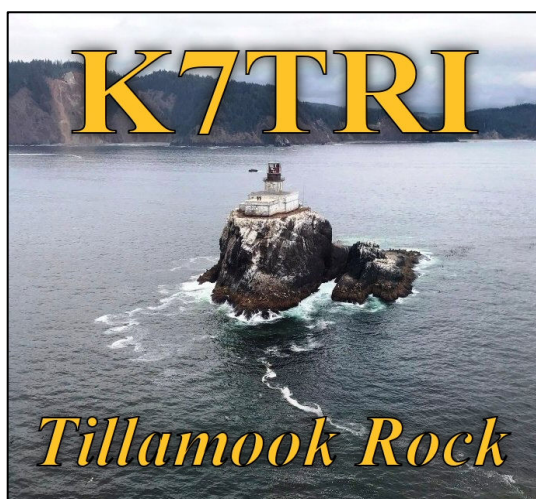

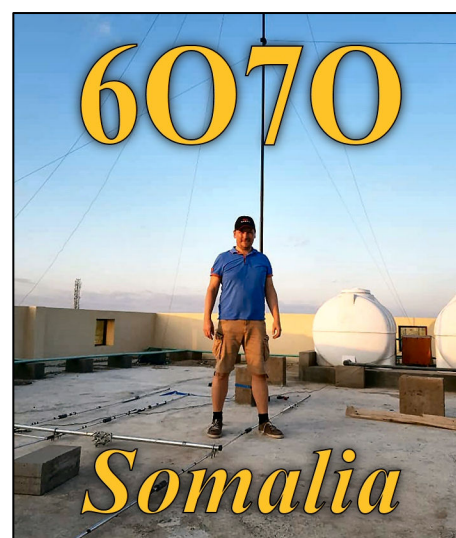

DX INFORMATION



3W - Jacek, SP5APW will be active as 3W9KJ from Dao Co To (AS-132), Vietnam from 27 September to 3 October. Main mode will be FT8/FT4 with some SSB if conditions allow. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW or via home call. [TNX DX World]

3W - Sven, HB9DXB will be active again as XV9DXB from Nha Trang, Vietnam on 2-9 October. He will operate CW and maybe some SSB on 20 metres and 40m. QSL via EB7DX.

3W - Yosuke, JJ1DQR will be active as 3W9QR from Da Nang, Vietnam from 23 October to 1 November, including an entry in the CQ WW DX SSB Contest. QSL via JJ1DQR.

5B - Kasimir, DL2SBY will be active as 5B/DL2SBY from Cyprus (AS-004) on 3-13 October. He will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on 80-6 metres. QSL via home call (direct only, as he is no longer a member of DARC); the log will be uploaded to LoTW and Club Log. [TNX The Daily DX]

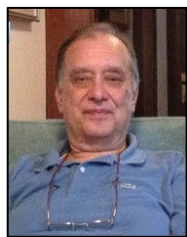

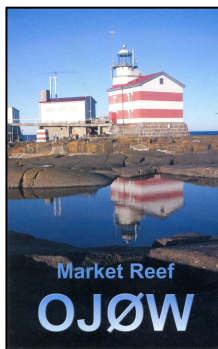
Club Peruano's HQ (OA40). A commemorative certificate will be available; information can be found on <https://www.qrz.com/db/OC19IARU>.

OE - Special call sign OE15SOTA will be active on 6-22 September to celebrate the 15th anniversary of Austria joining the Summits On the Air programme. A certificate will be available; information can be found on <https://www.qrz.com/db/OE15SOTA>.

OE - Special call signs OE190APD, OE192APD, OE193APD and OE196APD will be active from 21 September to 20 October. QSL via operator's instructions. The suffix stands for Animal Protection Day (World



Animal Day is an international day of action for animal rights and welfare celebrated annually on 4 October). A number of certificates will be available; information can be found on <https://www.qrz.com/db/oe190apd>.



OJO - Pasi, OH3WS will be active as OJØW, OJØ/OH3WS and OJØ/OG3A from Market Reef (EU-053) on 5-12 October. He will operate CW and SSB on 80-30 metres. This is expected to be the last activity for Market Reef's golden jubilee celebrations. OK - Special call sign OL75CARBON marks the 75th anniversary of Operation Carbon, executed during World War II in the Protectorate of Bohemia and Moravia by Czech paratroopers trained in England. Activity started on 5 September and will continue until 30 November. QSL via OK2PXJ.

ON - Club Radio Durnal (ON4CRD) will be active as OP75E between 21 September and 20 October to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the liberation of the city of Eghezee and the district of Namur during WWII. QSL via the bureau.

ON - The ONZ Oost Kust Radioclub (ON6HC) will be active on all bands and modes as OR75CLM on 1-3 November. The suffix stands for Canadian Liberation March, the annual event that celebrates the liberation of the Belgian town of Knokke on 1 November 1944. QSL via ON6HC. OX - Bo, OZ1DJJ will be active again in his spare time as OX3LX from Simiutaq Island (NA-220) on 26-30 September. Before and after going to Simiutaq he might be active from Qaqortoq, on the main island of Greenland (NA-018). QSL via OZØJ, Club Log's OQRS and LoTW. [TNX DX World]

PA - Commemorating the 75th anniversary of Operation Market Garden, special event station PH75MG will be active on 14-21 September. QSL via PI4CQ, direct or bureau.



