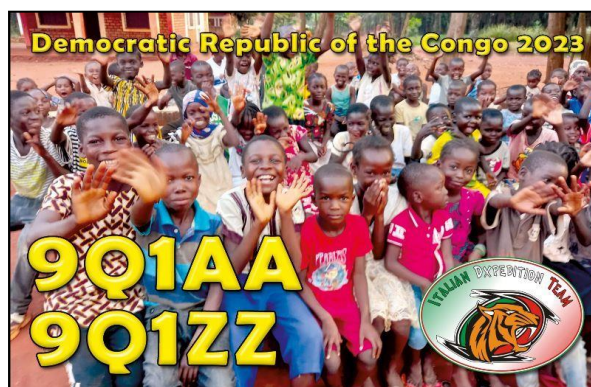

# DX INFORMATION

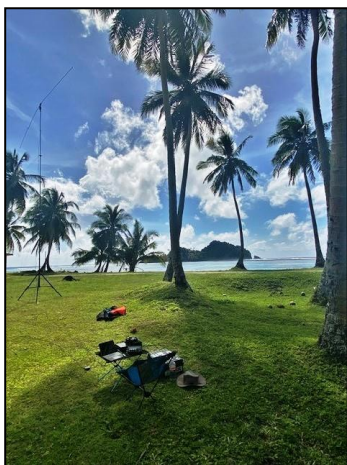


**1A** - A large multi-national team (EA5C, EA5EL, EA5KA, EA5KM, EA5RM, EA5Z, EA7KE, EA7R, EA7X, F2JD, IK5RUN, IN3ZNR, IZ0NIC, IZ4AKS, JH4RHF and RA9USU) will be active again as 1A0C from the amateur radio station of the Italian Relief Corps of the Order of Malta at the Magistral Villa on the Aventine Hill between 26 July and 2 August. QSL direct to EA5RM. Detailed QSLing policy, logsearch and OQRS can be found on <http://www.1a0c.com/>. As per tradition, this activity will be associated with a charity project. All the proceeds and donations generated by the DXpedition will be used to support the Order of Malta's reconstruction projects in the areas of Romagna heavily affected by the recent floods.

**3B9** - Lance, W7GJ will be active as 3B9GJ from Rongelap Island (AF-017) from 27 August to 7 September. This will be a 6m DXpedition, both EME and terrestrial. Detailed information and instructions can be found on <https://www.bigskyspaces.com/w7gj/>. QSL via LoTW or direct to W7GJ.

**3D2/R** - Previously active from Guam (AH2/WA7WJR), the Northern Marianas (AH0/WA7WJR), and more recently from Pohnpei, Micronesia (V63WJR), "BJ" has been QRV as 3D2BJ from Rotuma (OC-060) since 3 July. He plans to remain there until 18 July, and then set sail for Viti Levu (OC-016), Fiji. He operates mainly FT8 and CW primarily on 17-10 metres. QSL via LoTW or direct to WA7WJR; cards will be sent out when he returns to the US sometime in September. **4W** - Vasily R7AL, Mike RU3UR, Vlad R9LR, Slav OK8AU and Anastasya R6DTO have been QRV as 4W6RU from near Dili, Timor Leste (OC-148) since 28 June, and expect to remain there until 20 July. «This is a suitcase DXpedition with modest setup», they say. They operate mainly FT8 and CW with a focus on 30-10 metres. QSL via R7AL, Club Log's OQRS, LoTW.



**9A** - Look for 9A7YY, 9A/S53Z, 9A/S54W, 9A/S58MU, 9A/S500 and 9A/S50X to be active from Vis Island (EU-016) from 24 July and 1 August. They will operate CW and SSB on 80-10 metres, and will also be active during the IOTA Contest. QSLs via the bureau, eQSL, or direct to home calls. [TNX S58MU]

**9A** - IK6VXO and others will be active as 9A8DV from Drvenik Veli Island (EU-016) from 27 July to 2 August, including an entry in the IOTA Contest. QSL via IK6VXO. [TNX NG3K]

**9A** - Alex, 9A6SAI will be operate SSB from three different islands, all counting for IOTA group EU-110, during the IOTA Contest: Sveti Ivan na Pucini (29 July starting around 17 UTC), Sveti Ivan (during the night), and Sturag (30 July). QSL via LoTW. [TNX NG3K]

**9Q** - Originally scheduled for September [425DXN 1670], the Italian DXpedition Team's operation from the Democratic Republic of the Congo has been brought forward by two months. 9Q1AA (SSB, CW, RTTY) and 9Q1ZZ (FT8 F/H) will now be active on 6-18 July with four stations. See <http://www.i2ysb.com/idx> for the band plan. QSL direct to I2YSB (real-time online log and OQRS on <http://win.i2ysb.com/logonline>).

