# DX INFORMATION



Owing to the ongoing and fluid nature of the COVID-19 situation globally, announced activities might be postponed or cancelled at any time and without notice.

**6W** - 6W1TG is the permanent callsign issued to Dani, EA4ATI, who has been in Senegal since July [425DXN 1575]. He operates mainly SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL via EA4R (direct or bureau) and LoTW. [TNX EA4R]

**6W** - Jacques, F6HMJ will be active as 6W7/F6HMJ from Senegal from 29 December to 22 February. He will operate CW and SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via home call. [TNX Les Nouvelles DX]



**7P** - Chris, ZS1CDG plans to be active again as 7P8GOZ from Lesotho on 20-26 December. He will operate holiday style on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres FT8. QSL via LoTW or home call. [TNX DX World]

**8Q** - Tor, DG7RO will be active as 8Q7RO (reissued callsign, already used by RT4RO in 2013) from the Maldives (AS-013) on 11-27 December. He will only operate via Oscar QO-100. QSL via DG7RO and LoTW.

**8Q** - Tom, OE1TRI will be active holiday style as 8Q7TR from the Maldives (AS-013) from 28 December to 3 January. He will run 20 watts on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres SSB and FT8. QSL via OE1TRI; he does not use Club Log or LoTW. [TNX The Daily DX]



**9J** - Mario, IK1MYT is active again as 9J2MYT from Lusaka, Zambia until June 2022. He operates SSB on 40, 20, 17, 15 and 10 metres. QSL direct to IZ3KVD.

**DL** - Club station DL0IMO will operate special callsign DR50BAWA throughout 2022 to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the DARC's Intruder Monitoring Service. QSL via the bureau. Started in 1972 and formerly known as Bandwatch, the Intruder Monitoring (<https://www.intruder-monitoring.de/>) is the German branch of the IARU Monitoring System, whose primary objective is the search, classification, identification and initiation of steps leading to the removal from amateur bands of radio signals of non-amateur stations causing harmful interference to the amateur services.

**EI** - Special callsign EI90IRTS will be activated throughout 2022 to celebrate the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the founding of the Irish Radio Transmitters Society, Ireland's IARU society. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, eQSL, bureau or direct to EI6AL.



**F** - The Radio Club de Nice is active again as TM8AB on 2-6 December to commemorate the anniversary of the first Transatlantic amateur two-way contact between Leon Deloy F8AB and Fred Schnell 1MO (28 November 1923). QSL via F4KJQ.



**F** - Celebrating the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Centre National d'Etudes Spatiales (National Centre for Space Studies, the French government space agency), special event stations TM60CNES from France, TK60CNES (Corsica), TO60CNES (French Guiana) and TX60CNES (New Caledonia) will be active from 18 December to 2 January. QSLs via F1UJT, direct or bureau.

**FS** - David, F8AAN will be active again as FS/F8AAN from Saint Martin (NA-105) on 1-20 January. He will operate CW only on 40-10 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or direct to home call. [TNX DX World]



**FT/X** - Arthur Perrin, FT4XW is an electronic engineer currently stationed at Port-aux-Français, Kerguelen Islands, until December 2022. «I'm a total newbie at ham radio», he says, and «I do not know if I will succeed to establish radio contacts, but I remain optimistic». Thierry, F6CUK is in touch with him, and confirms

he is «100% legitimate» but «not QRV yet (too busy for work)». Arthur is equipped to run 20 watts to a vertical antenna. QSL via F6EXV, and LoTW after six months.



**G** - During the month of December, the Welland Valley Amateur Radio Society will be running special callsigns GB1XMS, GB2XMS, GB5XMS and GB9XMS to celebrate Christmas and say farewell to 2021. QSL via operator's instructions.

**G** - GB100BBC is the special callsign celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the British Broadcasting Corporation throughout 2022. The BBC was formed on 18 October 1922, and daily radio broadcasts began on 11 November. GB100BBC will be on air from the BBC Radio Group's shack at BBC Broadcasting House in central London, as well as from other BBC premises and members' home QTHs around the UK. QSL via the bureau, LoTW and eQSL; direct cards will not be accepted.



