# NEWS

**3D2** - Andre, GM3VLB confirms he will be active as 3D2LB from Beachcomber Island (OC-121) [425DXN 621], Fiji on 26-29 May. QSL direct only to home call.

**3V** - Francois, F8DVD plans to be active on SSB from Djerba Island (AF-083) using the call sign of the Djerba Scouts Radio Club, 3V8SM from 23 June to 4 July. QSL via F8DVD (by special permission of Mustapha, DL1BDF) either direct (Francois Bergez, 6 rue Liberte, 71000 Macon, France) or via the REF bureau. [TNX VA3RJ]

**4W** - 4W3DX is the new callsign for Thor, TF3MM (formerly 4W6MM), which apparently has been issued by the new licensing authority in the Democratic Republic of Timor Leste (East Timor). Thor expects to be active for at least one more week before leaving the country. QSL via TF3MM. [TNX The Daily DX]

**4W** - JA1BK and JR2KDN will be active as 4W1BK (QSL via WA2MOE) and 4W2DN (QSL via JR2KDN) respectively from Timor Leste on 24-29 May. This is a WFWL operation (see "Timor Leste" below). [TNX WA2MOE]

**5B** - Alan, G3PMR reports he will be active as 5B4AHJ from Cyprus from 28 May until 22 June. QSL via home call.

**5H** - Ramesh, VU2RKS is active on 20 and 15 metres as 5H9KR from Mwanza, on the banks of Lake Victoria in northern Tanzania. "I currently QSL direct", he says, "and shall return direct QSLs by mid May". 9H - Miki, YT1CS is active as 9H3CS from Malta until 4 May. "Frosty" Frost (K5LBU/7P8CF, <http://www.k5lbu.com>), Madison Jones (W5MJ/7P8MJ), Neil King (VA7DX/7P8NK), Tom Anderson (WW5L/7P8TA), Dave Anderson (K4SV/7P8DA) and Igor Zdorov (W0IR/7P8IZ). This will be an all mode, all band operation with beams, dipoles, a couple of amplifiers and hopefully at least one station on the air 24 hours a day. 7P8CF and 7P8TA will be the main phone operators, while 7P8MJ, 7P8NK, 7P8DA, and 7P8IZ will be mostly CW and digital modes. The DXpedition is under the aegis of the Texas DX Society (<http://www.tdxs.net/>) and the Lone Star DX Association (<http://www.dxeer.org/lsdxa>). QSL via each operator's home call. **7X** - A second attempt at operating from the Habibas Islands (AF-???) is scheduled to take place on 1-5 June. Last year the operation aborted at the very last minute [425DXN 576]. The operators (Ivan/OM3CGN, Afif/7X2RO and maybe other locals) are waiting for the last permission to be issued. [TNX OM3JW]

**7X** - As at 20 May the IOTA expedition to the Habibas Islands (AF-???) [425DXN 628] was still scheduled to start on 1 June. Latest information from Steve, OM3JW was that Ivan/OM3CGN, Afif/7X2RO and three other local operators would be active as 7W4HI on the usual IOTA frequencies (SSB and CW). QSL arrangements will be announced after the DXpedition - if it takes place, as on 21 May northern Algeria was hit by a strong earthquake. [TNX OM3JW]

**7X** - In spite of the recent earthquake in (we have been informed that 7X2DW and 7X2DS's daughter lost their lives) Algeria the 7W4HI operation from the Habbibas Islands (AF-???) 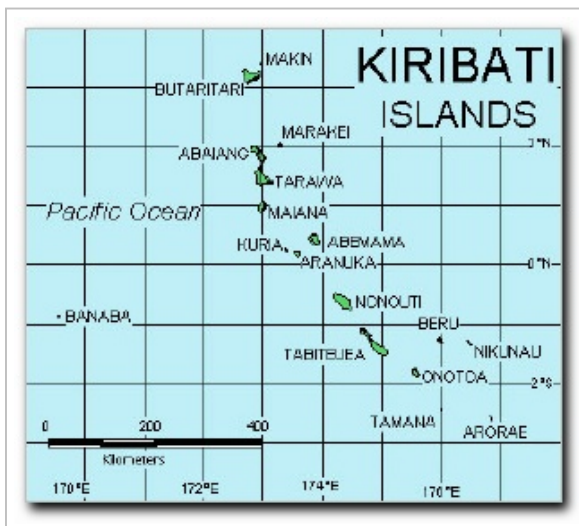

This prefix assignment was for the use of UNTAET as long as it existed, and was to be released to the ITU at the end of its existence. "Since the UNTAET organization's charter in East Timor expired May 20th of 2002", The Daily DX reports, "all ham radio operating authority also expired on that date. A successor organization called UNMISSET does not have the same telecommunications and other authority that UNTAET had; an emerging East Timor government is expected to take over responsibility for administrative things such as ham radio licensing", but for the time being it appears that East Timor is off the air. For DXCC purposes, UN Temporary Administration of East Timor was added to the DXCC List with the effective date of 1 March 2000.

