On 13 June more than 500 kg (1100 lb) of cards were shipped to the QSL processing team, and should arrive around the end of this week.

Everyone who requests a QSL will receive both a card and a LOTW confirmation, but QSL requests are prioritized in groups:

- QSL requests for QSOs that match the VP6DX log exactly have priority over requests that require manual research,
- QSL requests submitted through the Online QSL Request System (OQRS) have priority over requests received via postal mail,
- requests from donors have priority over requests from non-donors.
- Please note that 1086 donors have not provided their callsigns, and their QSL requests cannot be processed. The list of donors with missing callsign is available on the website; if you find yourself listed there, send your callsign via the "Contact Us" menu option.
