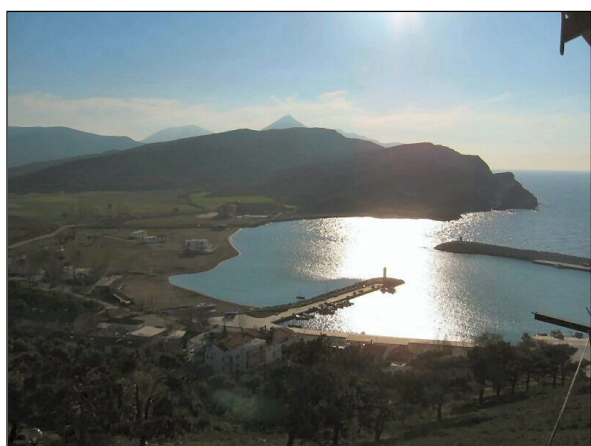

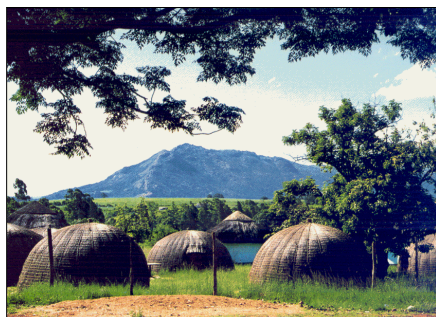

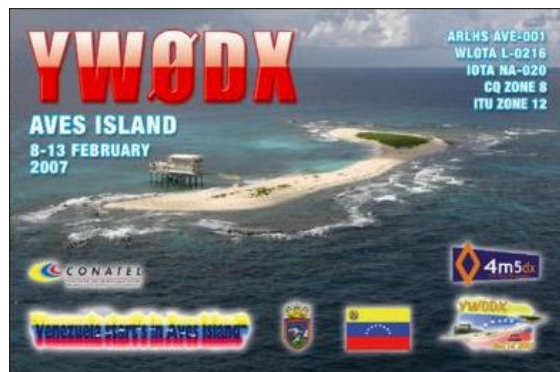

The current minimum requirement for Honor Roll is 328 current entities (deleted entities do not count towards this level).
