SM5MX/XV7SW is presently on leave in Sweden, but he expects to be on the air again from Hanoi some time in October. He operates CW only and this winter he will give priority to 160, 80 and 40 metres. Rolf is restricted to operating on certain fixed frequencies, for which he pays considerable annual fee: 1827, 3506, 7007, 14016, 14021, 21016, 21019, 28016 and 28019 kHz. QSL direct or via SM3CXS. Rolf says that to the best of his knowledge there are now five licenced stations: 3W5FM, 3W5RS, 3W6AR, XV7SW and XV7TH (XV1A is a pirate, most likely far from Vietnam). "Amateur radio in the sense we know it does not exist in Vietnam", he says, "and the above licensees should be seen as exceptions, pending the introduction of a fresh set of Regulations for Amateur Radio".

XZ - A group of operators from the Central Arizona DX Association (AA7WP, AB6ZV, K5VT, KA5AYR, KF7AY, N6BT, N7WTU, OH1NYP, OH2BH, WA6CDR, WA7LNW and WY7K) will be active as XZ1N from Yangon, Myanmar on 16-25

November. This activity has the approval of the Myanmar government at the highest levels and will conclude with a special multi-multi entry in the CQ WW DX CW Contest. Operations will take place

on the usual DX calling frequencies; the main mode will be CW, but there will also be extensive RTTY and SSB activity. A concentrated effort will be made on 40, 80 and 160 metres with special antennas and adequate power. QSL via W1XT, direct or bureau. In preparation for this large scale operation, Martti (OH2BH) will be visiting Myanmar on 21-22 September; expect XZ2BH to be sporadically active on several bands, including the Scandinavian Activity Contest.

ZS – A team including Barry/ZS1FJ, ZS1B, ZS1JM, ZS1X, ZS1LVH and possibly others will operate CW and SSB as ZS23I from Seal Island in the Cape Province South Coast group (AF-NEW) on 17-23 October. QSL via ZS1FJ.

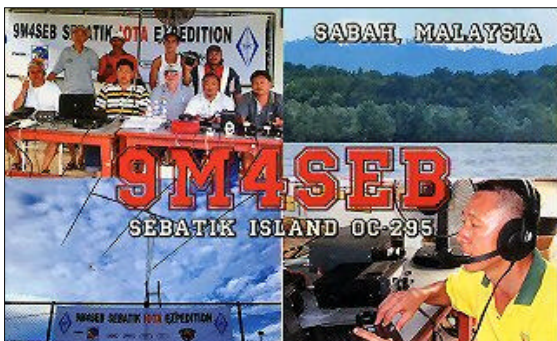
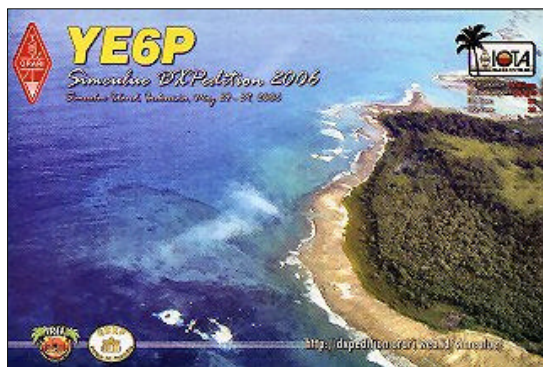
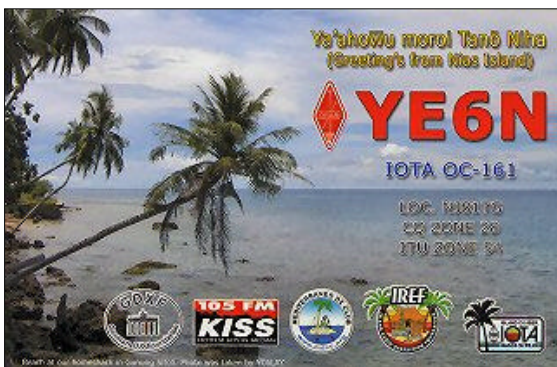