**GM** - The Kilmarnock and Loudoun Amateur Radio Club has been asked by the organizers of the celebrations to commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the reception of the first transmission by amateur radio across the Atlantic to operate a station adjacent to the site of the original experiment at Ardrossan (Scotland). Look for GS2ZE to be QRV on 11-12 December, from 12 UTC to 12 UTC (24 hours), using CW and SSB. QSL via M0OXO's OQRS.

**GU** - Bob, GU4YOX will be operating MU5A for the Stew Perry 160m Contest on 18-19 December (<https://www.kkn.net/stew/>). He will be using a top loaded 160m vertical antenna especially installed for the "Big Stew". QSL via LoTW, paper QSL cards will not be available.



**HA** - Special callsign HA21XMAS will be activated on 14-26 December on various bands CW, SSB and digital modes. QSL via LoTW and eQSL; a downloadable certificate for two QSOs on two different modes is available on

<http://qrz.com/db/ha21xmas>.

**HI** - Hrane, YT1AD and Milos, YT3M will be active as HI7/YT1AD and HI7/YT3M from the Dominican Republic on 4-14 December. QSL via home calls. [TNX NG3K]



**HS** - Brad, VK2BY will be active again as HS0ZNR from the Nam Yuen district in northeastern Thailand between 12 December and 21 January. QSL via LoTW, or direct to VK2BY.



**HS** - Champ, E21EIC and other nine operators (namely E20NKB, E24OYI, E25KAE, E25OKO, E29TGW, HS2BMI, HS2KYA, HS2QJJ and HS2UPR) will be active as E20AX/p from Koh Chang

(AS-125) on 18-20 December. They plan to operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 160-10 metres with two or three stations. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau; direct cards via Club Log's OQRS or E21EIC.

**I** - Members of the Italian Naval Old Rhythmers Club ([www.inorc.it](http://www.inorc.it)) will be active as I11TCWC on 12-17 December to commemorate the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first radio transmission sent across the Atlantic Ocean (12 December 1901). They will operate only CW. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau. A certificate will be available; see <https://www.qrz.com/db/I11TCWC> for information. [TNX IN3MDR]



**I** - The World Radiosport Team Championship, which was due to be held in Bologna on 6-11 July 2022, has been postponed to 2023 «in consideration of the worldwide

public health challenges from the Covid-19 pandemic» [425DXN 1565].

To promote the event and keep the interest alive, however, twelve special callsigns will be activated between 1 January 2022 and the end of the IARU



HF Championship (10 July at 11.59 UTC). Look for I11WRTC, I12WRTC, I13WRTC, I14WRTC, I15WRTC, I16WRTC, I17WRTC, I18WRTC, I19WRTC, I10WRTC, IR1WRTC and IO0WRTC (the latter from Sardinia) to be QRV on the HF bands CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8. A certificate for working the special stations will be available after the end of the event; see <https://www.wrtc2022.it/en/wrtc2022-award-19.asp> for the rules and the real-time scoreboard.

**JA** - JI3DST/6, JJ5RBH/6 and JS6RRR/6 will be active from Tanega Island (AS-032) from 25 December to 10 January. Look for activity on 80-6m CW, SSB and digital modes. QSL via operator's instructions. [TNX DX World]

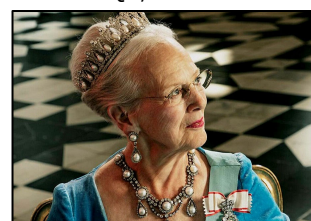

**OH** - The Finnish Amateur Radio League (SRAL) is celebrating its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary. To earn the *OH Northern Light 100-year Certificate* (OH-NL-100), contact fifty OH and fifty OF stations during 2021, and ten "multipliers" [425DXN 1559]. The list of special centennial activations will be completed during the month of December by three multipliers: OI3AX (QRV on 3-7 December, QSL via OH2LGW), OF2YOTA (QSL via Club Log's OQRS) and Santa Claus station, OF9X (Old Father 9 Xmas, QSL via OH2BH). **PY** - Felipe, PU2OYT will be active as PU2OYT/p from Ilha do Algodao (SA-029) on 23-24 December. He will be QRV mostly on 10 metres SSB and 15 metres FT8. QSL via home call. [TNX DX World]

