



DX INFORMATION



Owing to the ongoing and fluid nature of the COVID-19 situation globally, announced activities might be postponed or cancelled at any time and without notice.



3D2/R - Tony, 3D2AG will be active again as 3D2AG/p from Rotuma Island (OC-060). Departure is scheduled for 12 December, and return sometime around 10 January. The primary purpose of this trip is

to set up the tombstone memorial for his son Rehanisi (2009-2020), who lost his life during Tony's latest visit in January. QSLing instructions can be found on <https://www.qrz.com/db/3D2AG/P>.



4S - Amateur radio operators from Sri Lanka have been authorized to append /70 to their callsigns (e.g. 4S7VK/70) during the month of December to mark the 70th anniversary since the founding of the Radio Society of Sri Lanka (formerly known as the Radio Society of Ceylon). [TNX DX World]

4X - Members of the Holy Land DX Group will be active as 4X7T from the UNESCO World Heritage site of Tel Be'er Sheva (square F23BS for the Holyland Award) on 25-26 December. They will operate CW, FT8 and SSB on 80-10 metres with three stations. QSL via 4Z5LA.



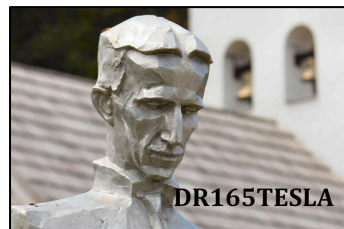
5T - Tom, DL7BO is expected to be active as 5T700 from Mauritania until around 20 December. He will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 on various bands, provided the airline can find the antenna mast that was missing when he arrived in Nouakchott on 9 December. QSL via DJ6TF (direct or bureau) and LoTW. [TNX The Daily DX]



5U - Adrien, F4IHM expects to be back in Niger and be active as 5UAIHM (not 5U4IHM as initially announced) early next year, possibly between 7 January and 11 February, The Daily DX reports. He will operate CW using a straight key on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via home call, direct or bureau.

CN - A team from the Association Royale des Radio-Amateurs du Maroc (ARRAM) will be active as CN1M between 24 and 31 December while travelling from the city of Casablanca to the outpost of Guerguerat through Moroccan Sahara. QSL direct to RW6HS.

CP - Once again Antonio, EA5RM will be working on a non-governmental organization's project in Bolivia on 9-26 January. In his spare time he will operate SSB and digital modes as CP1XRM. QSL via LoTW. [TNX OPDX Bulletin]

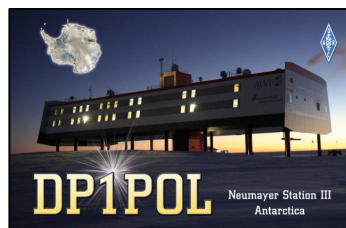


DL - Members of DARC Ortsverband Mainz (DL0MZ) will be active as DR165TESLA throughout 2021 to commemorate the 165th anniversary of the birth of Nikola Tesla (10 July 1856). QSL via DK8ZZ.

DL - Celebrating DARC Ortsverband Traunstein's 70th anniversary, special callsign DL70TRS will be active from 1 January to 31 December. QSL via the bureau.

DL - Celebrating DARC Ortsverband Salzgitter-Lebenstedt's 60th anniversary, special callsign DR60SZL will be active from 1 January to 31 December. QSL via the bureau, or direct to DJ9PH.

DL_ant - Felix, DL5XL will be a member of the Antarctic summer season's team at Neumayer III station. The RV *Polarstern* will be leaving Bremerhaven, Germany on 20



December, and during the long voyage Felix will operate mainly CW and digital modes as DP0POL/mm (QSL via DL5EBE). From mid-January to mid-March 2021, he expects to be QRV as DP1POL (QSL via DL1ZBO) from

Neumayer III. The club call DP0GVN (QSL via DL5EBE) may also be used by other operators: in particular Theresa, DC1TH, who will be part of the 2021-22 overwintering crew and will operate DP0GVN via the QO100 satellite. [TNX DX World]

EA - In celebration of the 40th anniversary since its foundation, URE San Fernando will be active as EG40URF on 5-6 and 12-13 December. QSL via EA7URF.

