DIPLOMA DELLE PROVINCE CALABRE - CALABRIAN PROVINCES AWARD

The ARI Section of Pizzo Calabro institutes the "Diploma delle Province Calabre" (Calabrian Provinces Award). Aim of this Award is to draw as many people as possible to the world of the radio, to promote the DX activities and, at same time, to get the beauties of the Calabria Region known.

The Award can be obtained by Radioamateurs and SWL from all over the world on these versions: HF (SSB,CW,Mixed), VHF, UHF and Upper (SSB,CW,Mixed), 50 Mhz (SSB,CW,Mixed), SWL (SSB,CW,Mixed).
Version: HF Award

You need to contact all 5 calabrian provinces on 5 bands for a total of 25 contacts.

Admitted HF bands are: 10,15,20,40 and 80 meters.

The provinces are: Reggio Calabria (RC), Vibo Valentia (VV), Catanzaro (CZ), Crotona (KR) and Cosenza (CS).
Contacts are valid since January 1st 1990 to date. [HF Application Form](#).

Version: VHF UHF and Upper Award

You need to contact at least 10 of the following WWL Squares:

In province of RC: JM78-JM88-JM77-JM87

In province of VV: JM78-JM88

In province of CZ: JM88-JM89

In province of KR: JM88-JM89

In province of CS: JM79-JM89-JN80

Of course at least one of these squares must be worked per each one of 5 provinces.

Some of these WWL Squares, in fact, contains more than one province, so that two different contacts with same Square, but with two different provinces are considered two good contacts. [VHF and upper Application Form](#)

Version: 6 meters (50 Mhz) Award

For the 50 Mhz band, same rules as the Version VHF ,UHF and Upper are valid.

Version: SWL

Same rules as OM.

The Award Manager could announce eventual "Jolly Stations" that could replace eventual missing QSLs. Stations operating from Calabrian Islands also valid for the IIA Award will worth as "Jolly Stations". Special Station IQ8V will also worth as "Jolly Station".
