



5B - Celebrating the 60th anniversary since the proclamation of Cyprus, all members of CARS (Cyprus Amateur Radio Society, <https://www.cyhams.org/wp/>) are allowed to replace their current prefix with 5B60 from 1 January until 31 December 2020. For instance, 5B4AIF will be active as 5B60AIF, 5B4AIX as 5B60AIX, 5B4ALJ as 5B60ALJ, 5B4ALX as 5B60ALX, 5B4AMR as 5B60AMR, 5B4AMT as 5B60AMT. See qrz.com for QSLing instructions.



5H - OK2WM, OM4AZF, OM5MF, OM5ZW and SP9LJD will be active as 5H4WZ from Pemba Island (AF-063), Tanzania on 6-18 February (<http://om7m.org/dxp-editions/pemba/>). They will operate CW, SSB, RTTY and FT8 on 160-10 metres, and will participate in the CQ WPX RTTY (8-9 February) and the ARRL DX CW (15-16 February) contests. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or via OM3PA.



7X - Three members of the Association des Radio Amateurs Tunisiens (3V1B/KG5OUE, 3V8CB and 3V8SS/KF5EYY) will join five members of Amateurs Radio Algeriens (7X2RO, 7X2TT/M0NPT, 7X3TL, 7X5FG and 7X5QB) and be active as 7X7X from 28 December to 2 January. They will operate CW, SSB and



FT8 with a focus on 160 and 80 metres using "decent antennas for TX and RX". 7X7X will use Club Log's Live Streams (<https://clublog.org/livestreams.php>). QSL via LoTW, or direct to Ben Lagha, 18 rue Louis Aragon, 26200 Montelimar France.

8Q - Sergey, RX3AMY will be active holiday style as 8Q7BS from the Maldives (AS-013) on 3-23 January. He will operate SSB and some CW on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via home call.



A5 - Zorro, JH1AJT will visit Bhutan again on 11-20 December. The main purpose of his trip is to have meetings with the Bhutan Olympic Committee and the Bhutan Paralympic Committee for Bhutan's participation in the 2020 Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Games. He will be joined by Franz DJ9ZB, Champ E21EIC, Adrian KO8SCA and Max ON5UR, who will be active as A50BOC, A50BPC and A5B on all bands CW, SSB, FT4 and FT8. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or via JH1AJT.

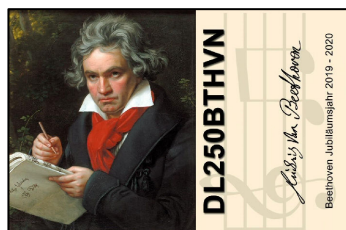
C5 - Carlo, ON4BR has been active as C56BR from The Gambia since 3 December, and is expected to remain there until 14 December. QSL direct to home call.

CE0Y - Oleh, KD7WPJ will be active as CE0Y/UR5BCP from Easter Island (SA-001) on 28-31 December. He will operate SSB, CW, FT8 & FT4 on 40-6 metres. QSL via KD7WPJ (direct or bureau); his digital QSOs will be

uploaded to LoTW. [TNX NG3K]
CN - Special station CN19JIM will be active on 21-22 December from Imlil in the High Atlas mountain range of Morocco. The callsign's suffix stands for Journee Internationale de la Montagne (International Mountain Day). QSL via RW6HS.

CO - The Radio Club de Caibarien will be active again as T46W on 29-31 December to commemorate the 128th anniversary of Manuel "Manolin" Alvarez Alvarez (1891-1986), a pioneer of radio in Cuba and an amateur radio operator (CO6MA) for seventy years. Look for activity on 80-10 metres CW, SSB and FT8. QSL via LoTW.



DL - Special callsign DL250BTHVN will be active from Bonn between 16 December 2019 and 17 December 2020, during the Beethoven Anniversary Year. Ludwig van Beethoven, one of the greatest composers of all time, was born in Bonn on 16 December 1770. More information will be available on <https://dl250bthvn.de/>.

DL - Volker, DL1WH will be active holiday style as DL1WH/p from Borkum Island (EU-047) on 21-31 December. He will operate CW and some SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL via home call, bureau or direct.

DL - Yannick, DK1YH and others will be active as DL30GER from 31 December 2019 until 31 December 2020 to celebrate the 30th anniversary of the German reunification process. QSL via the bureau, eQSL, or direct to DK1YH.



