3A - Special event call 3A50ARM will be aired on all bands and modes from Monaco on 15-30 November to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Association des Radio amateurs de Monaco (ARM). QSL via bureau. [TNX 3A2LF]

3X - Vlad, UR5WCW reports that Leo, 3XY1L plans to operate as 3XY1L/p from Rooma Island (AF-051) on 30 November. Look for him on 10 metres between 11 and 16 UTC.

3Y_p1 - The January 2004 DXpedition to Peter I [425DXN 645] has been postponed until January 2005. "A last minute glitch developed in the transportation plan", Bob, K4UEE and Ralph, KOIR report. "Weather windows precluded a rescheduling for 2004", but "the 2005 expedition will be bigger and better!"

4U_un - Ray, W2RE and Frank, W2IX will be active from the United Nations HQ station (4U1UN) on 9 November. They plan to operate SSB and CW on all HF bands. [TNX W2RE]

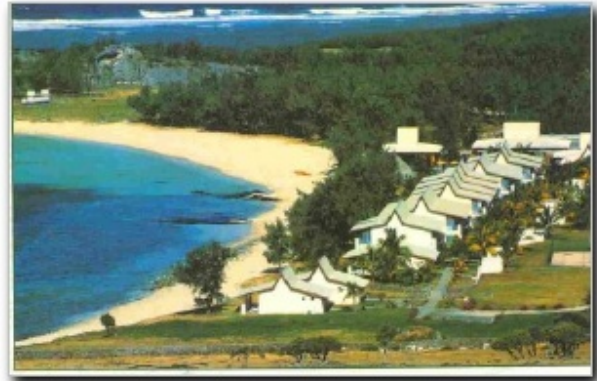

The Five Star DXers Association, of 9M0C (February 1998) and D68C (February 2001) fame, has announced "Project Star Reach", a large-scale DXpedition to Rodrigues Island (AF-017). A multinational team (so far including DL7AKC, EI5DI, GOMRF, G0OPB, G3NUG, G3BJ, G3IZD, G3NHL, G3RAU, G3SED, G3WGV, G3WKL, G3XTT, G4FRE/WW2R, G4JKS, G4KIU, G4TSH, G4VXE, GU4YOX, JA1RJU, JH4RHF, KF7E, MODXR, M0GMT, N7CQQ, NK7C and W3EF) will operate as 3B9C for over three weeks, including four weekends. The first members of the team will arrive on 15 March, and expect to spend the first two to three days installing antennas and equipment. Station breakdown will start on 12 April, though operations may continue for a further day or two after that. 3B9C will have up to fifteen high-power HF stations active simultaneously when band conditions allow. Activities will encompass SSB, CW, RTTY, PSK31 and, as appropriate, FM. There will also be satellite activity and possible EME. Large monoband antennas will be used on all bands, as the two main objectives are to provide the possibility for every amateur radio station in the world - even those running QRP or a very simple antenna - to make at least one contact with 3B9C; and to enable top DXers to put 3B9C in their log on as many bands and modes as possible. Project Star Reach is seeking contributions from sponsors to help defray the very significant logistics costs of this DXpedition. 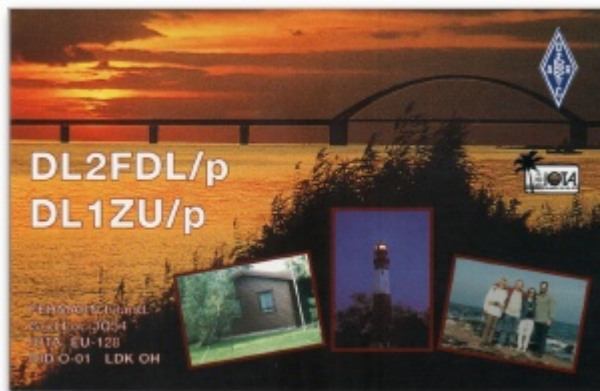

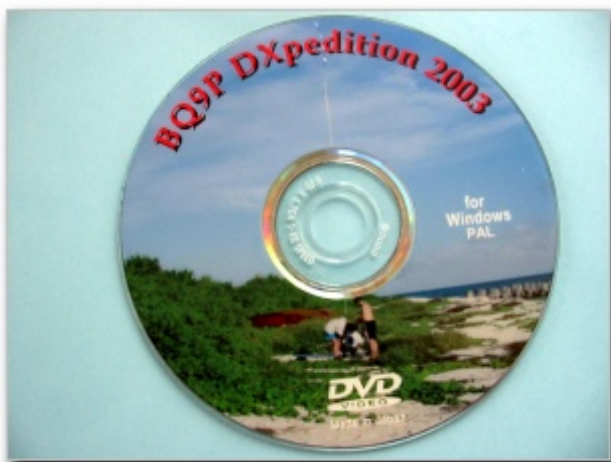

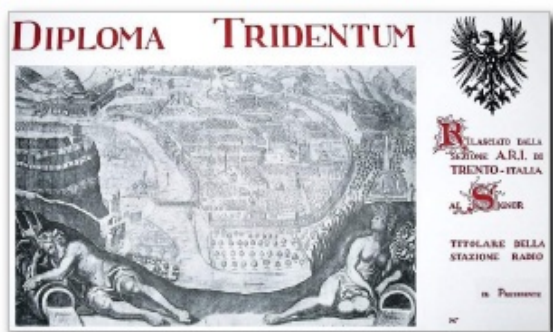

" Pickard, WA5PAE--SK

On Sunday, November 23rd, the DX community was saddened to learn that early that morning Billy G. "Pick" Pickard, WA5PAE, lost his battle with pulmonary fibrosis disease and became a Silent Key.

Prior to his death at the age of 68, Pick had a distinguished military career. In 1954, he joined the Air Force where he served in Tripoli, Libya; Ankara and Karamursel, Turkey; Germany; and Scotland. Subsequent assignments were to HQ, USAF Security Service; RAF Chicksands, Bedfordshire, England; and Viet Nam where he flew as a crew member on 101 combat missions in a rebuilt C-47 (Gooney Bird) loaded with advanced electronic warfare gear. Before retiring in 1977 after twenty-three years in the Air Force, Pick was assigned to the National Security Agency for four years.

Pick held an Extra Class license and was an accomplished CW operator who had the ability to copy through very difficult conditions.

Throughout his life, Pick was an avid DXer. He operated from Germany as DL4IZ and for the past three years Pick and friend Jay, K4ZLE, made three DXpeditions to Guantanamo Bay where Pick operated as KG4IZ and Jay as KG4MO.

In 1997, Murphy Ratterree, W4WMQ, then president of the International DX Association, appointed Pick to the staff of the INDEXA Information Session where Pick dispensed DX and QSL information during the daily sessions. In 2002, Pick was elected vice president of INDEXA and continued in that capacity until his death.

On January 1st, 2003, Jim Weaver, K8JE, ARRL Great Lakes Division Director, appointed Pick to be the new Great Lakes Division DXAC Representative.

Pick was an Honor Roll Dixer and a member of the Southwest Ohio DX Association; the West Chester Amateur Radio Association; and The Greater Cincinnati Amateur Radio Association where he wrote a DX column for *The Mike and Key Newsletter*.

Pick is interred at the West Chester Township Cemetery and is survived by his wife of 43 years, Ethel Pickard; two daughters; and three grandchildren. Condolences may be forwarded to Ethel at 8063 Pepper Pike, West Chester, OH, 45069.