**S2** - The S21DX operation (<https://s21dx.org>) from IO-TA group AS-140 [425DXN 1589] has been brought forward, and is now expected to take place on 10-16 December. In accordance with the operating permission granted by the licencing authority, the activity will take place from Char Kukri Mukri (not Manpura). S21AM and S21RC plan to run

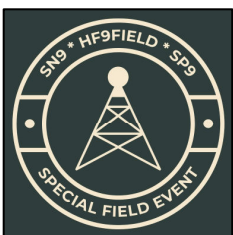

**S5** - Special event station S522PMC will be active from 3 December to 2 January 2022 to promote the PMC Contest, sponsored by the Radio Club Slovenj Gradec (S59DCD). All QSOs will be confirmed via the bureau. The International Association of Peace Messenger Cities was established in 1988 to recognize and encourage the role and responsibility cities have in creating a culture of peace. The PMC Contest, promoting contacts between stations located in the Peace Messenger Cities and the rest of the world, will be held on 1-2 January (see <http://www.s59dcd.si/> for complete information).



**SP** - Dominik SQ9ORN, Maciek SP9RBL, Pawel SN9PJ and Thomas SP9TL will be active "out in the field" between 1 January and 14 December 2022, and will operate special callsigns HF9FIELD (January, April, July and October), SN9FIELD (February, May, August and November) and SP9FIELD (March, June, September and December). So he has moved to the «sunny Turkish coast of Fethiye» instead, where he will be QRV as TA4/G6JFY, while waiting for a TA callsign to be allocated.

**TZ** - Ulmar, DK1CE has extended his stay in Mali [425DXN 1592], and now expects to be QRV as TZ1CE until 15 December. QSL via DK1CE and logsearch on Club Log («the FT8 log will be updated daily», he says, while the «CW/SSB log will only be available on Club Log after the end of my operations in Mali»).

**UA** - Yaroslav R1BET, Yulia R1CBL and Mikhail R1MJ will be active from Peredovik (Esisaari) Island (EU-117) on 11-12 December. Bands and modes will depend on local conditions, and will be decided when on the island.

**UN** - Celebrating the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Republic of Kazakhstan's independence (16 December 1991), special event stations UN30RK, UO30RK, UP30RK and UQ30RK will be active on 11-19 December. 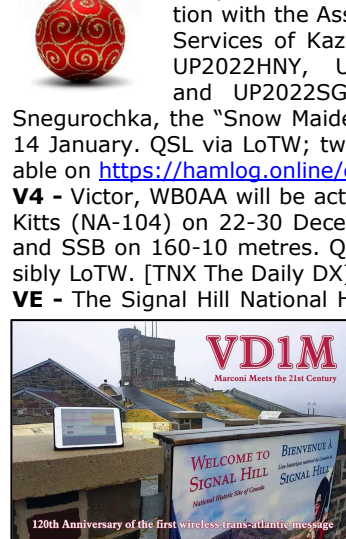

**VE** - The Signal Hill National Historic Site is the location where Guglielmo Marconi received the very first wireless transatlantic message on 12 December 1901. Commemorating the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary of that historic event, the Society of Newfound-

land Radio Amateurs will operate special callsign VD1M on 1-31 December. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or direct to VO1IDX.

**W** - This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the historic Transatlantic Tests of December 1921, when the ARRL's representative Paul Godley, 2ZE set up his listening station in Ardrossan (Scotland) and received the signals of more than two dozen US amateur radio stations, the first from 1BCG in Connecticut. During the UTC night between 11 and 12 December those transmissions will be recreated by W2AN/1BCG from the Vintage Radio and Communications Museum of Connecticut, using a replica transmitter constructed by volunteers at the Antique Wireless

Association. Transmissions will start on +/- 1820 kHz CW at 23 UTC, then every 15 minutes until 03.45 UTC on 12 December. Transmissions from W2AN/1BCG will be one-way, just like the original Transatlantic Tests. You can get a SWL certificate by sending a copy of the transmit-



ted message to 1BCG@AntiqueWireless.org. See <http://1BCG.org> for more information.

