



# DX INFORMATION



**4X** - Team 4X100AI will be active (SSB, CW, FT8 and on QO100) from the Akhziv Islands (AS-100) on 7 August (5-15 UTC). Originally scheduled during the IOTA Contest, the operation has had to be postponed due to bad weather conditions. QSL direct to 4X6ZM; the log will be uploaded to LoTW, Club Log and eQSL. [TNX The Daily DX]

**6W** - Dani, EA4ATI is back to Senegal and active as 6W1/EA4ATI (3-month temporary callsign while waiting for a permanent call). He operates mainly SSB on 80-10 metres. QSL via EA4R; Dani will try to upload his log to LoTW and eQSL. [TNX EA4R]

**BY** - BA4TB and others will participate in the IOTA Contest as B4T from Kaishan Island (AS-135). Before the Contest they will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 40-6 metres as BI4SSB. QSLs via BA7TB. [TNX NG3K]

**BY** - BA4MY, BI4KKZ and others will be active as BG4OP from Lingshan Island (AS-150) on 23-25 July. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 80-6 metres, and will participate in the IOTA Contest. QSL via BI4IIZ. [TNX NG3K]



**C6** - While the C6AHA operation [425DXN 1569] has been postponed until sometime in October, Steven WA8Y (C6AYW, QSL via LoTW or direct to home call), Juan AC6ZM (C6AZM, QSL via LoTW or Club Log's OQRS) and Richard NN2T (C6AHB, QSL via LoTW or direct to

home call) will be active from the Bimini Islands (NA-048), Bahamas on 14-21 July. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 80-10 metres.

**CN** - Taking part in the annual Throne Day's celebrations, members of the Association Royale des Radioamateurs du Maroc (ARRAM) will be using the special prefix CN22 between 28 July and 8 August. Throne Day is a public holiday in Morocco that commemorates the enthronement of the incumbent monarch. Since 1999, it has been celebrated on 30 July.

**CN** - Bruno, IW5BBV will be active as CN2BBV while touring Morocco on 5-30 August. He will operate SSB mainly on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via home call.

**CT8** - Jim, W6PQL will be active as CT8/W6PQL from Pico Island (EU-175), Azores from 25 July to 4 September. He will operate FT8 on all bands and SSB on 20 metres; between 1 August and 3 September he will operate 2m EME and tropo. QSL via LoTW, or direct to home call.

**DL** - Members of DARC's Ortsverband Greifswald (DL0HGW) will be active as DL70GREIF from 1 August to 31 December. The special callsign marks the 70<sup>th</sup> anni-

versary of the *Greif*, a brigantine owned by the town of Greifswald and used as a training ship for maritime youth education. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau. A certificate will be available, see <https://hamlog.online/club/germany/189> for information.

**E5\_sc** - Bruce, ZL1AAO will be active holiday style as E51AAO from the South Cook Islands: first from Atiu (OC-083) on 6-9 August, and then from Rarotonga (OC-013) until 19 August. He will operate SSB on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via home call and LoTW.

**EA** - AM1CCB is the special callsign for URE Burgos to mark the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Burgos Cathedral between 20 July and 18 August. QSL via the bureau, LoTW, eQSL, or direct. The cathedral has been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List since 1984.



**ES** - Look for ES6JP/0 (QSL via YL2GM) and ES6TZ/0 (QSL via YL2GN) to be active from Hiiumaa Island (EU-034) on 23-25 July, IOTA Contest included. [TNX DX World]

**ES** - Look for Sergei, ES1LL/0 and Andrei, ES4AW/0 to be active from the islands of Muhu, Saaremaa and Hiiumaa (all counts for IOTA group EU-034) on 5-8 August.

**F** - F4ESV, F5LPY and F8EFU will be active as TM21MAB



from 22 July to 3 August for this year's Grand Est Mondial Air Ballons event for hot air balloons. They will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on all bands. QSL via F5LPY;

the logs will be uploaded to Club Log and LoTW.

**F** - TM21OG is a French special callsign to be aired from 23 July to 8 August in celebration of this year's Tokyo Olympic Games. It will be operated by members of the Radio Club du Val d'Issole (F8KGH) on 80-6 metres CW, SSB and digital modes. QSL via the bureau, LoTW, eQSL, or direct to F4GPB.



**F** - F4ELI, F4ELK and F6DXE will be active as TM6JVX from Ile Vierge (EU-105) on 24 July. QSL via F4ELK, direct or bureau. The special callsign pays a tribute to Jeannot Polard, F6JVX (SK since 16 November 2020).



**F** - Eddy, ON6EF and Christiaan, ON1BN will be active as F/ON6EF/p and F/ON1BN/p from Grande-Ile, Chausey Islands (EU-039) during the IOTA Contest (24-25 July). They will be QRV from 9 to 15 UTC both days; plans

are to operate SSB with two stations on two different bands at the same time.

