# DX INFORMATION

Owing to the ongoing and fluid nature of the COVID-19 situation globally, announced activities might be postponed or cancelled at any time and without notice.

**4U\_UN** - The United Nations Amateur Radio Club will be active as 4U75UN to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the United Nations. «Currently there is no set operations schedule», *The Daily DX reports*, but the QSL manager (HB9BOU) «already has QSL cards ready». Located at the 42nd floor of the UN Headquarters in New York City, the station has its control point on the ground floor and can be operated remotely offsite.

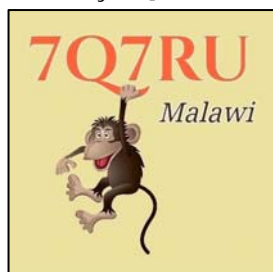
**4X** - 4X0AAP is a special callsign for the Israel Amateur Radio Club to celebrate the recently signed Abraham Accords Peace Agreement (the treaty of full normalization between the United Arab Emirates and Israel) between 16 October and 1 November. More than eighty operators will be QRV from their home stations, and will append a serial number to the special



callsign (4X0AAP/1, 4X0AAP/2, etc). QSL via 4X6ZM.

**4X** - Special event station 4XORMN will be active on 13-14 November from Makhtesh Ramon (Ramon Crater), Israel's largest national park. QSL via 4X6ZM, LoTW and eQSL.

**7Q** - Don, K6ZO has been active again as 7Q6M from the Embangweni Mission Hospital in Malawi since 7 October. He will remain in the country and be QRV in his spare time until 5 December. QSL direct to home call. [TNX The Daily DX]



**7Q** - Russian Robinson Club's members RA1ZZ, R7AL and RZ3K plan to be active as 7Q7RU from near Embangweni, Malawi on 7-18 November. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8 (F/H mode) on 160-10 metres with three stations and a focus on the low bands. QSL via Club Log/OQRS and LoTW. See

**8Q** - Depending on travel restrictions, Remo, HB9SHD will be active holiday style as 8Q7RM from Kandolhu, Maldives (AS-013) on 2-29 November. He expects to operate SSB, digital modes and some CW.

**9G** - Tom, DL2RMC has been active as 9G5FI from Ghana since 3 October, and will remain in the country for one year at least. He operates CW, FT8 and SSB on all bands, including the QO-100 satellite. QSL via DL1RTL (direct or bureau) and logsearch on Club Log. [TNX The Daily DX]

**9M2** - Yoshida, JE1SCJ is currently active as 9M4DXX from the MARTS' station on Penang Island (AS-015), West Malaysia until the end of the year. Apparently his plans are to concentrate on the low bands FT8 during the weekends. QSL direct to JAODMV. [TNX DX World]

**9M2** - 9M4S, the amateur radio station of the World Scout Bureau, will be activated this weekend from Kuala Lumpur (West Malaysia) during the 63rd Jamboree On The Air (JOTA).

**9M6** - Saty, JE1JKL will be active again as 9M6NA (East Malaysia) during the CQ WW DX SSB (24-25 October). He will be QRV on 40-10 metres; the station will be re-

motely operated, thus this activity will not be eligible for IOTA credit. QSL via LoTW and Club Log's OQRS. [TNX NG3K]

**A6** - Similarly celebrating the Abraham Accords Peace Agreement, the Emirates Amateur Radio Society will be active as A60AAP between 16 October and 1 November. QSL via EA7FTR. Also look for A60AAP/1, A60AAP/2, etc. (see qrz.com for the QSL routes).



**CE** - Members of the Grupo de DX Pacifico Chileno (<https://www.cpdxcg.cl/>) will be active as XR500M on 1-31 October to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the discovery of the Strait of Magellan during the first global circumnavigation voyage. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or via XQ7UP.

