DX INFORMATION

3C - 3C7A is the callsign issued to Ken, LA7GIA for his 11-21 March activity from Malabo, Bioko Island (AF-010), Equatorial Guinea [425DXN 1296]. He plans to be QRV on 80-10 metres CW, SSB and RTTY. QSL via LA7GIA and LoTW; logsearch on Club Log.

4W - A team of five (7K4QOK, JE1CKA, JI1AVY, JJ2VLY and JQ2GYU) will be active from Timor Leste on 5-11 April. They will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on 160-10 metres. Callsign(s) and QSL information will be announced later. [TNX DX World]



5V - DF1AI, DL5MEV, DL6MFK and DL9MBI will be active as 5V7D from Togo from 24 March to 11 April. They will operate SSB, CW, RTTY on 80-10 metres, and will be doing some 2m EME as well. QSL via DL9MBI, bureau preferred. Log-search on

Club Log.

5W - Haru, JA1XGI will be active as 5W0XG from Apia, Samoa (OC-097) on 19-25 April. He will operate mainly CW with some RTTY and PSK on 40-10 metres. QSL via JA1XGI (direct or bureau) and LoTW; logsearch and OQRS on Club Log.

C5 - Leaving Belgium on 28 March, Pedro, ON7WP will be active again as C5WP from the village of Buntung

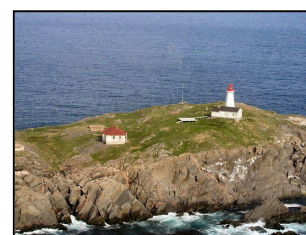

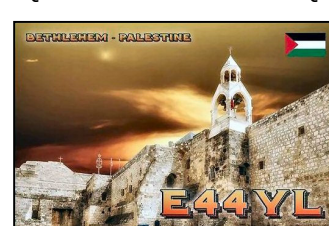
CY9 - A team of nine (AA4NC, K4ZLE, K5DHY, K8LEE,

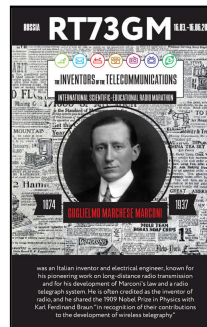

Only operators located within the United Kingdom and Crown Dependencies, Commonwealth or British Mandated Territories are eligible to enter.

THE GREAT NORTHERN WAY • "The Great Northern Way" expedition started on 29 February from Novy Urengoy, with plans to travel by All Terrain Vehicles along a 10,000 km route as far as Uelen, the easternmost settlement in Russia. Expect activity mainly on 40 and 20 metres (14120 and 14260 kHz) as R3CA/8, R3CA/9 and R3CA/0. The operators will be Valery RA9J and possibly Yuri UA9OBA, who might join the expedition later on. Brief activities from islands along the coasts of Taimyr, Yakutia and Chukotka are also being planned. The expedition stopped for a while at Dikson (mainland Russia), with a brief activity from nearby Dikson Island (AS-005) on 20 March. There might be further activity from the Begichevskaya Kosa Islands and/or Kolchak Island (formerly known as Rastorguyev), whose IOTA status is being considered. VK0EK • It will be possible to follow the Heard Island Expedition on the Weak Signal Propagation Reporter Network's website, www.wsprnet.org: 1) click "Map" in the upper right hand corner; 2) set the search parameters for "all" bands and "24 hours", and 3) look for ZS/K2ARB (Cape Town), K2ARB/mm (during the voyage) and VK0EK (while on the island). The expedition will operate a 250-milliwatt battery-powered propagation beacon that is capable of transmitting on 40, 30, 20, 17, 15 and 10 metres. The beacon will cycle through the bands during the expedition.

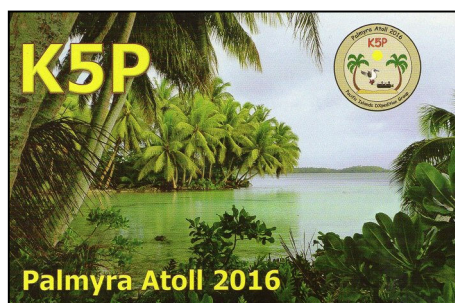