PA - Special callsign PA350RB will be active again on 1-31 October to commemorate the 350th anniversary of the death of Rembrandt (1606-1669), the famous Dutch painter and printmaker. QSL via the bureau to PA2CVD.

PA - PI4ADL, the Club Station at the National Aviation

Theme Park "Aviodrome" in Lelystad, will be active as PH100ADL on October-December to celebrate the centenary of the commercial aviation in the Netherlands. Look for activity on the HF bands SSB and CW. QSL via the bureau.

PA - The Vereniging van Radio Zend Amateurs (VRZA) will be active as PA100PCGG on 6-10 November to celebrate "Idzerda Day" and the 100th anniversary of PCGG. QSL via the bureau. Located at The Hague and established by engineer Hanso Idzerda, radio station PCGG began broadcasting a regular schedule of entertainment programmes on 6 November 1919. It is believed to have been Europe's first sustained broadcasting station, as well as one of the first stations in the world to transmit entertainment intended for a general audience.



PY - Special callsign PS360KT will celebrate the 36th edition of the Oktoberfest of Blumenau (9-27 October), the biggest German festival in the Americas. Look for activity on all bands CW, SSB and FT8. QSL via

PY2GTA (direct) or PY2AA (bureau).

S7 - Lance, W7GJ will be active as S79GJ from La Digue Island (AF-024), WWL LI75vp, Seychelles on 21-29 September. This will be a 6m EME DXpedition: "I urge you to gain experience with JT65A", he says, "and especially review the QSO procedure that I use most effectively on these DXpeditions". When "not aimed up at the moon", he adds, "I very well may be on SSB or FT8 mode. For FT8, I will be using 50.313 MHz". Plans are to tear down on 30 September, but he might "be able to get on 20m FT8 for some activity during the first few days of October" before departing for home on the 5th. S7 - Ravi, VU2IIX will be on Mahe Island (AF-024), Seychelles from 30 September until 30 June 2021 (22 months). He will operate SSB and digital modes as S79VU on 80-10 metres. [TNX The Daily DX]

SM - Gaby, DF9TM as SD7M and Frank, DL2SWW as SD7W will be active from Sturko Island (EU-138) on 13-19 September. QSL via the bureau to home calls.

SV5 - Wolf, DL3DRN will be active again as SV5/DL3DRN from Rhodes Island (EU-001), Dodecanese from 20 September to 10 October. He will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on all bands. QSL via LoTW, or via home call (direct or bureau).

T8 - T88FM (JM1LIG), T88MK (JO3LVG) and T88RR (JA6UBY) will be active from Koror (OC-009), Palau on 12-20 September. They will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on 160-6 metres. QSL via home calls.

CLUB LOG LIVE STREAMS • Live Streams is a new feature that Michael, G7VJR has added to Club Log. It provides a console view of a Club Log callsign in real-time, including a map showing the location of the QSOs. Each time new QSOs are uploaded to Club Log, the Live Stream is automatically updated and a graphical indication of which bands are in use is presented to help DXers. Live Streams is available to any Club Log user. The idea is that it can be used standalone (very helpful if a DXpedition is logging in real-time) and can also be embedded in other web pages or bookmarked. DX-WORLD RADIO CLUB • G5DX is the callsign issued to the DX-World Radio Club, which was formed on 18 September 2019. IOTA AND THE MAINTENANCE OF FAIR PLAY • "To clarify its position on the conduct of operations put on for the IOTA Programme, the IOTA Board has updated the text of provision E.1.2 in the IOTA Programme Rules as follows:

IOTA Management attaches importance to the maintenance of fair play as far as is practicable. From time to time a set of circumstances occurs where official intervention is considered justified. One such case is where there is seen to be apparent intentional unfair, even discriminatory, treatment of people

in the making of contacts or issue of QSL cards or QSO matches. An example of this is where an expedition to a rare IOTA group follows a clear practice of discriminating against contacts with non- participants in the IOTA Programme or, post-event, of deleting them from the log. In this regard the cardinal principle to be followed must be that it is immaterial whether the contact is a known participant or not in IOTA. Failure to observe fair play in cases like this is sufficient justification for rejection of the operation for IOTA credit on grounds of it bringing the IOTA Programme into disrepute. All participants are asked to have regard for our long established tradition of acting in accordance with the best of ham spirit". [G3KMA, <https://iota-world.org/>, 11 September 2019]

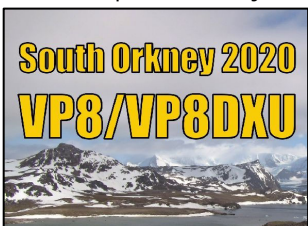

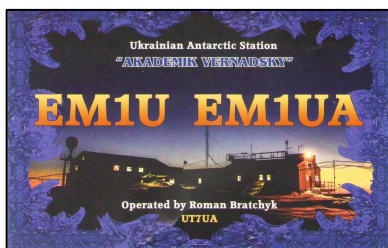

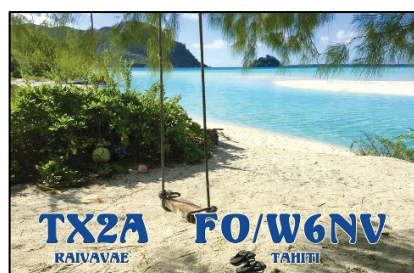
