

## TURIN AWARD

- 1) The followings are eligible for the Award:

All Italian Amateurs, except those from the Province of Turin, who have established 15 Two-way Communication with station in the Province of Turin;  
5 two-way communication on the 50 Mhz band will be considered sufficient.

All Amateurs from the European countries who have established 10 two-way communication with stations in the province of Turin;  
5 two-way communication on the 50 Mhz band will be considered sufficient.

All Amateurs outside Europe who have established 5 two- way communication with the station in the province of Turin.

- 2) Contacts must be made all in telegraphy or all in telephony and all of them only one of the amateurs bands including present and future WARC acquisition.  
Cross band is only allowed via satellite.
- 3) Contacts must have been made after January 1<sup>st</sup> 1952. For the 50 mhz band after 6<sup>th</sup> march 1990.
- 4) The photocopies of the QSL confirming the QSO certified by the Award Manager must be submitted the “Award Manager IW1FGZ – ARI Section of Turin – P.O.Box 250, 10100 Torino – Italy.
- 5) The QSL must not contain corrections or other kinds of changes in the data. The decisions of the ARI of Turin are final.
- 6) Obtaining the Award Torino for one band does not exlude amateurs from obtaining Awards in the other authorized bands. The same is true for different transmission modes: CW or SSB.
- 7) SWL are also eligible for the Award subject to the Same rules as those for the OM.
