Three operators have dropped out of the expedition, and the current roster includes F2JD, HB9BXE, K0IR, K3NA, K4SV, K4UEE, K9SG, LA6VM, N2WB, N4GRN, N6OX, NP4IW, OH2BH, OH2PM, PA5M, UA3AB, VK4GL and W0RUN. They expected to be underway from Ushuaia, Argentina on 11 February. Another vessel (the "Cavendish Sea"), another helicopter and a very experienced pilot have been contracted, and the team should be able to hold to the most recently announced schedule.