DL - Celebrating the 70th anniversary of the Deutscher Amateur Radio Club (the German IARU society), special callsigns DF70DARC and DP70DARC will be active from 1 January to 31 December. QSL via the bureau, LoTW, eQSL, or direct to DK5DC; logsearch on Club Log. See <http://www.70darc.club/> for information on the DARC 70 Award.



DL - Special callsign DL100BKW will be active throughout 2020 to mark the 100th anniversary of the first broadcast transmission from the Radio Station Koenigs Wusterhausen (22 December 1920), which is regarded as the birth of statutorily regulated broadcasting in Germany (<https://100jahrerundfunk.de/english/>). QSL via Club log's OQRS; paper QSLs are not needed. A certificate will be available, see qrz.com for information.



E4 - Russian Robinson Club's members R5EC, R7AL, RA1ZZ and RW9JZ will be active as E44RU from near Jericho, Palestine on 6-12 January. They will operate CW, SSB, FT8 (Fox & Hound) on 160-10 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS and LoTW. See <https://dxpedition.wixsite.com/e44ru> for more information.

EX - When time permits, Andrea, HB9DUR will be active again as EX0DX from Kyrgyzstan from 27 December to 11 January. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call. [TNX DX World]



F - Francois, F8DVD will be active as TM70TAAF on 12-26 January. QSL via home call (direct or bureau), and LoTW. The special call sign commemorates the 70th anniversary of first QSOs made on the amateur radio bands by stations operating from the Terres Australes et Antarctiques

Françaises (the French Southern and Antarctic Lands). The stations involved in early 1950 were FB8AX from Adelie Land (Antarctica), FB8XX from the Kerguelen Islands and FB8ZZ from Amsterdam Island.

FG - The Radio Club de Guadeloupe (FG4KL) will be active as TO2O from 20 UTC on 28 December until 14 UTC on 29 December. Activity will focus on 160, 80 and 40 metres CW, SSB and FT8. QSL via LoTW and Club Log's OQRS.

FG - Taking part in the celebration for the 10th anniversary of CWops (see "Good to Know" below), Jean, FG8NY will be active as TO10CWO from Guadeloupe (NA-102) on 17-31 January. QSL via FG8NY, direct or bureau.

G - Celebrating the New Year 2019, special event stations GB0HNY, GB1HNY, GB2HNY, GB4HNY, GB5HNY, GB6HNY, GB8HNY and GB9HNY will be active from 28 December until 24 January. They are being run by members of Denby Dale ARS. Paper QSL cards will not be issued.

HB0 - Kasimir, DL2SBY will be active as HB0/DL2SBY from Liechtenstein on 21-28 December. He will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on 80-10 metres. QSL via home call (direct only, as he is no longer a member of DARC); the log will be uploaded to LoTW and Club Log. [TNX The Daily DX]

HB9 - The Association des Radioamateurs de la Cote (HB9HI) will operate special event station HE2JOJ on 1-31 January to mark the 3rd edition of the Winter Youth Olympic Games (Jeux Olympiques de la Jeunesse) to be hosted by Lausanne. QSL via

HB9HI (direct or bureau). A certificate will be available: complete information can be found on <http://www.hb9hi.ch/he2joj>. The Youth Olympic Games, an international multi-sport event organized by the International Olympic Committee, aim at bringing together talented young athletes aged 15-18 from around the world.

HB9 - HB40HTC and HB40HC are the call signs for the Helvetia Telegraphy Club to celebrate its 40th anniversary in 2020. QSL via the bureau and LoTW. A special activity programme - the HB Open CW Activity (HB-OCWA) Award - will be in place throughout the year to mark the anniversary,

help activate the special call signs and also "inspire amateur radio operators in Switzerland and elsewhere to increase CW activity on the HF bands. The intent of the



award is to encourage and reward them for conducting sustained CW conversations rather than short-duration CW signal reports". See <https://hb-ocwa.ch/> for detailed information.