**CE** - Members of the Grupo Magallanes DX from Punta Arenas will be active as CB500AM on 1 November to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the discovery of the Strait of Magellan. They will operate SSB on +/- 3685, 7138, 14230, 21330 and 28445 kHz. QSL VIA CE8PVT

**EA** - URE San Fernando (EA7URF) is participating in the official celebrations for the 500th anniversary of the first circumnavigation of the Earth [425DXN 1467]. The fourth in a series of AM500 special event stations representing a milestone of the voyage will be AM500ETS, to be active from 31 October to 8 November to memorialize Ferdinand Magellan's discovery of the Estrecho de Todos los Santos, later named after Magellan himself. QSL via EA7URF (bureau or direct), LoTW and eQSL. Previously active were AM500SEV (August 2019), AM500SAN (September 2019) and AM500ISJ (June 2020).

**CE** - Radio Club Copiapo (CE1CPI) will operate special callsign XR33M from 13 October to 13 November. Look for activity on 80-6 metres SSB, CW and digital modes. This operation commemorates the tenth anniversary of the Copiapo mining accident, when 33 miners were rescued after being trapped 700 metres underground in a copper-gold mine in the Atacama Desert for 69 days. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau; direct cards via LZ1JZ.



**CN** - 5E1EC is a special callsign that a group of friends will be using on 23-31 October in memory of the late Boumeهدي El Moujahid (CN8EC) who passed away on 16 September. QSL via RW6HS.

**CN** - Special callsign CN45MS will be active on 1-7 November from Oujda, Morocco to celebrate the 45th anniversary of the so-called Marche Verte (Green March). QSL via RW6HS.

**F** - Guillaume, F1IEH will be active as TM72WOW at various times between 3 October and 22 November. He will operate SSB, RTTY, FT8/FT4. QSL via home call. The special callsign memorializes the flights of Wilbur and Orville Wright at



Camp d'Aouvours near Le Mans in late 1908. [TNX F11EH]  
**F** - The Radio Club EME Phocéen, F5KDK will be active from Ile Ratonneau (EU-095) on 17-18 October for the Jamboree On The Air. The operators will be F4IDX, F4VSO and F5SDD, along with some 20 scouts and guides. Look for activity on 3690, 7090, 7190 and 14290 kHz. QSL via F5SDD.

**F** - Jerry, F4HJO will be active as F4HJO/p from Brehat Island (EU-074) on 17-24 October. He will operate mainly SSB on 80, 40, 20 and 17 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), LoTW, or via home call (direct or bureau).

**F** - Commemorating the 75th anniversary of the creation of the United Nations, Franck, F4FHM and Dany, F0GFI will be active as TM75ONU on 17-31 October. They will operate SSB and FT8 on the HF bands and 2 metres. QSL via eQSL only.

**F** - The Radio Club Vendeen (F6KUF) will be active as TM9VG on 1-15 November to celebrate the ninth edition of the Vendée Globe, which will set sail from Les Sables d'Olonne on 8 November. QSL via F6KUF (bureau) or F5OEV (direct). The Vendée Globe is the



only round-the-world single-handed yacht race that is sailed non-stop and without assistance.

**F** - Michel, F8GGZ will be active as TM50GDG on 9-22 November to commemorate the 130th anniversary of the birth and the 50th anniversary of the death of Charles de Gaulle, leader of the Free French Forces in World War II and later President of France. Look for activity on 160-20 metres SSB and CW. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau. [TNX F8REF]

**F** - Members of the Radio Club de Cestas (F6KUQ) will be active as TM30CDR on 14-22 November. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8/FT4 on 80-6 metres. QSL via F6KUQ. The special callsign marks World Children's Day, celebrated annually on 20 November. [TNX F6AJA]

**F** - Rodrigue, F8DFO will be active as TM1GC between 18 November and 2 December. The special callsign memorialises Carl F. Gauss (1777-1855), one of the most influential mathematicians of all time. QSL via F8DFO. [TNX F8REF]



**G** - Larry, G4HLN will be active as GB4CKS on 1-14 November. He will operate CW and some SSB on 40-10 metres. The special callsign commemorates the 85th anniversary of the death of Australian

record-setting aviator Sir Charles Kingsford Smith, who disappeared off the coast of Myanmar whilst attempting to break the England-Australia speed record (8 November 1935). QSL via G4HLN, direct or bureau.