**C2** - «The return of C21TS is confirmed», Phill, 3D2TS (FK1TS) posted to his website on 3 July. He expects to be back on Nauru on 22 July, but «as I'll be starting a new job, radio will be secondary, and I also don't know where I will be staying yet. But I'd hope to be on the air by the start of August in my spare time and weekends. Antenna wise, let's wait and see». His initial focus will be on FT8, with SSB to follow when he gets settled in. **C6A** - Joe, W8GEX (C6ADX) and Janet, W8CAA (C6AYL) will be active again from Exuma Island (NA-001), Bahamas from 30 June to 8 July. QSLs via LoTW, or direct to home calls.

**CN** - Taking part in the annual Throne Day's celebrations, special call sign CN24M will be active from 26 July to 6 August. QSL via CN8WW. Throne Day commemorates the enthronement of the incumbent monarch; since 1999, it has been celebrated on 30 July.

**CT7** - Special event station CR6J will be active on 17-23 July for the 41<sup>st</sup> International Motorcycle Rally in Faro, Portugal. Expect activity on 80-6 metres SSB, CW and digital modes. QSL via CT1EHX. [TNX CT1END]

**CT7** - Members of the Associação de Radioamadores da Beira Alta (CT1ARB) will operate special callsign CQ7JMJ on 1-6 August in celebration of World Youth Day (Jornada Mundial da Juventude) to be held in Lisbon. Also active will be CS23JMJ (QSL via the bureau) and CS23WYD (QSL via CT2FFC and LoTW).



**CX** - Special event station CX90RCU will be active on 1-31 August to celebrate the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Radio Club Uruguayo (CXA1AA), founded on 23 August 1933. QSL via the bureau, direct,

or via LoTW.

**DL** - Mike, DG5LAC will be active as DG5LAC/p from Foehr Island (EU-042) on 4-11 August. He will operate FT8, FT4 and some SSB. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL.

**DU** - Rag, LB3RE will be active on 40-6 metres as DU1/LB3RE from Luzon Island (OC-042) from 28 June to 18 July. QSL via LoTW, Club Log, or via home call.



**E6** - Stan, LZ1GC and Dimo, LZ1ON will be active as E6AM from Niue (OC-040) on 10-23 October. They will operate CW, SSB, FT8 and maybe some RTTY on 160-6 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), LoTW, or via LZ1GC (direct or bureau). QSLing policy and other information can be found on <https://www.c21qc.com/>.

**F** - F4FET, F4HHL, F5RAB and F8GGV will be active as TM5K from Ouessant Island (EU-065) from 25 July to 2 August. Before the IOTA contest they will operate SSB, CW, RTTY and FT8 on 80-6 metres. QSL via

F8GGV.

**F** - Larry, F6FVY and Alain, F6BFH will be active again as TM5OL from Oleron Island (EU-032) for the RSGB IOTA Contest (29-30 July). QSL via F6AJA. [TNX F6AJA]

**F** - George, F5MAG will be active as TM0MM from the Frioul Islands (EU-095) on 5-19 August. He will operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 40-6 metres. QSL via the bureau to F5MAG. Located off the Mediterranean coast of France, the Frioul archipelago includes four islands (Pomègues, Ratonneau, If, Tiboulén). [TNX The Daily DX]

**FR** - In memory of Denis Arlais (F6DBA) and André Fonteneau (F1GJP), who both passed away early this year, Philippe, FR8UA and Anne, FR8TZ will be active as TO0GL from Reunion Island (AF-016) on 29-30 July (IOTA Contest), 30 October-5 November and 5-10 December. QSL via LoTW, eQSL or direct to F8TRL.

