WORKED ALL EUROPEAN PREFIX
OFFICIAL ARTICLES

The award recognizes all the confirmed QSOs with the radioamateur station using different prefixes all over Europe.

The valid European prefixes are those used in the WAZ areas n. 14, 15 (including IG9 and IH9), 16, 20 and in the following WAZ countries:

Iceland, Svalbard, Jan Mayen, Franz Josef Land.

PREFIXES

The alphanumeric combination of the first two or more characters forming the first part of a radioamateur's callsign which identifies his Country, will be considered a prefix. Any change in the combination will be considered a new prefix.

Any prefix will be considered good if authorized by the responsible authority; the bestknown international lists will be authoritative.

The same principles and awards are available to the SWL's:

ACHIEVABLE AWARDS:

MIXED at least the confirmation of 350 prefixes are needed;

CW at least the confirmation of 300 prefixes are needed;

2xSSB at least the confirmation of 350 prefixes are needed;

THE BEST at least the confirmation of 800 prefixes on 10 metres band are needed;

RTTY at least the confirmation of 250 prefixes are needed;

VHF at least the confirmation of 200 prefixes on 2 meter band (144-146 Mhz).

For each award, apart VHF, it is available the 5-BAND for which the confirmation of 1000 QSO, with a minimum of 150 for each band, are needed.

Only for the 5-BAND there is a particular diploma called Excellent that needs the confirmations of 3000 prefixes with at least 250 prefix for each of the 5 bands.

Only for the MIXED it is possible to call the same station or prefix on the same band, but in a different mode, while the same prefixes but on different bands are good for all.

All QSOs must be made from the same country and those for the diploma VHF must not be made by means of cross-band, repeater or satellite.

The Qsl must be sent only after the request of the Diploma Award Manager.

The logs enclosed to the Diploma or endorsement requests must be signed by two radioamateurs.

The QSOs since 1/1/1970 are accepted.

ADVANCEMENTS

Endorsement will be given every 50 new prefixes up to the doubling of the base number, besides 25 new prefixes.

BANDS

All QSOs on authorized one's own Country bands will be valid.

COST

Each diploma will cost Euro 15,00 / 8 \$

The EXCELLENT will cost Euro 50,00 / 60 \$

For the endorsement it is sufficient to send a S.A.S.E.

AWARD

The diplomas are on parchment paper (20x30 cm.); the EXCELLENT consists of a 9x14 cm. silver plate (the dimensions of a QSL).