**HC** - Members of the Azuay Radio Club (HC5ARC) will be active as HD200C from 31 October to 3 November in celebration of the 200th anniversary of the independence of the city of Cuenca. Look for activity on the HF bands and 6 metres

SSB, CW, FT8/FT4. QSL via operator's instructions.

**I** - The stations affiliated to the *Coordinamento Stazioni Marconiane Italiane*, which gathers amateur radio stations operating from historic Marconi sites located in Italy, will be active on 3 October to celebrate the 125th anniversary of the invention of radio. Weather and Covid-19 restrictions permitting, twelve stations are expected to be QRV: IY0CG, IY0GA (Sardinia), IY0IMD, IY0ORP, IY0TC, IY1MR, IY1SM, IY1SP, IY4FGM, IY5PIS, IY6GM and IY7M. A certificate will be available for working at least six stations; just send your QSO details to Pier Luigi Anzini, IK2UVR, ARI HF Award Manager (ik2uvr[@]ari.it).

**I** - Celebrating the 75th anniversary of the founding of the United Nations, the UN Global Service Center ARC (4U1GSC) in Brindisi will be active as 4U75B from 8 October to 31 December. DXCC wise, it counts for Italy. QSL via 9A2AA, direct or bureau.

**I** - ARI Firenze will run scout station I15BP during this weekend's Jamboree On The Air (JOTA). QSL via the bureau to IW5EGT.

**I** - Once again special callsign IR3MD will be in use by ARI Rovereto on 1-30 November. The suffix stands for *Maria Dolens*, the mighty bell casted after World War I to commemorate the fallen in all wars. QSL via IN3MDR; information on the award



can be found on qrz.com.

**J8** - Oleh, KD7WPJ plans to be active as J8/UR5BCP from St. Vincent Island (NA-109) on 21-28 November. He will operate FT8, FT4, CW and SSB on 40-6 metres. QSL via KD7WPJ (direct or bureau); digimodes QSOs will be uploaded to LoTW. [TNX KD7WPJ]

**JD1\_mt** - Take, JG8NQJ will be back to the weather station on Minami Torishima (OC-073) from 14 October until mid-January 2021, his QSL manager reports. Take will operate CW as JG8NQJ/JD1 in his spare time. QSL via JA8CJY (direct) or JG8NQJ (bureau).

**JW** - Look for JW7XK (QSL via LA7XK and LoTW), JW9DL (QSL via LA9DL and LoTW) and JW6VM (QSL via LA6VM) to be active from Longyearbyen (EU-026), Svalbard on 7-12 October. They will participate in the SSB leg of the Scandinavian Activity Contest (10-11 October).



Outside the contest JW7XK will operate via satellite, mainly on RS-44 using SSB and CW.

**LU\_ant** - Ramon, LU3HRS is active throughout October as LU1ZG from the Argentine Antarctic base General Belgrano II. «He is a novice operator, first time on the air», *The Daily DX* reports, «and is on the FT8 mode, QRV since 4 October with activity on 40 and 15m». QSL for this activity via LoTW, or by the bureau via LU4AA. Please note that this Antarctic base is located on the Bertrab Nunatak within the Confin Coast of Coats Land, and IOTA wise counts for AN-016 (not AN-011 as reported elsewhere).



**LX** - Look for Gerard LX/PA0PIW, Gert LX/PA2LO, Maarten LX/PA3EYC, Tijmen LX/PA3GRM, Hans LX/PE1KWH and Bert LX6/PD0GP to be active once again from Luxembourg on 15-18 October. They will operate CW,

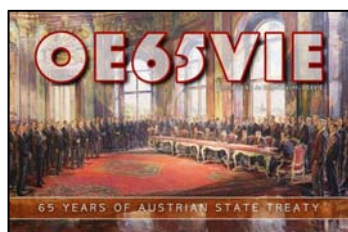
SSB, FT8, FT4 and RTTY. QSL via Club Log, LoTW or via PA3EYC. [TNX The Daily DX]



**OE** - 4U75A is the special call sign for the VIC Amateur Radio Contest DX Club in Vienna, Austria (4U1A, <http://www.cqdx.ru/4u1a/>) to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the United Nations until 31 December. QSL via

UA3DX.