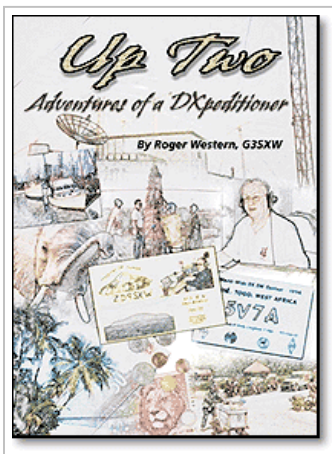

An application for new entity status will be filed together with an application to delete of the former 4W territory as an entity under DXCC rules.



Article 5 of the treaty between Portugal and Indonesia of May 5, 1999 removed East Timor from the list of Non-Self-Governing Territories of the General Assembly and the deletion of the question of East Timor from the agendas of the Security Council and the General Assembly. The treaty, witnessed by the Secretary General of the United Nations, did not make the United Nations the administrator of East Timor but did provide for UN humanitarian assistance. Article 7 requested "the Secretary-General to maintain an adequate United Nations presence in East Timor."

The DX Advisory and Awards Committees quite possibly misinterpreted the language of the treaty as conferring status of East Timor as a UN administered territory which in fact was not the case. Only when the referendum authorized by the treaty was held and the East Timorese people declared themselves independent was there a new entity.

The role of UNTAET (UN Transitional Administration in East Timor) was humanitarian and peacekeeping and was not a quasi-government authorized to issue amateur radio

licenses. UNTAET did not have the authority to issue amateur radio licenses; it was a peacekeeping mission and only after the referendum was there a Ministry of Communications which does have that authority.

If ARRL agrees, the UN sanctioned operations in East Timor would be deleted on the ground that East Timor was not an entity under the rules and a new entity, would be created effective 20 May 2002, the date of the creation of the East Timorese state. Democratic Republic of Timor Leste became a UN state on 27 September, 2002. ITU has reassigned 4WA-4WZ to the Democratic Republic of Timor Leste on 23 April, 2003.>>