**GD** - Keith, G3TTC will be active as GD3TTC from the Isle of Man (EU-116) on 26-29 July, including activity during the IOTA Contest. He will operate SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via G3TTC. [TNX The Daily DX]

**GD** - Tom, G2NV and Ady, G6AD will be active as GD6AD from the Isle of Man (EU-116) on 27-31 July, including an entry in the IOTA Contest. QSL via LoTW, Club Log, eQSL.

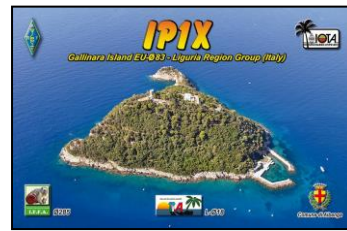

**I** - II3GR is the special callsign for the annual YOTA Camp organized by ARI Grado. This year it will take place on Volpera Island (not IOTA) on 20-23 July, including participation in the second session of the YOTA Contest (22 July, 1000-2159 UTC). QSL via IV3CTT.

Agon Island (EU-176) on 27-31 July, including an entry in the IOTA Contest.

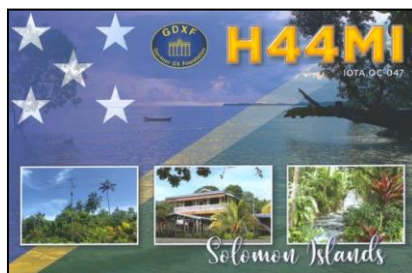
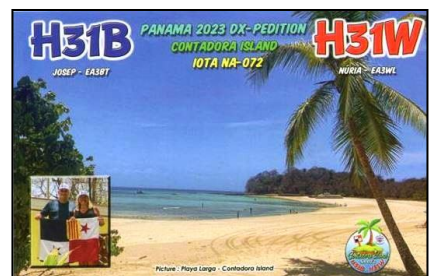
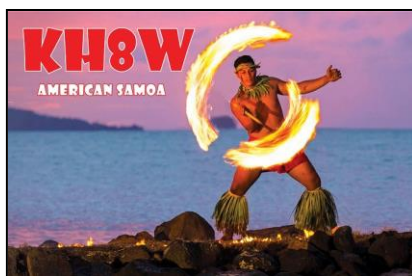

**4W8X: LOCATION SETUP & LOW BAND ANTENNAS** • Lagunaria DX Group's November 2023 DXpedition to Timor Leste [425DXN 1677] «will have two operating sites which are 500m apart. The main location, which we have also used for our 4W1A scouting trip in April, will serve all eleven bands from 160m thru 6m. The second location will serve seven bands from 40m thru 10m. The physical separation will enable us to provide two signals on the same band at the same time - one CW and one SSB. Please note that CW and SSB are our preferred modes, followed by RTTY. We'll give FT8 a chance, but we definitely prefer the man-made operating modes».

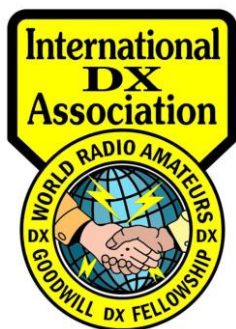
As for the low bands, 4W8X will have two 30m 4-Squares, two 40m 4-Squares, one 80m 4-Square and one Titanex V160 vertical with extensive radials for 160m. For receiving, they will have two Beverages (about 250m long) plus filtering/switching network to listen in four directions, independently on 160m and 80m: Europe (short path); North America (short path); Africa, same as North America (long path); South America, same as Europe (long path).

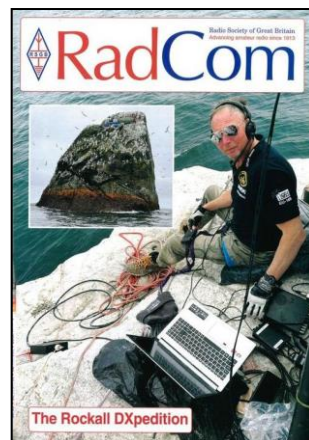

**INDEXA WORLDWIDE QSO PARTY** • Grown from a few people loaning equipment to DX travelers to an organization that has sponsored hundreds of DXpeditions, the International DX Association will turn 40 years old in September. To commemorate this anniversary, INDEXA is sponsoring a worldwide on the air celebration, the INDEXA QSO Party. The event will occur on 2-10 September on 160, 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres SSB, CW, and RTTY. This event is open to all radio amateurs, INDEXA members and non-members alike. There will be QSO points, multipliers, plaques and awards, and published results. See <https://indexaqsoparty.com/> for detailed information.