**OE** - Celebrating the 65th anniversary of the Austrian State Treaty that re-established Austria as a sovereign state after World War II, OE65VIE (operated by OE6VIE, see qrz.com for QSL information) and OE65SGU (operated by OE3SGU, QSL via LoTW and eQSL only)

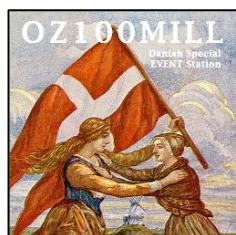


are active until 31 December.

**ON** - Within a decade after the end of World War I, the devastated Westhoek region of Belgium rose like a Phoenix from its ashes, and by the end of the 1920s the reconstruction was largely completed. UBA Sections ARA from Gullegem and IPR from Ypres will join the Feniks 2020 campaign (<https://www.flandersfields.be/en/feniks2020>) and be active as OP2OFENIKS throughout November, especially over the weekends

and on Remembrance Day (11 November). They will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on the HF and VHF bands. QSL via ON5YL, direct or bureau.

**OX** - OZ1DJJ's flight to Tasiilaq Island (NA-151) [425DXN 1534] was delayed, so on 26-28 September Bo was active as OX3LX from the main island of Greenland (NA-018). He now expects to be QRV from NA-151 until 3 October. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via OZ0J.



**OZ** - Commemorating the 100th anniversary of the unification of Southern Jutland with Denmark in 1920, EDR (the Danish IARU society) will activate special call sign OZ100MILL on all bands and modes from 15 October to 15 December. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW and eQSL. A certificate will be available; see <https://www.qrz.com/DB/OZ100MILL> for information.

**P4** - Members of the Aruba Amateur Radio Club are active again as P42WW until 31 October to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the end of World War II. QSL via P41G and LoTW.

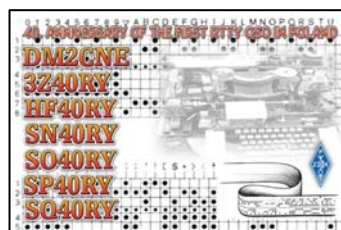


**PZ** - Markus, DJ4EL has had to postpone his trip to Suriname owing to COVID-19 new travel restrictions. He had planned to be QRV as PZ5GE from mainland Suriname between 12 and 24 October, and as PZ5G from Papegaaien Island (SA-092) on 16-19 October [425DXN 1523]. **SM** - Palle, SA0BYP and Johan, SA3BYC will be active from SI9AM (the King Chulalongkorn Memorial Amateur Radio Society's station) in Ragunda, Sweden on 10-11 October for the SSB leg of the Scandinavian Activity Contest. QSL via SM3FJF, direct or bureau.

**SV** - Markus, DJ4EL has been active as SV8/DJ4EL since 13 October, and will remain QRV until 22 October. He is visiting the islands of Kythira, Antikythira and Makrokythira, which all count for IOTA group EU-113. He operates SSB mainly on 40, 20, 17 and 15 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS

**SV** - Nine multi-operator special event stations - namely SX1A, SX2A, SX3A, SX4A, SX5A (Dodecanese), SX6A, SX7A, SX8A and SX9A (Crete) - will be active during the countdown to the 200th anniversary of the Agonas (the Struggle), the Greek Revolution of 1821 which led to the formation of modern

**VP9** - Jeff, N1SNB will be active as VP9/N1SNB from Bermuda (NA-005) on 21-26 October. QSL via home call and LoTW. Main activity will be as VP9I (QSL via LoTW and WW3S) during the CQ WW DX SSB Contest. [TNX NG3K]

