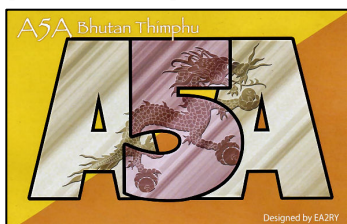

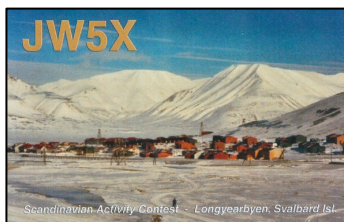

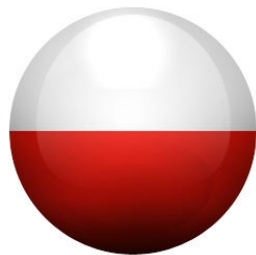

IOTA: PROPOSED ADDITIONS TO THE LIST OF VALID ISLAND GROUPS • On 31 August the following announcement was published on the IOTA website (<https://iota-world.org/>): "IOTA Programme Structure A.4.2 in the 2018 Directory provides for a review of the list of valid island groups to take place every five years. The last such occasion took place in June 2014 with the announcement made at the 50th anniversary celebration of IOTA's launch the following month. It resulted in 11 new groups being added.

This time IOTA Management has decided to bring forward the review to give a chance for any new groups announced to be activated in 2019, the target year. The review process is scheduled to start with an announcement of some additions at this year's RSGB Convention and may possibly finish with a top-up at next year's Friedrichshafen Ham Radio event.

Any new groups will be very few in number, probably between 5 and 10. It should be noted that only proposals that meet the programme criteria at Sections B and C of the IOTA Programme Structure chapter (2018 Directory) will be considered and, as guidance, it is unlikely that any additions will be made to the Europe list because it is already generously covered. Proposals for consideration should be sent to G3KMA (g3kma[[@jds1.pipex.com](mailto:g3kma@jds1.pipex.com)]) by 1 October with a short justification (one paragraph please) in terms of the programme criteria". RI0B

- The "Apostol Andrey" departed from Arkhangelsk around 6 UTC on 27 August. The voyage to Dikson Island, where the rest of the team will join the expedition, will take about eight days. Along all the way the RI0B team will be operating as RT9K/mm from the yacht. Read the DXpedition's diary on http://legendsarctic.com/dnevnik_ekspedicii_ri0b.
- The team departed from Dikson on 7 September at 2 UTC, but owing to an incoming storm, they had to change their plans. They landed on Tyrtov Island (AS-121) and were QRV on 10-12 September while waiting for the storm to subside. Then they set sail to the Firnley Islands (AS-054), and started operations on 13 September. Plans are to be QRV until the 15th, and then reach their next destination (Nansen Island, AS-104).

- The team was QRV from Nansen Island (AS-104) for about 43 hours on 16-18 September. Their main generator failed, and they were limited to 100 watts during the second day. They set sail to the Arkticheskogo Instituta Islands (AS-087) afterwards, and started operations around 12 UTC on 20 September. This is the fourth and last island stop of the trip. Plans are to remain QRV until 21 September in the morning (local time), then head to Dikson and Arkhangelsk. The yacht must be back in Sankt-Peterburg by mid-October, and there is not time for the team to go and operate from the Scott-Hansen Islands (AS-068) and Sibirjakov (AS-005). VP6D



"The Ducie Island 2018 project is on schedule", the VP6D team reported on 2 September, and "the equipment is now at Tauranga, New Zealand, stored in the Braveheart's warehouse.

A real challenge for DXpedition teams on uninhabited islands is knowing where in the world they're being heard. The usual pilot reports tell us what happened, not what's happening, propagation predictions tell us what might happen. We understand that propagation may produce only short openings from Ducie Island to many locations around the world. For example, it's not unusual for an EU opening to occur but EU callers are covered up by callers from other geographies. Until propagation changes for the better the EU stations can't get through. We have therefore augmented our pilot process to quickly identify these openings and get this information to the VP6D operators so they can exploit them. We're confident this new capability will result in more timely coverage of difficult paths".

The DXpedition to Ducie Island will be QRV on 6m EME for the first time ever. Operation is planned for 50.200 MHz, with VP6D transmitting during the first period JT65A mode. If local QRM from the HF stations requires any change from this frequency, it will be announced on the ON4KST EME Chat page. VP6D intends to be active at Ducie moonrise on most days, and occasionally during moonset. Lance, W7GJ gives more information and instructions on <https://vp6d.com/index.php/news/226-6m-eme>.

The team has also announced that Bob Schmieder, KK6EK has offered the use of DXA (<http://www.dxa3.org/vp6d/>), which allows anyone with an ordinary browser anywhere to see updates about the expedition activities, particularly the radio log, in nearly real time. Within 60 seconds of your contact with VP6D, the browser page is automatically updated to show your callsign, this confirms that your contact is in the log. This process (1) eliminates the need for duplicate contacts on the same band/mode, (2) minimizes the confusion caused by pirates or other DXpeditions operating at the same time, and (3) significantly reduces, or eliminates, the hundreds of e-mails asking for "log checks".

As for the traditional logsearch, VP6D will not use Club Log, but will upload the logs to the website (<https://vp6d.com/index.php/logsearch-oqrs>) on a daily basis.

The cost of the VP6D project is about USD 175,000. "To date, we are at 87% of our donation target", the team reported on 21 September. "Our goal is all donations plus OQRS income will cover 50% of the project cost, with the team members paying the remaining 50%. There's still time for you to join the hundreds of DXers, and many foundations, clubs and corporate entities already on the list". See <https://www.vp6d.com/>.

A couple of months ago Facebook updated an API used by third-party applications that allowed for cross-posting. The change breaks this functionality and Twitter users are no longer be able to create a Tweet and share it easily to their Facebook page. "We have arranged for tweets to be transferred to VP6D's Facebook page", the VP6D team said on 27 September. "However, due to time zone differences there may be a delay between Twitter and Facebook updates. If you follow us on Twitter (@VP6D_2018) you'll receive our tweets without delay".

The "Braveheart" is ready to sail, and the VP6D team is ready to soon begin their journey. Follow the ship's progress on <https://share.garmin.com/vp6d>. The function will be activated on 16 October and will remain active until the team returns to Mangareva on 6 November.

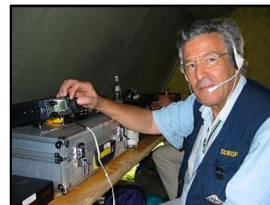