EA - Special callsign AO50UPC will be active on 15-30 December to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya (Polytechnic University of Catalonia). A certificate will be available for download: <http://50aniversario-upc.dxfun.com>.

F - TM110P is a special callsign for Les Emetteurs Biterrois (F6KEH) to pay a tribute to Louis Paulhan (1883-1963) between 28 November and 12 December. Paulhan was a pioneering French aviator, known for winning the first *Daily Mail* aviation prize for the first flight between London and Manchester in 1910. QSL via the

bureau to F6KEH.

F - Special callsign TM8AA will be active during the first weekends of January, February, March, April, May and June to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the first officially assigned amateur radio callsign in France (8AA, issued to Andre Riss from Boulogne-sur-Mer). QSL via eQSL, or direct to F5SLD.

G - GB100H (Golf Bravo One Oscar Oscar Hotel) is a special callsign for the Hull and District Amateur Radio Society to celebrate its centenary throughout 2021. QSL via MOGPN.

HB9 - In celebration of the 40th anniversary of the International Police Association Radio Club's Swiss Section, special event station HB40POLICE will be active from 1 January to 31 December. QSL via the bureau or eQSL.

I - I10MMI, I11MMI, I12MMI, I17MMI, I19MMI, I00MMI (Sardinia), I09MMI, I10MMI, I17MMI, I18MMI and I19MMI will be active from 1 January to 31 December to celebrate the 160th anniversary of the Italian Navy

(Marina Militare Italiana). QSL via operator's instructions. See <http://www.assoradiomarinai.it/> for more information.

I - Defined by Gabriele D'Annunzio as «the white ship that sails through miracles and animates the ethereal silences of the world», the *Elettra* was Guglielmo Marconi's steam yacht, from which he conducted many experiments with wireless telegraphy, wireless telephony and other communication and direction-finding techniques. ARI Fidenza will use a series of special callsigns



throughout 2021 to commemorate twelve major events related to the ship: I14BLD (January), I14BLY (February), I14RDF (March), I14DNZ (April), I14REG (May), I14SWE (June), I14DXS (July), I14MWS (August), I14SML (September), I14RDP (October), I14BLN (November) and I14DTH (December). JA - Kenji, JA4GXS will be active as JA4GXS/4 from Kasado Island (AS-117) on 5 December, between 7 and 22 UTC. He will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 40-15 metres. QSL via home call. [TNX DX World]

JD1_oga - Once again Harry, JG7PSJ will be active as JD1BMH from Chichijima (AS-031), Ogasawara from 14

OH - Special callsign OH100SRAL will be in use throughout 2021 to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the Finnish Amateur Radio League (SRAL), Finland's IARU member.

ON - The Belgian regulator has extended the expiry date for Covid-19 special callsigns O07STAYHOME, OP19MSF, OQ5BECLEVER, OR20STAYHOME, OT4LIFE and OT6SAFE until 31 January. Also active until 31 December 2020 is OR20STAYS SAFE.

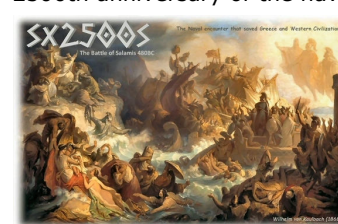
S5 - S520SAFE is a special callsign for members of Radioklub Elektron Brezice (S59ACP) to promote the "Be Safe Stay Safe" campaign in order to stop the spread of Covid-19. Look for activity between 8 December and 31 January 2021. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or direct only to S56IPS.

SM - The Boras Radioamatorer Club (SK6LK) will be active as SF400B from 1 January to 31 December to celebrate the 400th anniversary since Boras received its city privileges (29 June 1621). QSL via LoTW and the bureau. Realtime logbook and map to keep track of the countries they work can be found at <https://www.sf400b.se/>.

