

## **I.N.O.R.C. – AWARD**

The Award reproduces the image of the " Charles Alberto", the first war ship in which has been installed a station complete radio. Departing from Naples in 1902, has reached the Atlantic and the Sea of the North to develop a complete experimentation during which have been involved American and Canadian coastal stations. The same William Marconi has conducted these experimentations. To get the Award needs to work (or to listen, for the SW s) 10 stations I.N.O.C. Italian and 10 foreign stations.
