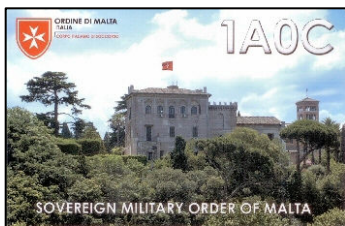

# DX INFORMATION



**1A** - A large multinational team (EA1SA, EA5EL, EA5KA, EA5KM, EA5RM, EA7AJR, EA7KW, F8ATS, F9IE, IK5RUN, IN3ZNR, IW0DJB, IZ4AKS and LA7GIA) will be active again as 1A0C from the SMOM on 15-21 July. They will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 with at least three stations on 80-6m. See <http://www.1a0c.com/> for 1A0C's bandplan, QSLing policy, logsearch and Online QSL Request System. QSL direct via the OQRS (preferred), or direct to EA5RM.

**3D2** - Dom, 3Z9DX is back to Fiji, and has received the callsign 3D2DOM. He plans to "be active from some of the 3D2 islands" during his stay, including participation in the IOTA Contest from the Yasawa Islands (OC-156).

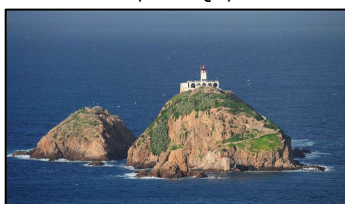
**4L** - Darek, SP9DLM will be active as 4L/SP9DLM from Kobuleti, Georgia on 4-16 August. He will be QRV on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or via SP9DLM (direct or bureau).

**5R** - Giovanni, IZ2DPX will be active as 5R8PX from Nosy Be (AF-057) on 3-17 August. He will operate SSB and digital modes on the HF bands. QSL via IK2DUW (direct) and LoTW; the log will be uploaded to Club Log.

**6O** - Ken, LA7GIA (6O6O in January 2018) will return to Somalia and be active as 6O7O for 14 days in September (dates TBA). The licence has been granted, flights and accommodation have been booked, and the LoTW certificate has been issued. He will operate mainly CW on 160-10 metres.