SM - 7S60BQ is the special callsign for the Kristianstad Radioamateur Club (SK7BQ) to celebrate its 60th anniversary throughout 2021. QSL via SM7BHM and LoTW.

SV - Special callsign SX40ARES will be active on 5-20 December to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Hellenic Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES). QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, eQSL, or via the bureau.

TI - David, KM3A and Scott, N0OI will be active from Costa Rica on 3-9 January. Plans are to climb and be QRV as TI2/AB3G, TI3/AB3G and

BANDS ALIVE: THE 2021 CW/SSB ULTRA-MARATHON • The True Blue DXers Club announces *Bands Alive*, a year-long “ultra-marathon” to be run from 1 January through 31 December 2021. «As the new solar cycle is now under way and conditions on the HF bands are expected to gradually improve throughout 2021, this unprecedented initiative is launched to give DXers a further motivation to get on the air and therefore support, improve and promote amateur activity using person-to-person modes of communication such as CW and SSB. This initiative, which we call ‘ultra-marathon’ for a reason, is indeed unprecedented - its

aim, reflected in its format, is to get people on the air and make as many unique contacts as possible over the duration of a full year, and not simply to work as many countries as possible». Participation is open to all amateurs: you do not need to sign up for TBDXC membership, but you have to register for the marathon on the dedicated section of the TBDXC website: <https://www.tbdxc.net/marathon>. Official registration will be opened on 31 December, so that starting at 00.00 UTC on 1 January 2021 everybody can start entering their results.



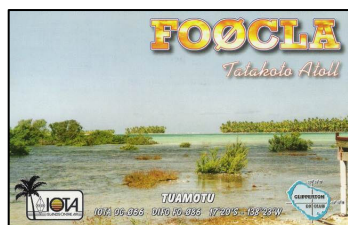
CQ DX MARATHON • The CQ DX Marathon is a year-long DX hunt, with participants competing to see who can work the greatest number of countries (“entities”) and CQ zones during the calendar year. The 2021 edition will start at 00.00 UTC on 1 January and will end at 23.59 UTC on 31 December. Complete details

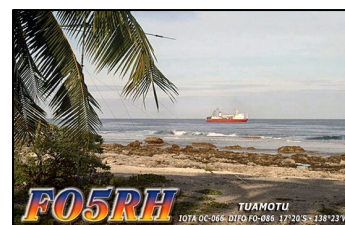


IOTA NEWS: 2021 HONOUR ROLL & ANNUAL LISTING • The last date for sending score updates to checkpoints, both online or by QSL cards, for inclusion in the 2021 Honour Roll and Annual Listings is 31 January 2021. If cards are postmarked after that date, they will be processed in the normal way, but the scores will be held over to the following year’s listing. The current disruption to postal services as a result of coronavirus suggests that, where cards are to be sent, they should be sent in good time to enable credit to be given. Participants who have not updated since the 2016 annual listings and wish to remain listed should make a submission before 31 January 2021. Furthermore, those who have not logged into their record for more than two years, will need to

revalidate their registration through info@iota-world.org. Do not leave it to the last moment as you may run out of time. [TNX G3KMA]



IOTA NEWS: OC-298 • «New IOTA OC-298, Tatakoto Atoll has now been confirmed following the opening up of QSO matching on LoTW for contacts with Cezar, VE3LYC’s recent TX0T operation (30 October-5 November 2020)», IOTA General Manager Roger Balister (G3KMA) posted to the IOTA website on 10 December (<https://iota-world.org/management-news.html>). «This has enabled credits made previously with the island by FO5RH, FO0CLA and TX5TES and credited to OC-066 to be transferred to the new number OC-298 where the evidence is clear. Record holders may wish to check if they now need to restore credit for OC-066 with a replacement card. Requests arising from this change of group number should be made using the normal update procedure through checkpoints».