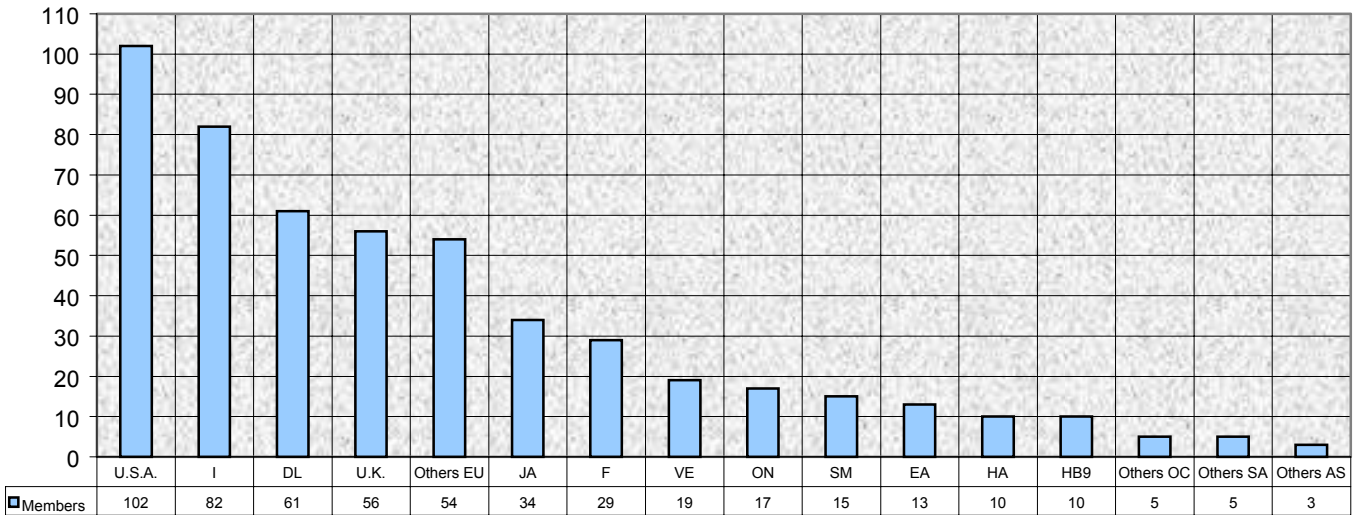

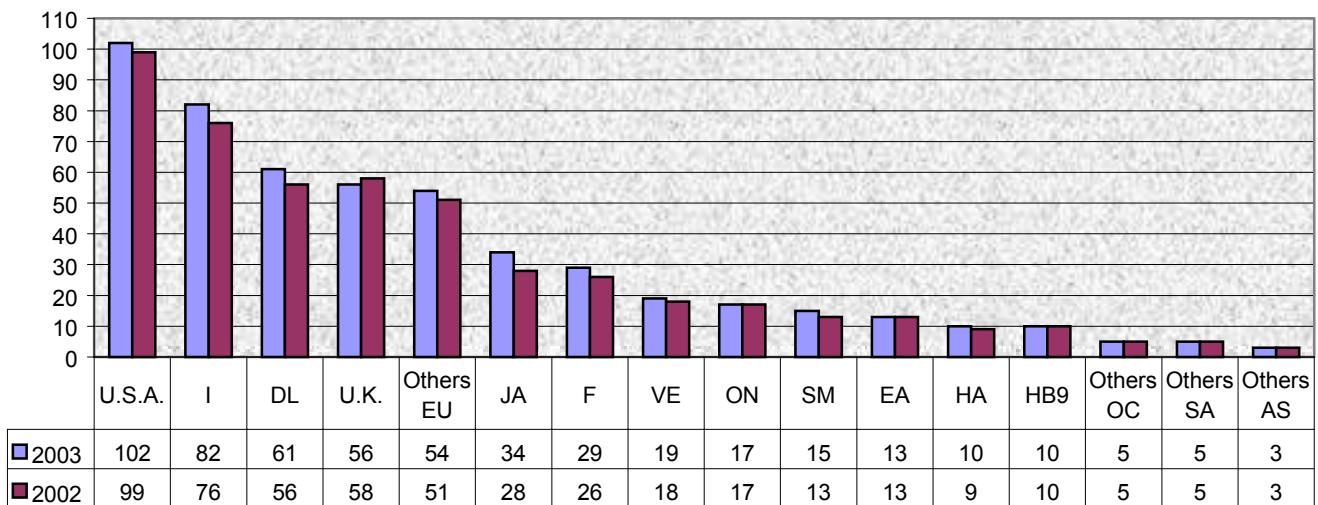

## 9n7dx : From Tel Aviv to Nepal: A wonderful experience.

(By Dov 4Z4DX, with an introduction by Sarla,VU2SWS)

SARLA: Dov Gavish is licenced since 1968 and is the second generation of Hams in the family. His father was 4x4vb,an active SSTV operator in his days and son Matan is 4z5dx!!

When I got the message that Dov would be passing through Mumbai on his way to Nepal for an expedition, I was delighted. After all he did have so many aces up his sleeve! Awards and diplomas like the 9 Band WAZ, 5 Band WAS, IOTA Honour Roll with 950 islands confirmed, 6 mtr DXCC, RTTY DXCC to name a few. As I was just beginning to experience contesting, I was eager to meet this person who holds 4 World records (as ZC4dx in 1987, as 4z8dx in 1988, as 4z4dx in 1980 on 40 mtr and 1981 in 80mtr) in the CQWW Contest. The icing is the fact that Dov was in the expedition to Jordan after the Peace agreement in 1995 between Jordan and Israel and he worked with King Hussein JY1, with a special callsign JY8WW. At the airport he was as delighted to meet me as I was him, and this was his first visit to this part of the world. He had all his Ham stuff in his backpack!! An Icom 706 MkII with all the filters, a Toshiba 8000 Laptop and a 6mtr antenna!! I took him for a long drive all over Mumbai and had a chance to listen to all his activities on the band. He visited my shack and gave me lots of advice and encouragement. I was sad to see him go in the evening and wished I could go to the expedition with him!!



DOV:In 1999, I met Bill 9n7zk in the IARU convention in Tel Aviv. I had always wanted to operate from Nepal in memory of Father Moran, 9n1mm, an old friend. I also wanted to be the first to make a QSO in 6 mtr from Nepal and operate RTTY and SSTV. Plus of course, have a vacation with the entire family. So I started working on the plan.

In February 2003 I applied for the call sign 9n7dx to the Ministry of Commerce in Nepal and received the basic confirmation from Satish, 9n1aa. I then contacted my friend IZ8 CCW from the MDXC Club in Italy of which I am a member and asked him to help me design a Website which would represent my activities and frequencies and 1 daily sched for everyone on 14.195 at 1500 GMT.



I finally left Tel Aviv for Kathmandu via Mumbai on the 21<sup>st</sup> of April 2003. I met my good friend Sarla, VU2SWS in Mumbai and spent the day with her, sightseeing and visiting her shack and family. On the 21<sup>st</sup> evening I was finally in Kathmandu! Hugo,9n7yj and my son Mat,4z5dx received me at the airport and we headed for the Hotel in Thamel where we put up a tower with 4 different dipole antennas and we were all set for the action.