**MM0UKI** • Cam Cameron's fundraising expedition plans (<https://www.rockallexped.com/>) were to stay on Rockall for 60 days; overnight on 27-28 June, however, the weather significantly worsened, a lot of his equipment was destroyed by the wind and waves, and on several occasions he was almost swept away. On 28 June, he issued a "Mayday" call, which was picked up by HM Coastguard at Stornoway. Later on that day Cam was winched onto a coastguard helicopter, and flown back to dry land. Nobby, G0VJG and Emil, DL8JJ were expected to return to Rockall on 19 July to collect the equipment that has remained there since Cam was airlifted to safety. They had planned to operate again as MM0UKI for three hours, but the swell around the islet prevented them from landing and they returned to the mainland. The team will re-plan for another recover attempt sometime in the future.

**QSL CO2XN** • Boris, E73Y is the new QSL manager for Jose, CO2XN, including his previous callsigns (CM2XN and CM8AKD). The QSL cards are being designed and Boris hopes to have them printed by mid-August. QSLs can be requested via Club Log's OQRS, or via E73Y (direct and bureau). **QSO TODAY ACADEMY** • The QSO Today Virtual Ham Expo was introduced during the height of the Covid-19 pandemic. After six successful events, it is evolving into the QSO Today Academy. **SOUTH SUDAN** • The YASME Foundation reports that last week two members of the National Communications Authority (NCA) of South Sudan visited the ET3AA club station in Addis Ababa to learn more about amateur radio and to gather information from members of the Ethiopian Amateur Radio Association (EARA). There is interest in establishing a club like ET3AA in South Sudan and creating a pathway for local citizens to gain access to amateur radio. It is hoped this visit will help to further that effort. Travel for NCA was sponsored by the Yasme Foundation.

**VP6A: DUCIE ISLAND WRAP UP REPORT** • The following report was released on 26 June:

*In 2018, on Baker Island in scorching heat, exhausted operators spent a day dismantling 11 tents, 12 antennas, 5 generators, radios, computers, Ethernet stretching hundreds of feet, desks, chairs and trash and hauled it all back to the boat. On the voyage back to Fiji we wondered if there wasn't a better way.*



*With funding from the Northern California DX Foundation George Wallner, AA7JV, put together a team to create that new way: welcome to the RIB, Radio In a Box.*

*VP6A was the first full deployment of the RIB on a rare location. On 24 June at 16:00 UTC, VP6A went QRT after making just under 62,000 QSOs, of which 24% (15,000) were unique calls. DXCC was obtained on 6 bands.*

*There were four stations on the island. One used by AA7JV, W6IZT and KN4EEI on the boat, and three others operated by 34 remote operators from 11 countries (9V1YC, AA1V, AA7A, CT1BOH, CT1EEB, CT1ILT, DJ4MX, F6EXV, JN1THL, KC1KUG, KY7M, KD4Z, KL7YL, KO8SCA, K1DG, K4NHW, K6GFJ, K6TD, K6UFO, KL2A, K6MM, ND2T, N1DG, N2IC, OH2BH, PB8DX, PY5EG, VE4EA, VE5MX, VK3GK, W0GJ, W1RM, W1VE, and W8HC).+ It took four hours to set up the first three stations (the fourth*

*followed on the third day), and 1 hour and 50 minutes to tear down and leave the island. Mother Nature and satellite latency threw us curve balls, but we are extremely happy with the final result. We hope our audience is too. See you from our next location.*



**WRTC 2026** • The 10<sup>th</sup> World Radio Sport Team Championship will be hosted by the United Kingdom, and will take place in the area known as East Anglia, in the East of England, on 7-13 July 2026.

The qualification criteria are still being determined. It is already known, however, that the first and final qualification events will be this year's CQ WW DX SSB Contest (28-29 October) and the 2025 ARRL DX SSB Contest (1-2 March), respectively. Bookmark <https://www.wrtc2026.org/> for updates.
