3W - Retu, OH4MDY and Henry, OH3JR will be active from Vietnam as XV2RZ and XV2JR respectively until 7 December. They operate CW, SSB and RTTY on the HF bands. QSL for both calls via OH4MDY (direct only). [TNX The Daily DX]

5R - Eric, F6ICX will operate only CW on 80-10 metres as 5R81C from Sainte-Marie Island (AF-090), Madagascar from 17 November to 14 December. QSL via home call, bureau preferred. [TNX F6GCP]
