BOUVET ---> Preliminary plans were for 3Y0F to be active from Bouvet Island for two weeks between December 2015 and January 2016 [425DXN 1230]. However, on 13 August Alex Lebedev (UN7PCZ) reported that "some logistical issues remain open and unresolved", and that "for obvious lack of immediate progress, I must admit that our operation will probably be delayed until the next season, 2016-2017". ILLW ---> The 18th annual International Lighthouse/Lightship Weekend will take place from 00.01 UTC on 15 August until 23.59 UTC on the 16th. Complete information on this popular event, including a list of announced participating stations, can be found at <http://illw.net/>.

VY0M & VY0/VE3LYC ---> Cezar, VE3LYC was able to be active as VY0/VE3LYC from Resolute Bay, Cornwallis Island (NA-009) between 20.15 UTC on 2 August and 08.47 UTC on the 3rd. He logged 1220 QSOs on 20m CW and SSB. A separate QSL card will be printed for this activity. Operations from Melville Island (NA-248) started at 20.24 UTC on 4 August, and VY0M logged over 4500 QSOs until 9.25 UTC on the 11th. The vast majority of the contacts were made on 20m, although he "spent a little bit of time on 17 and 30m, with modest results".
