# DX INFORMATION

**40** - Alex, UA3RF and Nick, RK3RB will be active holiday style as 40/UA3RF and 40/RK3RB from Montenegro between 21 July and 2 August. They will operate CW, SSB, PSK and RTTY on 40-10 metres. On 26-28 July they will be QRV as 40/UA3RF/p and 40/RK3RB/p from Sveti Nikola Island (EU-163), and will participate in the IOTA Contest. QSL via home calls, direct or bureau. [TNX UA3RF]

**5B** - Stavros, 5B4AFM and Philip, 5B4ZN will be active as 5B4AFM/p and 5B4ZN/p from Agios Georgios Island (AS-120) from around 16 UTC on 22 June until around 6 UTC on the 23rd. They will operate mainly CW on 40, 30 and 20 metres, with a focus on North America. QSL via home calls, direct or bureau. [TNX 5B4AFM]

**5R** - Flavio, IW2NEF will be active as 5R8NE from Nosy-Be (AF-057) on 16-30 July. He will operate holiday style on 40-10 metres SSB, IOTA Contest included. QSL via IK2DUW. [TNX IZ2DPX]

**C6** - Drew N2RFA (C6ABB), Gene K2KJI (C6ALC), Ivars KC4PX (C6APX) and Jay K2TTT (C6ATT) will be active from New Providence (NA-001) Bahamas on 8-15 June. He will be busy installing solar-powered HF equipment for medical and emergency use at communities on the Maniqui River and in the Amazon jungle. The project is being developed by Solidaridad Medica Espana ([www.solidaridadmedicacanaria.com](http://www.solidaridadmedicacanaria.com)) and Radioaficionados Sin Fronteras ([www.rsf-rwf.org](http://www.rsf-rwf.org)). He plans to be QRV as CP1XRM in his limited spare time with a 100-watt solar-powered station and a vertical antenna. [TNX EA5RM]

**CT7** - CT1BOP, CT1DIZ, CT1EEQ, CT1EGW, CT1EKD, CT1END, CT1IUA and CT4NH will participate in the IOTA Contest as CS5DX from Bugio Island (EU-040). QSL via bureau or direct

**F** - Special callsign TM8YT will be activated on 1-15 June as a tribute to Andre Fleury (F8YT), who became a SK on 4 February. Andre was well known in the amateur radio circle because his personal station was used for the filming of "If All the Guys in the World" (original title "Si tous les gars du monde") in 1956. **F** - Special event station TM5AR will be active on 5-19 June during the "Armada de Rouen", a large gathering of tall ships and historic sailing vessels that is held every five years on the banks of the Seine. QSL for this year's edition via F5IL. [TNX Les Nouvelles DX]

The suffix stands for Filles Du Roy (King's Daughters), and refers to the young French women who immigrated to New France as part of a program sponsored by Louis XIV to boost Canada's population. 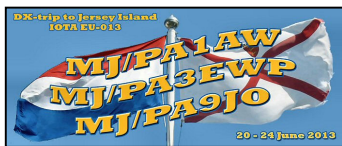
**FY** - Christian, F5UII ([www.f5uui.net](http://www.f5uui.net)) will be active as FY/F5UII from French Guiana on 5-14 June. He will operate SSB on the HF bands in his spare time. A side trip to Ile Royale (SA-020) is planned during the weekend of 8-9 June. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX F5UII]

**G** - Subject to prior authorisation, amateur radio operators in the United Kingdom may use special prefixes from 23 UTC on 4 July to 23 UTC on the 31st to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Radio Society of Great Britain (RSGB). The second letter in the existing call sign (D, I, J, M, U, W, etc, plus E for Intermediate licences) may be replaced by the letter "V"; where no second letter exists, the letter "V" may be added.



For instance, GD0XXX (Isle of Man), GI0XXX (Northern Ireland), GJ0XXX (Jersey), GM0XXX (Scotland), GU0XXX (Guernsey), GW0XXX (Wales) and G0XXX (England) may all be amended to GV0XXX. **GJ** - Look for Jo MJ/PA9JO, Alex MJ/PA1AW and Ronald MJ/PA3EWP to be active from Jersey (EU-013) on 20-24 June.

