- 3D2\_rot- The Daily DX reports that Ron, ZL1AMO confirms his upcoming trip to Rotuma (OC-060) [425DXN 339]. He plans to be on the air sometime on 8 November and should be active for one week. Ron plans to operate on 10-160 metres (WARC included) CW and SSB, plus RTTY on either 20 or 15 metres. QSL via ZL1AMO.
- 4X - Cedric, HB9HFN will be signing 4X/HB9HFN from 8 to 13 November while on a business trip to Tel Aviv. QSL via the HB bureau or direct (Cedric Baechler, Mettetlet 26, 1763 Granges-Paccot, Switzerland).
- 5T - The IARV members are now active as 5T5U [425DXN 339]. The Daily DX reports that "subject to spare time, and any other operational constraints," their plans are to give emphasis to CW on all bands (WARC included, 160 metres excluded) and to work RTTY on 120, 15 and possibly 40 metres. QSL to JA1UT.
- 9Q - Peter, 5X1T/ON6TT and Mats, 5X1Z/SM7PKK were active as 9Q2T from Kisangani [425DXN 339], from where Peter made the the first ever SSTV QSO from 9Q land (Democratic Republic of Congo, ex Zaire). They plan to operate from Kinshasa during the weekend. QSL via ON5NT.
- 9U - Alex, PA3DZN is currently active from Alfredo's (9U5CW) station. He is still awaiting his own call (possibly 9U2L) [425DXN 337] and will be in Burundi until mid-January.
- BY - The Gui-Shan Dao (AS-131/Prov) operation has been reorganized [425DXN 337] and started on 7 November. Team members BD7IA, BD7IX, BD7JA, BD7JG, BD7JK, BD7YA, BG7ML and BG7NQ will be active until 04.30 UTC on 9 November (04.30 UTC). They expect to operate on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres (IOTA frequencies). QSL to P.O.Box 1713, Guangzhou, People's Republic of China.
- KH2 - The ARRL DX Bulletin reports that Bill, NH6D has moved to Guam and will be active on all bands as NH2/NH6D. QSL via N6FF.
- OX - Joergen, OZ8AE reports to 425 DX News that he will be active (mostly on CW) as OX/OZ8AE from Greenland (NA-018) until 1 December. QSL via home call either direct or through the bureau.

TT - The ARRL DX Bulletin reports that Jim, TT8JWM/WA4KKY and John TT8JFC/WB4MBU [425DXN 330] are now active on RTTY. Jim, TT8JWM will go QRT on 8 November, but will be QRV again on 10 December. The \*new\* QSL manager for TT8JWM is N4RXL.

CYCLONE ---> Cyclone Martin, with winds gusting at more than 100mph, struck the northern Cook Islands on 1 November, leaving five people dead and 14 missing while hundreds of homes have been wiped out by towering waves. The worst-hit atoll, Manihiki, was completely submerged. By 5 November 160 people had been airlifted off the island by New Zealand Airforce Hercules transports, and local reports said an evacuation of Manihiki's entire population of 600 was likely. Then the cyclone moved west and reached French Polynesia on 3 November. Doug Brandon, N6RT/FO0BRD reports that Martin "destroyed much of the private island home (Mai Moana) of Stan (FO5IW), Dominique (FO5IZ), and their daughter Tatiana", who recently hosted the FO8DX team: "none of their family was hurt, but there was major damage to their beautiful island home. Some of the existing structures have completely vanished.

QSL 3W5KVR ---> Pepe, EA5KB is the QSL manager (Europe only) for contacts made by Yuki, JI6KVR/3W5KVR from Con Son group (AS-130/Prov). Pepe expects to get some 5,000 QSL cards in late November. The total QSOs logged by the four callsigns (3W5FW/7L1MFS, 3W5MNB/JA2MNB, 3W5KDN/JR2KDN and 3W5KVR/JI6KVR) on 10-160 metres (WARC included) is 5581 (4223 on SSB, 1216 on CW, 142 on RTTY).

QSL 4L4CC ---> Vlad, RV1CC/UT1II (Vladimir Sidorov, P.O.Box 1, St.Petersburg-Bugry, 188660 Russia) has received the first part of 4L4CC's logs and has started answering direct and bureau requests.