KH6VV/KH4 • «Recently the US Fish & Wildlife Service became uncomfortable with our proposed expedition date [second half of February 2021, Ed.] due to the forecast of a second virus wave», Ron, KH6DV posted to KH6VV’s qrz.com page on 20 December. «We are now in that second wave, and the latest news is that Europe is seeing a new strain of the virus that is 70% more contagious. We agreed to change the date to September 2021 and submit a new Supplemental Use Permit application. A new management team is expected on-island once the holidays are over. Once that team is in place, we will submit our revised application».

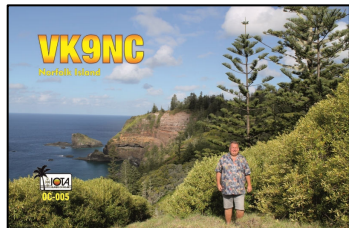
OH8X NODE ACTIVITY • «As part of the Yasme Foundation project to provide additional Reverse Beacon Network nodes in underserved areas, equipment has been provided to a team in northern Finland. The latest node to become active is currently hosted by Radio Arcala (OH8X), very close to the Lapland (OH9) Region.

A mysterious propagation mode called Polar Path exists in Northern Europe during the winter season. At and above the Arctic Circle in the middle of the night this propagation offers a footprint covering the entire North American continent for many hours. This occurs in spite of the stations being within the Aurora Oval. Only 100 miles to the south, there is no such propa-

gation at all. Carl Luetzelschwab, K9LA, has tentatively studied the Polar Path and expects that two independent propagation scenarios need to co-exist to create this interesting path. The OH8X RBN node would further help the study of the Polar Path in which Radio Arcala will be cooperating with the northern scientific community».

Launched on 22 December, the RBN node receiver is currently located at the Radio Arcala station, OH8X (65 11 03N - 26 14 53E), but may later move even farther north to be at the heart of this unique Auroral Region of the Arctic Circle. [TNX OH2BH]

QSL EP2HAM • Charles, M0OXO is the new QSL manager for Arash, EP2HAM. New, full colour QSL cards are being printed and will be available in early 2021. QSL via M0OXO's OQRS: <https://www.m0oxo.com/oqrs/logsearch.php>.



QSL VK9NC, VK9NE & VK9NG • «Unfortunately, due to the ongoing serious restrictions on the delivery of letters sent abroad (due to COVID) by Polish Post Office, and the fact that our cards sent to many countries returned with the words 'no delivery' (and stamps cancelled), our manager SP7VC had to resign from sending QSL cards from Poland», Jacek, SP5EAQ (ex VK9NE) says. «In this situation, Willi, DL8MAN came to our aid by successively sending cards from Mainburg. Willi always ensures delivery after making sure the country is served by the German Post Office. Previously, some cards could be delivered in bulk by road transport according to lists provided by the main sponsors». VK9NC, VK9NE and VK9NG were active from Norfolk Island in October-November 2019. 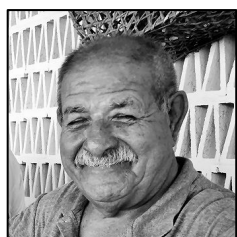
RAEM CONTEST • This year's RAEM Contest (<https://raem.srr.ru/>) will be held on 27 December, from 00.00 UTC until 11.59 UTC, on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres CW. Organized by the Russian Amateur Radio Union (SRR), the annual event memorializes Ernst T. Krenkel (1903-1971), the legendary Arctic explorer and radioman (callsign RAEM) on various polar stations and on the first drifting ice station North Pole-1.