HC - HC3AGT is the call sign used by Antonio, EA5RM while in Loja, Ecuador. In his spare time he operates SSB and digital modes on 40-10 metres. Antonio will remain in the country until 5 January [425DXN 1489], with possible activity also from Guayaquil (HC2). QSL via home call.

in January II4BRN (Marconi's birth, 1874); in February II4MLB (Dame Nellie Melba's song recital, the first radio broadcast of a musical performance, 1920); in March II4MCY (foundation of the first "Marconi Company", 1897); in April II4FTX (first transatlantic radio signals transmission, 1901); in May II4TEA (first radio message between the United States and the United Kingdom, 1903); in June II4REP (rescue of the ocean liner "Republic", 1909); in July II4NBL (Marconi is awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics, 1909); in August II4CLT (inauguration of the radio station at Coltano, 1911); in September II4PTN (Marconi applies for his first patent, 1896); in October II4LGH (Marconi switches on the lights at Sydney Town Hall from Genoa via wireless transmission, 1930); in November II4RVT (inauguration of Vatican Radio, 1931); in December II4MDY (Marconi Day at Chicago World's Fair, 1933). J6 - John, AI6LY will be active holiday style as J6/AI6LY from St. Lucia (NA-108) on 4-11 January. He will operate SSB on 80-15 metres. QSL direct to homecall; he will upload his log to Club Log and LoTW. [TNX The Daily DX]

JD1_oga - Once again Harry, JG7PSJ will be active as JD1BMH from Chichijima (AS-031), Ogasawara from 22

December to 3 January 2020. He will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on 80-10m, but the "top priority for this tour is antenna maintenance" in the aftermath of two typhoons. QSL via JD1BMH (bureau) or JG7PSJ (direct). He does not use LoTW or PayPal. See <http://jd1bmh.webcrow.jp/> for logsearch.

PY - Marcelo, PY2AE will be active as ZZ1R from Ilha dos Ratos (SA-029) on 26-29 December. He will operate SSB, CW and FT8/FT4 on 80-10 metres.

TF - Col, MM0NDX and Jonathan, MM0OKG will be active as TF/OJ0Y from Iceland (EU-021) from 31 December to 2 January. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 80-30 metres, and maybe 169m. QSL via EB7DX and LoTW. [TNX DX World]

UA - Special callsigns R2020NY, RA20NY, RC20NY, RG20NY, RK20NY, RL20NY, RM20NY, RN20NY, RO20NY,

RT20NY, RU20NY, RW20NY, RX20NY and RZ20NY will be active from 30 December to 14 January for the "Russian New Year 2020" radio marathon organized by the Miller DX Club. QSL via Club Log's OQRS. A number of certificates will be available, see <http://mdxc.hamlog.ru>.



UA - The Russian Robinson Club will operate special event station R200ANT between 1 January and 31 March 2020 to commemorate the 200th anniversary of the discovery of Antarctica. QSL via RZ3EC. The first confirmed



sighting of mainland Antarctica (27 January 1820) is attributed to the Russian expedition led by Fabian Gottlieb von Bellingshausen and Mikhail Lazarev, who discovered an ice shelf at Princess Martha Coast that

UA9 - Special callsign R95WURC is active on 12-25 December to celebrate the 95th anniversary of UFA Radio Club and the beginning of amateur radio in the Republic of Bashkortostan (R9W). 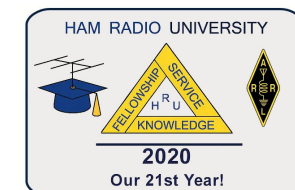

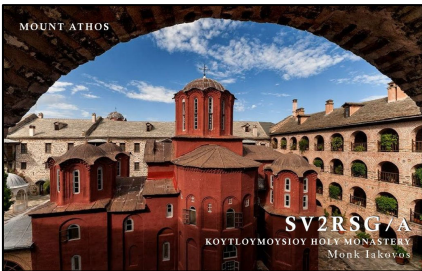

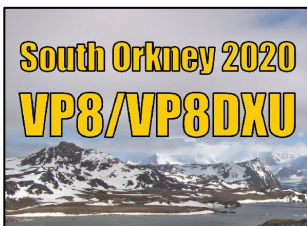

OQRS HINTS & TIPS • Tim, M0URX has added a page on his website to explain how to use his Online QSL Request System: go to <https://www.m0urx.com/> and find "OQRS Hints & Tips" in the dropdown menu under "How to QSL". This is the same system used by M0OXO: "an integrated on-line bespoke Log Search, OQRS and QSL Manager application", which "offers useful tools for DXers and Dxpeditions, and strongly supports the QSL manager workload automating the most time consuming QSLing processes".