But the beginning was not that easy. The procurement of the licence was long and tedious. I had to go from one official to another, from the bank to the ministry and it took a good 4 days for it all to end. During this period I traveled around the Kathmandu area.

Finally on the 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2003, I was on air!!! The pileup was tremendous from all over the world. So much so, that I

had to call by the numbers in the call signs, to cope. I operated split and worked SSB on 28.495, 21.295 and 14.195. Every one hour I worked RTTY after giving sufficient notice and operated split, 2-10 up. Late in the evening when conditions deteriorated, we operated CW at 40 wpm. We faced the problem of electricity failures. Also, conditions in Nepal were limited between 9.30z to 21.00z.

My first weekend, I spent with Bill, 9n7zk and his wife in their palatial house in Kathmandu where I was given 5 star hospitality and I had the opportunity to operate from his shack with a beam antenna. As soon as I put up the 6 mtr antenna which I had bought with me, I had a contact with VK8MS, VR2XMT and lots of Japanese!!! In fact my first QSO on SSTV was with JA0SC. After I clocked about 3000 QSOs, I took a break .

My son Matan and I headed for the mountains. We trekked for 5 days through the mountains after flying to a point 3000 ft up. I flew in a small aircraft with 9N as its number!! The terrain was breathtaking and we stopped for "chai" every hour and walked for a minimum of 8 hrs every day. On the last day we had a good soak in the hot springs. We then went river rafting in Pokhara before finally returning to Kathmandu and working the radio.



After working for another 4000 QSOs , we decided to call it a day and prepared to head for home.

Looking back, there are a few pointers for my ham friends who may want to work dx from Nepal.

1)The price of a licence in Nepal is very high. Its around 50\$ per band.2) The licencing process is very slow and valuable time is lost.3)Kathmandu is not a good location to operate on lower bands. It is better to go closer to the Tibetan border in northern Nepal. But the conditions are open for only short periods of time. And linears have to be used.

On the positive side, I was so happy to meet many of my Ham friends since the last 30 yrs on the air from this rare location and I was pleased that I gave them a new RTTY country. I had a fantastic time with Bill and Jennifer who were most cooperative and perfect hosts. They are moving out of Kathmandu soon as Bill's tenure there is over. The Nepalese people are helpful and polite and are happy in their own little world in the mountains, where their basic needs are taken care of. It was great to work the radio with my son who is a great CW operator. Even though conditions towards N.America were not good, I managed to work some old friends like W3UR, KOBX and worked many new countries on RTTY. As I worked with the system of numbers, I was able to get through to QRP stations and also stations without big antennas or linears. I know that many of them were working 9n7 after ages.

My total tally:

RTTY 1650 QSOs

6mtr SSB & CW 253 QSOs

SSB all bands 3200 QSOs

CW all bands 3500 QSOs

On my way back home, I had 2 full days in Mumbai. I had the opportunity to meet VU2SWS Sarlaji and Prashant , VU2CBU. Though the weather was hot and humid, their hospitality made me very comfortable. I hope to work dx from an island close to VU someday!! I am back home now and I carry very fond memories of this entire expedition.

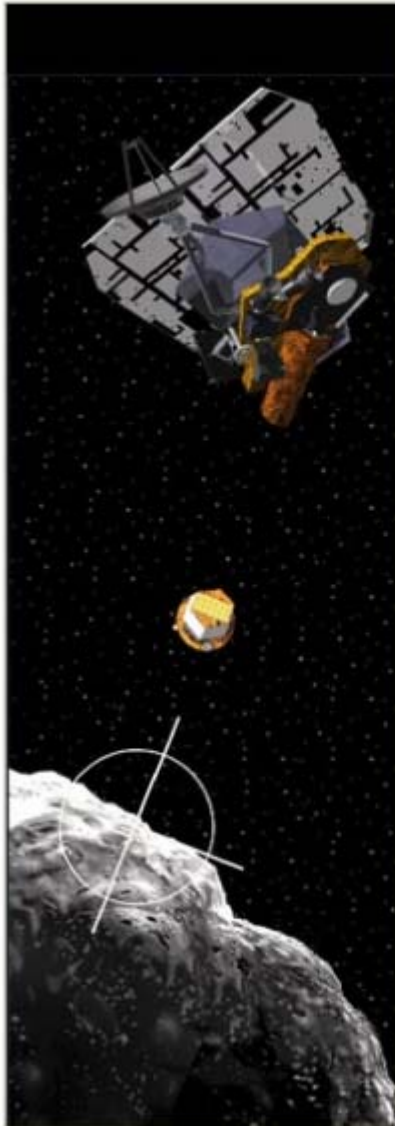