They will operate on all bands and modes from the Jersey Amateur Radio Society's club station. For all callsigns, QSL via PA1AW and LoTW. They have a webpage on [www.cfjfriends.com](http://www.cfjfriends.com) (search for mj2013). [TNX DX World]

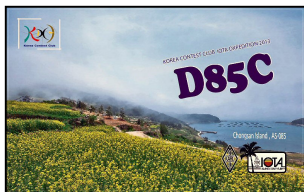

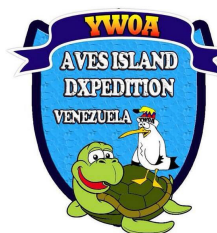

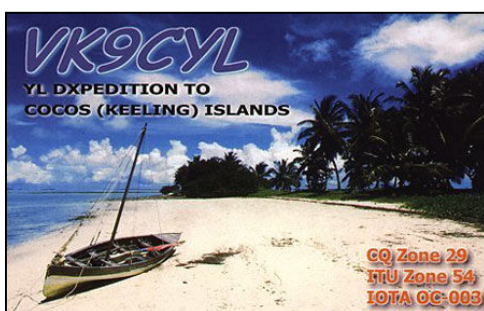

First licensed back in 1952 as WN6PVF, in 1984 - along with KL7HFQ and KL7KL - he conducted the first amateur radio license exam session under the Volunteer Examiner programme. He was inducted into the CQ Amateur Radio Hall of Fame in 2009.
- Domenico Marino (**IT9TAI**) passed away unexpectedly on 17 June from a heart attack. Born 1932 and licensed since 1950, he was a DXCC chaser with a penchant for CW, a 2m pioneer, an antenna designer and a co-founder and past president of ARI Palermo.

Update from the P5 Project Leadership Team**



P5 Project Team members Paul Ewing-N6PSE and David Flack-AH6HY have just returned from their extensive travels throughout the DPRK. Total distance covered was from Panmunjom at the DMZ in the South to Sonbong in the North, bordering China and Russia. Paul and David are among the first Western travelers to be allowed to enter the DPRK from Namyang and later exiting from Wonjong back into China.

The purpose of the visit was to meet with DPRK Government Representatives in Pyongyang and to survey and assess various potential Dxpediton venues throughout the country. Particular attention was paid to terrain and the availability of reliable power.

We are making further refinements to our proposals for a major Dxpediton. We will continue to communicate with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications to further refine our proposals. Our goals are to provide a much needed P5 contact to the entire amateur radio community world-wide.

We also enjoyed visits to several schools and we enjoyed the conversations that we had with the school children. We also were able to visit various factories throughout the country. Plans for a 2nd visit to the DPRK are already underway.

We are very pleased at this time to announce our partnership with the Chinese Amateur Radio Community and their involvement in the P5 Project. We have invited Fan Bin-BA1RB to join the P5 Project Leadership Team and to represent the Chinese Radio Amateur Community in our project.

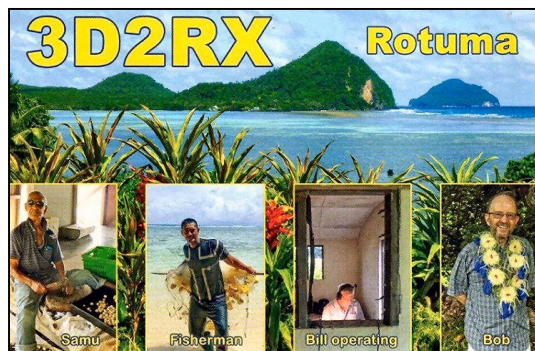

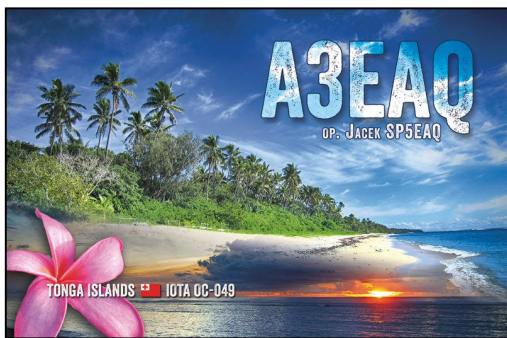

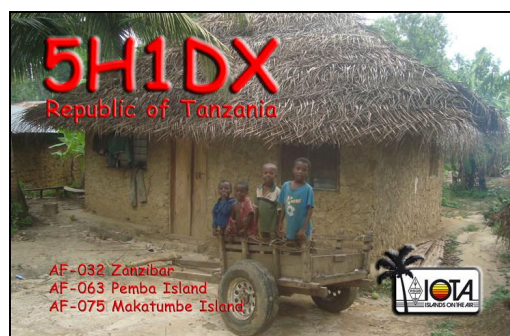
