- DL Markus, DJ4EL will be active as DJ4EL/p from Juist Island (EU-047) on 10-13 July. He will operate SSB on 40-10 metres. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via home call. [TNX DX World]
- HS Look for E20WXA/p (QSL direct to home call), HS0YNM/p (QSL via home call, direct or bureau, and LoTW), HS1OLQ/p (QSL via home call) and HS2JQC/p (QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or direct to home call) to be active from Si Chang Island (AS-107) between around 6 UTC on 11 July until around 8 UTC on the 12th.