QSL A61AS ---> "I apologize to those of you who have waited for cards either direct or via the buro", Dave, KA5TQF says. He has never received any logs from Salem since he first met him over a year and a half ago. When Dave goes to Dubai (in a couple of weeks), he will give Salem the cards received so far and let him take care of the matter. A61AS is reported to give YO3FRI as his QSL manager.

QSL FO0xxx ---> Doug Brandon, N6RT reports the current QSL routes for the Southern California DX Club recent contest expedition to Bora Bora (OC-067). Please note that the FO0 calls the operators had hoped to be issued [425DXN 337] were replaced with others. The actual calls used and QSL routes are the

following: FO5VO via N6VO (Ron Weaver, 13691 Solitaire, Irvine, CA 92720, USA); FO0BRD via N6RT (ex NF6H: Doug Brandon, 712 Stardust Drive, Placentia, CA 92870-4507, USA); FO0KEO via KA7CQQ (John Kennon, P O Box 31553, Laughlin, NV 89029, USA); FO0MIT via W6RW (ex N6NU: Mike Mitchell, 5271 Turquoise Ave, Alta Loma, CA 91701, USA); FO0PLA via W8AEF (Paul Playford, 35639 N 3rd St, Phoenix, AZ 85027-7405, USA); FO0SPE via KG6AR (Chris Williams, 1117 So. Del Mar Ave., San Gabriel, CA 91776-3034, USA). QSLs for contacts made with FO8DX during the 1997 CQ WW SSB Contest go via KG6AR.

QSL HC5C ---> Robert, W5AJ reports that QSL for contacts made with HC5C during the CQ WW SSB Contest should go via WJ5DX.

QSL VIA K4PHE ---> Bob Smith, K4PHE is the QSL Manager for the following operations: VP2KC/K4PHE (CQWW 1979), WB4ZNH/3D6 (28 Dec-3 Feb 1980), WB4ZNH/A2 (5-8 Jan 1981), WB4ZNH/5X (20-31 Oct 1982), 3C0BC (24-28 Jan 1982), TT8AC (26-31 Jan 1983), TT8BC (26-31 Jan 1983), 3C1BC (15 Feb-1 Mar 1985), 3C1YL (15 Feb-1 Mar 1985), 5T5BC (24-28 Oct 1987), 5T5MH (24-28 Oct 1987), J6LAH (29-30 Oct 1988), ET3BC (9-16 Oct 1992), 9ER1TB (19-26 Oct 1992).

ZK1XXP ---> More information [425DXN 337] on the recent ZK1XXP comes from Tom, K8XP. The Dateline DX Association team (K8XP, N7RO, N4RF, KI6AN, WA4YBV, ZS8IR and N6MZ) completed its DXpedition to Penrhyn Atoll (OC-082), North Cook on 27 September. Total on-air time (5 1/2 days with 2 stations) produced 15,299 QSOs (6708 SSB, 8101 CW, 490 RTTY). A planned third station was operated only a limited amount of time due to restrictions brought about by a failure of the local power source on the second day of the operation. Use of the team's amplifiers were also limited for the same reason. Band breakdowns are as follows: 375 QSOs on 10 metres, 572 on 12, 3361 on 15, 1935 on 17, 4219 on 20, 947 on 30, 1904 on 40, 1327 on 80, 659 on 160. Zones breakdowns are as follows (zones/QSOs made): 1-6/10455, 7-13/257, 14-17/1845, 18-21/40, 22-23/7, 24/8, 25/2236, 26/7, 27/14, 28/8, 29/15, 30/141, 31/100, 32/118, 33-39/47, 40/1. Two of the goals of the operation were to allow Europe and East Coast North America access to North Cook not only as a new country, but also to provide as much low band activity as possible. All in all the group accomplished its goals in providing that low band activity (almost 4000 QSOs on 40, 80 and 160 metres) and at the same time worked as much Europe as possible with over 1800 EU QSOs. On RTTY almost half of the total FSK QSOs were with European stations. Like any operation of this size the expenses are considerable. Donations are still welcome and can be forwarded to the QSL manager, WA4YBV (Robert Pond, 9 River Cove, Portsmouth, VA 23703, USA).