RAEM CONTEST • The 48th RAEM Contest will be held on 29 December, from 00.00 UTC until 11.59 UTC, on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10m CW (see <http://raem.srr.ru/en/main/> for complete information). Organized by the Russian Amateur Radio Union (SRR), this annual event memorializes Ernst T. Krenkel (1903-1971), the legendary Arctic explorer and radioman (callsign RAEM) on various polar stations and on the first drifting ice station North Pole-1.

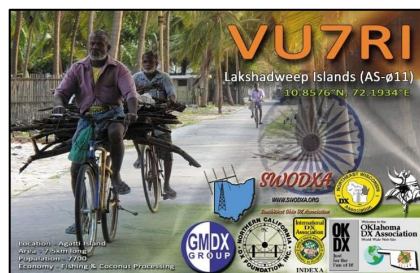
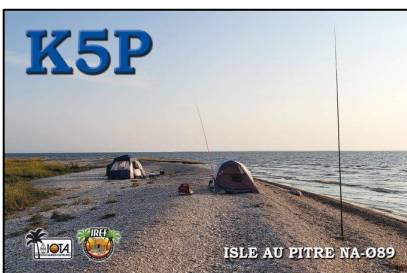
VP8/VP8DXU • Alan Cheshire (VK6CQ) has joined the South Orkney Islands DXpedition team; he replaces WD5COV who has had to leave the project. Loaded into a sea container, the equipment is on its way to Chile. It is expected to arrive at Coronel on 21 December; subsequently, the shipment will be taken to Punta Arenas. The estimated cost of this project is 310,000-325,000 USD, with the most expensive line items being the ship, freight and cold weather shelters. As for fundraising, 49 clubs/foundations and over 400 individuals have supported the project so far. "While we still have a long way to go", the team reports, "we continue to make progress towards our goal of the radio team paying 50% of the project cost with sponsorships paying the remainder". The next major milestones include finalizing the radio operating schedule and assigning team member responsibilities for camp setup, radio and antenna installation. WRC-19: REGION 1 50 MHZ AMATEUR ALLOCATIONS • IARU has released a more detailed report (see <https://www.iaru-r1.org/>) on the outcome of Agenda Item 1.1 (50 MHz) at the recent World Radiocommunication Conference in Egypt. The IARU position was to seek a 4 MHz primary allocation in Region 1 in common with that in other ITU regions. Proposals from administrations and Regional Telecommunications Organisations around the world ranged from no allocation at all to the provision of a 4 MHz primary allocation. The table at http://www.iaru-r1.org/wiki/VHF#50-54_MHz_.286_m.29 ("Overview of 50 MHz status in ITU Region 1") is IARU's understanding of the position on 50 MHz allocations in Region 1 before and after WRC-19. The definitive position is the responsibility of individual national administrations. Provisions of the ITU Regulations, as revised by WRC-19, shall enter into force on 1 January 2021, however administrations may make provisions to provide 50 MHz spectrum at an earlier or later date. Unless already licensed to do so, individual amateurs should not use the newly allocated spectrum until their national licensing authority has

given the go ahead for its use.

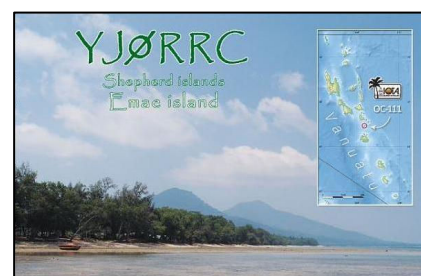
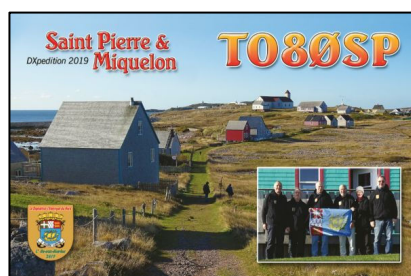
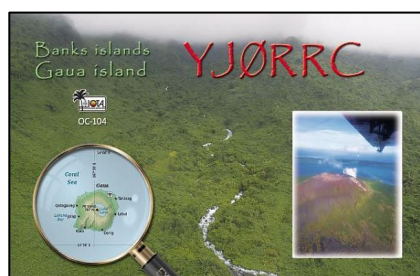
