DX INFORMATION

3B8 - Ray, HB9DNG/F5UKV is moving to Mauritius Island (AF-049) and will be QRV as 3B8HH starting around 20 January. Activity will be on 80-2 metres (possibly 160m) using CW and some SSB. When the station is completely installed, he will operate also some PSK and RTTY. QSL via 3B8HH, direct or bureau; he will upload his log to Club Log. [TNX The Daily DX]

3B8 - Simon Luttrell (ex-XW0LP) had moved to the Turkish coast of Fethiye [425DXN 1598], but «the cold weather created a lot of problems for my lungs, and I had to quickly look for a new and hot country to call home», he posted to eHam.net on 10 January. He has now left Turkey and relocated to «sunny Mauritius. I have rented a nice house with a big garden, and hope to be on the air in the next month or so with my 3B8 callsign. Especially, I hope to do some low band DXing».



3X - Jean-Philippe, F1TMY has been QRV as 3X2021 from Guinea since 16 October 2021. He has announced on Twitter (<https://twitter.com/3X2021>) that he «will try to be active as 3X2021/p» from the Los Islands (AF-051) during the 22-23 January weekend. He plans to operate «mostly FT4». QSL via Club Log.

5B - Philipp, DK6SP has joined the Erasmus Programme (the European Union Action Scheme for the Mobility of University Students) and is spending a semester in Cyprus. In his spare time he will be active as 5B4AQC until 27 July. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via DK6SP.

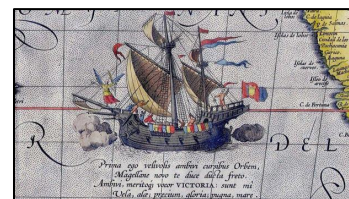

G - Special event station GB4LWS will be active on 22-23 January from the Marconi Museum at Bass Point. The suffix stands for Guglielmo Marconi's Lizard Wireless Station, the site of the first over-the-horizon wireless transmission (23 January 1901). QSL via eQSL only. [TNX The Daily DX]

G - Special event stations GB1900HA (operated by M0MNE) and GB1900HW (operated by M0TKF) will be active between 24



January and 23 December for the 1900th anniversary since the beginning of the construction of Hadrian's Wall (<https://1900.hadrianswallcountry.co.uk/>). QSLs via Club Log's OQRS and LoTW. A former defensive fortification which marked the boundary between Roman Britannia and unconquered Caledonia to the north, Hadrian's Wall is the largest Roman archaeological feature in Britain, and has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site List since 1987.

GM - Special event station GB2KW will be active on 1-28 January from near Inverness, Scotland using vintage equipment manufactured by KW Electronics Ltd during the 1960s and 1970s. 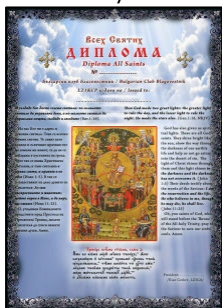

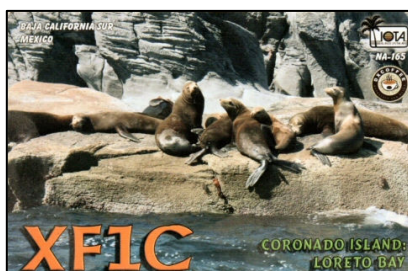

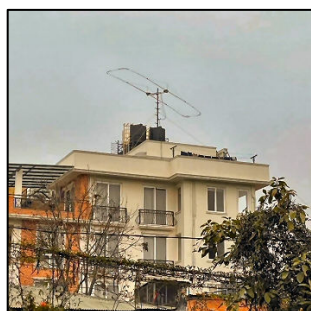

The PRIMNM includes the current DXCC Entities of Baker & Howland (KH1), Johnston (KH3), Palmyra & Jarvis (KH5) and Wake (KH9). The *Permit system for allowable public activities* is listed among the «preliminary issues, concerns, and opportunities that may be addressed in the MMP», and for which NOAA and USFWS are seeking comments and input. A graduate of the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, he created Shahidlipi, the first Bangla keyboard developed for the computer (1985). A founding member and first President of the Bangladesh Amateur Radio League (1979), «after working hard lobbying and negotiating with government officials for more than twelve years», he and other BARL members eventually succeeded in launching Amateur Radio in the country. In 1992 Saif got the first licence issued in Bangladesh, S21A; seven years later he migrated to the US, where he held the callsign KF6WJZ.

Also reported SK is **Paul-Joel Herbet, F2YT**, a prominent figure in the French amateur radio world, who passed away on 31 December aged 77.

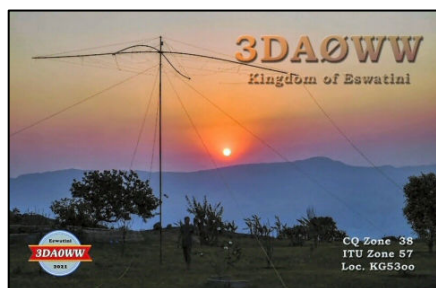

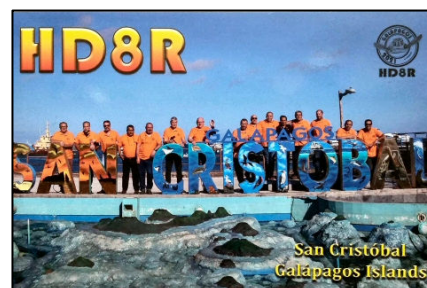

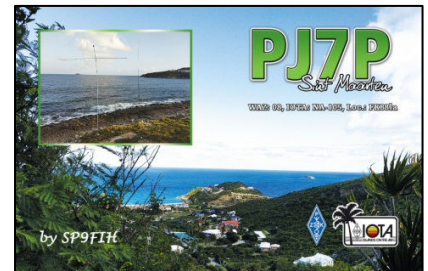