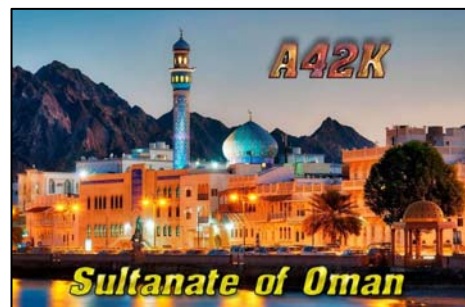

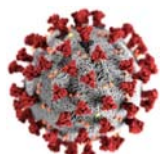

**BANDS ALIVE: THE 2021 CW/SSB ULTRA-MARATHON** • The True Blue DXers Club announces *Bands Alive*, a year-long “ultra-marathon” to be run from 1 January through 31 December 2021. «As the new solar cycle is now under way and conditions on the HF bands are expected to gradually improve throughout 2021, this unprecedented initiative is launched to give DXers a further motivation to get on the air and therefore support, improve and promote amateur activity using person-to-person modes of communication such as CW and SSB. This initiative, which we call “ultra-marathon” for a reason, is indeed unpre-

cedented - its aim, reflected in its format, is to get people on the air and make as many unique contacts as possible over the duration of a full year, and not simply to work as many countries as possible». Participation is open to all amateurs: you do not need to sign up for TBDXC membership, but you have to register for the marathon on the dedicated section of the TBDXC website: <https://www.tbdxc.net/marathon>.

**IARU NEWS** • «The Administrative Council (AC) of the International Amateur Radio Union (IARU, <https://www.iaru.org>) held its annual meeting on 8-10 October 2020. The AC is responsible for the policy and management of the IARU and consists of the three IARU international officers and two representatives from each of the three IARU regional organizations.

Originally planned to take place in Novi Sad, Serbia, just before the IARU Region 1 Conference in that city, both the AC meeting and the conference had to be held virtually owing to Covid-19 travel restrictions. The virtual meeting format had the benefit of allowing participation by additional observers from the regional organizations and real-time presentations of reports to the AC from the specialized IARU coordinators and advisors.

Recently appointed EMC Coordinator Dr. Martin Sach (G8KDF) reported on what is being done on behalf of the IARU in CISPR, the International Special Committee on Radio Interference. Martin and his predecessor, Tore Worren (LA9QL), continue to work together to address the need for reasonable standards to limit the increasing threat of radio spectrum pollution from proliferating digital devices and wireless power transmission.

IARU Beacon Project Coordinator Peter Jennings (AB6WM/VE3SUN) reported on the status of the HF time-shared beacon network that is supported by the Northern California DX Foundation and the IARU. He explained recent and planned upgrades and the many applications and uses being made of the network.

Satellite Advisor Hans Blondeel Timmerman (PB2T) described the work of the Satellite Frequency Coordination Panel. Steps are being taken to address the growing number of non-amateur satellites using amateur-satellite spectrum.

Special Advisor for Emergency Communications Rod Stafford (W6ROD) explained his work representing the IARU in the ITU Development Sector (ITU-D), particularly with regard to disaster communications, and preparations for the World Telecommunication Development Conference scheduled for November 2021. He highlighted an opportunity to promote amateur radio in ITU-D as a training platform for youth.

Preparations are already underway for the next World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), currently expected to be held in 2023. A team of some 20 IARU volunteers from all continents led by IARU Vice President Ole Garpestad (LA2RR) is engaged in the preparatory processes of the ITU and the regional telecommunications organizations (RTOs). The AC reviewed a draft of preliminary IARU positions on the WRC-23 agenda items of concern to the amateur and amateur-satellite services. The Action Plan for the remainder of 2020 and 2021 was reviewed; it will be subject to continual adjustment in response to the continuing impact of the pandemic on international travel.

In 2019 a committee was formed to address the growing pressure on amateur spectrum allocations, particularly the secondary allocations, at 144 MHz and above. The committee reported on its work to date in defining present and future spectrum requirements. Additional information will be sought from the amateur community on how this spectrum is being utilized.

The AC received and discussed an in-depth report from its Working Group on the Future of IARU and agreed to steps for evolving toward a more flexible organization and strengthened relationships with all stakeholders in the global amateur radio

community and telecommunications ecosystem.