RI0Q 2021 • The Arctic Legends Expedition 2021 [425DXN 1534] is set to start on 10 March from Talnakh (Norilsk). The trip to Bol'shoy Begichev Island (AS-152) will depend on weather, as the team will be using snowmobiles. Indicatively, RI0Q is expected to be QRV no sooner than 17 March. [TNX UA1QV]

SOLAR CYCLE 25 • «In direct contradiction to the official forecast, a team of scientists led by the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) is predicting that the Sunspot Cycle that started this fall could be one of the strongest since record-keeping began»: see <https://news.ucar.edu/132771/new-sunspot-cycle-could-be-one-strongest-record>. Marcello Cassinelli, IK2DIA passed away unexpectedly on 1 December. Between 2001 and February 2020 he teamed up with Silvano, I2YSB & Friends and operated from Niger (5U2K and 5U4R), Marquesas (TX4PG), Samoa (5W0SB), Tokelau (ZK3SB), Somalia (600CW and 600N), Djibouti (J20MM/J20RR), Sierra Leone (9L1X), Ghana (9G5TT/9G5XX), Togo (5V7TT), Liberia (5M2TT and A82X/A82Z), Ivory Coast (TU2T), Chad (TT8TT), Mayotte (TO2TT), Burkina Faso (XT2TT), Benin (TY1AA), Zambia (9J2T), Kenya (5Z0L), Democratic Republic of the Congo (9Q0HQ), Guinea (3XY1T), Guinea Bissau (J5T), Central African Republic (TL8TT), Cameroon (TJ2TT), Rwanda (9X0T/9X0Y), Uganda (5X3C/5X3E) and Tanzania (5I5TT/5I4ZZ). As a member of the Italian DXpedition Team he was inducted into the CQ DX Hall of Fame in 2019.



Halim Dani Hidayat, YB2CW passed away on 12 December. Born in 1963, he was first licensed as YD2DVM in 1982, then switched to YC2DVM (1984), YC2TJV (2003), YB2TJV (2007) and finally YB2CW in December 2018. He served as President of ORARI Lokal Kebumen and Chairman of the IARU Region 3 Disaster Communication Committee, and gave his services also to the Scout movement and the Indonesian Red Cross. Dani was renowned for producing logos for many major DXpeditions (e.g. K1N, Navassa 2015) and IOTA operations, as well as for organizations and individuals (e.g. the M0OXO QSL Manager and OQRS logos).



Franz Berndt, DL9GFB (ex Y25JA) passed away on 22 December, one day after his 68th birthday. The Chairman of DARC's Mecklenburg-Vorpommern District, over the past 25 years he participated in many DXpeditions, notably C56R & C53M (The Gambia 2002), 4S7FBG (Sri Lanka 2003), ZD7F (St. Helena 2004), VU4AN/VU3RYE (Andamans 2006), VU7RG (Lakshadweep 2007), VU7SJ (Lakshadweep 2008), VP2EFB (Anguilla 2008), 9N7AN (Nepal 2011), 5W0M (Samoa 2013), V73D (Marshall Islands 2015) and XX9D (Macao 2019). Most recently he was a team member of HU1DL (El Salvador, January-February 2020) and Z66DX (Kosovo, October 2020).

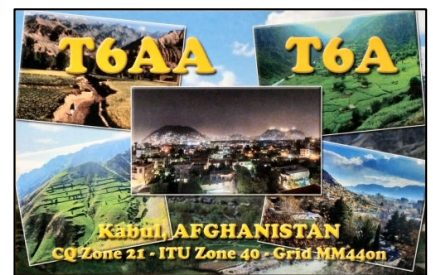

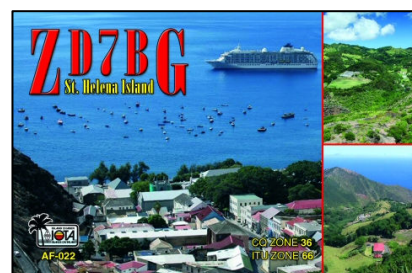
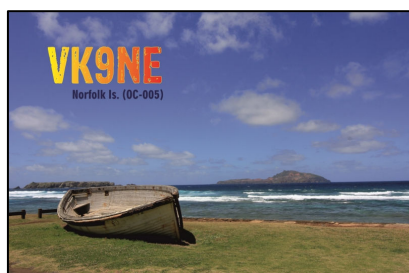