**W** - The Straight Key Century Club's annual on-air event, commemorating the club's founding in 2006, will run on 2-31 January. Look for K3Y to be aired from the ten US call areas (K3Y/0 through K3Y/9), plus /KH6, /KL7 and /KP4. 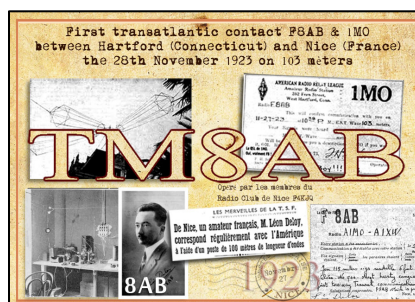

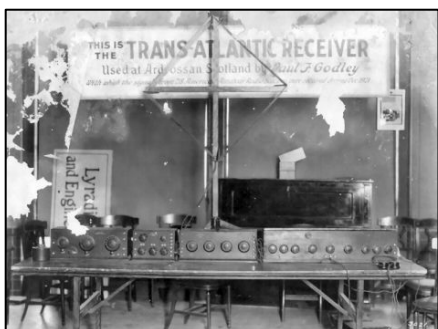

**160-METER TRANSATLANTIC CENTENARY QSO PARTY** • Organized by the ARRL and the RSGB, this operating event will take place on 12 December, from 2 to 8 UTC (six hours). The event coincides with the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the successful second Transatlantic Test. Stations participating will operate only CW, trying to contact the two official callsign activations: W1AW from Newington (Connecticut) and GB2ZE from Scotland. The GMDX Group will award a quaiach - a traditional Scottish drinking cup representing friendship - to the first stations in North America and the UK to complete contacts with both W1AW and GB2ZE during the QSO Party. A commemorative certificate will be available for download. Log submissions will not be required, as the official logs from W1AW and GB2ZE will be used to determine the winners and for certificates. Going to Bouvet is a huge undertaking financially as all our expenses are upfront. If you want to have the opportunity to work the rare #2 DXCC Bouvet Island, please consider to donate upfront». 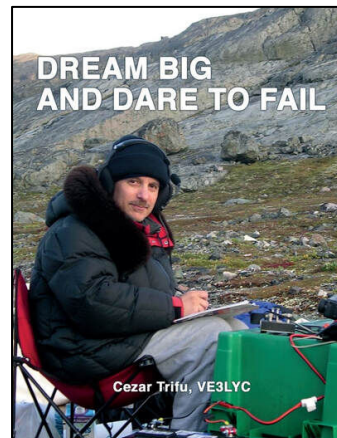
**9N7AA** • «We have now moved to the new residence and a couple of vertical dipoles were strung from a Spiderbeam pole on the upper terrace of our top floor apartment», Robert, 9N7AA (S53R) posted to his qrz.com page on 11 December. «I mostly run on 17m as other bands sound rather empty. A new antenna mast was manufactured locally and delivered today, while the Ultra Beam/WIMO 2el Yagi (40-6m) is still at the customs. If all stars align, I will be able to install it before the end of the year. 160/80 will have to wait for a while, though. I have an idea how to install quarter-wave slopers but this will need some negotiations with the neighbors, as the wires will go over two adjacent land plots. Kathmandu is veery densely populated. And, for those constantly asking: 60m band is not permitted in Nepal. Equipment from my previous operation is still stuck in Kabul and we are trying hard to bring it to Kathmandu. As of very recently, single-airline commercial flights have finally resumed to Dubai, so there is a little tiny light at the end of the tunnel». QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or direct only to S57DX.

**COMOROS 2022: POSTPONED** • Due to the current pandemic situation, «it's safer for the team not to travel now», Jean-Luc, F1ULQ reports. Consequently the January 2022 operation organized by the Radio Club de Provins [425DXN 1589] has been postponed to a later date TBA, «when all gets again quieter».