An application for IARU membership from the Amateur Radio Union of the Kyrgyz Republic was received and will be submitted to the member-societies for approval.

Noting the many ways that the global amateur radio community has responded positively to the challenges posed by the pandemic, the AC agreed to develop a related theme for World Amateur Radio Day, 18 April 2021.

AC members attending the meeting were IARU President Tim Ellam (VE6SH/ G4HUA), Vice President Ole Garpestad (LA2RR), Secretary David Sumner (K1ZZ), regional representatives Don Beattie (G3BJ), Hans Blondeel Timmerman (PB2T), Ramon Santoyo (XE1KK), George Gorsline (VE3YV), Wisnu Widjaja (YB0AZ) and Ken Yamamoto (JA1CJP). Participating as observers were regional executive committee members Sylvain Azarian (F4GKR), Mats Espling (SM6EAN), Jose Arturo Molina (YS1MS), Jay Bellows (KOQB) and Peter Young (VK3MV), and IARU Assistant Secretary Joel Harrison (W5ZN).

Additional virtual meetings of the AC will be scheduled in the coming months. It is hoped that an in-person meeting can be held in October 2021».

**IOTA NEWS** • The logs for the IOTA Contest 2020 island stations have now been added to the IOTA database and are available for QSO matching. Record-holders who have made IOTA contacts in an IOTA contest after 2003, can claim credit for them without submitting QSLs, provided that the contact details match. Go to <https://iota-world.org/>, log in, select ADD CONTEST QSOs under the MY IOTA tab, and choose either UPLOAD CONTEST LOG or MANUAL QSO ENTRY.



**JXØX: CANCELLED** • The DXpedition to Jan Mayen (18 September-2 October 2021) has been cancelled. «While we worked hard for 18 months to secure the entry permit, the permit to stay onshore, the fund-raising and the logistics - we have come to the conclusion that there are too many uncertainties involved in this project», the JXØX team announced on 26 October. «There is not a single reason that we cancel, but rather several reasons right up to today that altogether makes this a difficult project to complete. We would like to thank everybody who donated upfront to the JXØX DXpedition, and who believed in our team and our project. You all made a contribution to have the opportunity to work us guys next year, and you all made a difference no matter what you donated. It is people like you who donated upfront that makes DXing happen. Without upfront donations we will see less tent and generator DXpeditions to expensive places. We will start refunding 100% all PayPal donations, and you should see your support returned soon».

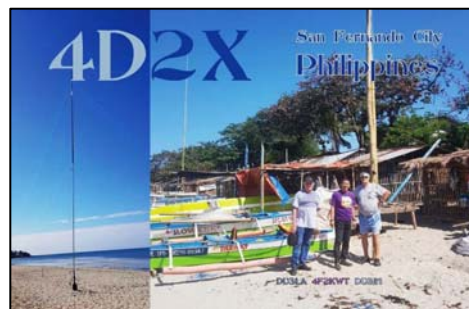

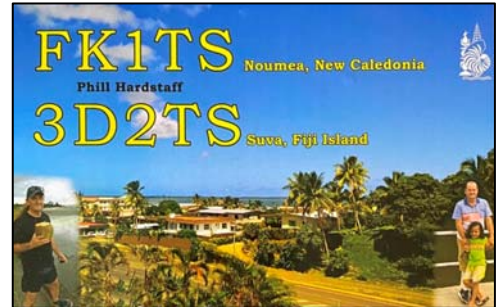

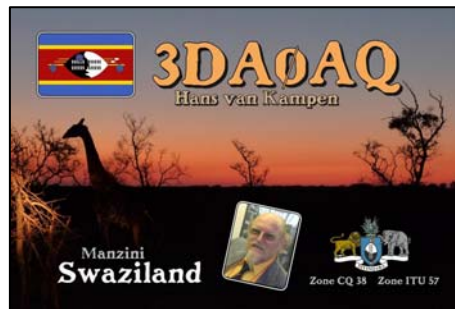