**F** - For the 69<sup>th</sup> year the Association des Radioamateurs de la Sarthe (F6KFI) will operate a special event station for the 24 Hours of Le Mans. Look for TM24H on 8-22 August, with activity on various bands and modes (SSB, CW, RTTY, PSK, FT8). QSL via F6KFI.



**FM** - Dim, UT5UGR has been active as FM/KL7WA from Martinique (NA-107) since 7 July, and will remain there until 14 July. He will participate in the IARU HF World Championship as TO5GR. QSL via UT5UGR or Club Log's OQRS. [TNX UT5UGR]

**FO** - Yann, F1SMB will be active as FO/F1SMB from several French Polynesia islands in August. His itinerary is as follows:

**FS** - Hal, W8HC and Gregg, W6IZT will be active holiday style as FS/W8HC and FS/W6IZT from St. Martin (NA-105) from 29 July to 6 August. They will operate FT8 and CW on 60-6 metres. QSLs via LoTW. [TNX The Daily DX]

**GM** - The 7M Contest Group (G3UNA, G3VCQ, G4ZVB, GI4FUE, M0KPD, M0YDB, M3VCQ and MI5JYK) will be active from the Isle of Arran (EU-123) on 22-25 July, including participation in the IOTA Contest. They will be signing GM7M (QSL via G4ZVB) as well as MS0SDC, with planned activity also on 6m FT8.

**HL** - DS3BBC and others will be active as D70EXPO from Pukkyongnyolbi Island (AS-080) on 22-25 July. They will be QRV on 80-6 metres, and will participate in the IOTA Contest. QSL via LoTW, or via DS3BBC; the log will be uploaded to Club Log.

**HP** - Celebrating the bicentennial of the independence of Panama from Spain, HP2AT and HP2NG are active as

3F200AT and 3F200NG until 30 November. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, or via Club Log's OQRS (to be enabled after the activity is over).



**HS** - The Radio Amateur Society of Thailand is active as HS18IARU until 30 September to mark the 18th IARU Region 3 Conference 2021 (20-23 September, <https://www.iarur3conf2021.org/>).

QSL via E21EIC, but all QSOs will be confirmed via LoTW and the bureau.

**I** - A large team will be active from the island of Santa Maria di Barbana (EU-130) on 23-25 July. They will be signing II3Y during the IOTA Contest (QSL via M0OXO) and IQ3JT (QSL via IV3OSC).

**I** - Weather permitting, Roberto, IK8PGM and others will be active as ID8A from Cirella Island (EU-144) on 29 July. QSL via home call.

**J8** - Brian, GW4DVB will be active again as J88PI from Palm Island (NA-025) from 23 July to 1 August. He will operate SSB, FT8 and «if anyone requests it in advance, I'm willing to give it a go on CW». QSL direct to home call (see <https://www.g4dvv.co.uk/> for PayPal information).



**JA** - Ichy, JH7IPR will be active from Tokunoshima, Amami Islands (AS-023) from around 5 UTC on 2 July until around 5 UTC on 7 July. **JA** - The following HQ stations representing JARL will be active from various regions of Japan for the IARU HF World Championship:



**JA** - Kenji, JA4GXS he will be active again as JA4GXS/4 from Ohzu Island (AS-117) on 16-17 July. He will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on 40, 20, 17 and 6m. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. [TNX DX World]

**JA** - Look for JI3DST/5, JR8YLY/5 and JR8YLY/p (FT8) to be active again from Shodo Island (AS-200) on 22-26 July and 18-26 September. JI3DST/5 will participate in the IOTA Contest. All QSOs will be uploaded to Club Log and made available for Club Log Matching on the IOTA website. [TNX NG3K]

**OA** - Alex, DD5ZZ will be active as OA7/DD5ZZ from the Peruvian region of Cuzco between 30 July and 17 September. He will operate SSB, FT8, FT4 and some CW on 40-6 metres, and might use OA7/5P6G during the WAE



DX CW (14-15 August), WAE DX SSB (11-12 September) and World Wide Digi DX (28-29 August) contests. QSL via home call, LoTW and Club Log's OQRS. [TNX NG3K]

**OH** - Representing SRAL in this year's IARU HF World Championship will be twelve stations operating on all six bands, both CW and SSB simultaneously. They will be located on mainland Finland (OF2HQ) and the Aland Islands (OF0HQ). «Working the OF2HQ/OF0HQ stations on 3 bands would qualify you for a special 4-page SRAL-100 QSL card. In case you work these stations on more than three bands, the QSL card will have a special bronze, silver or gold sticker on it». [TNX OH2BH]



**OH** - Ric, DL2VFR will be active as OH1/DL2VFR from Reposaari Island (EU-173) on 23-25 July, IOTA Contest included. Afterwards he will be active as OH73ELK (26-30 July) and OH9/DL2VFR (2-3 August) from mainland Finland, as OH6/DL2VFR (4-5 August) from IOTA group EU-101, and as OH2/DL2VFR (6-8 August) from IOTA group EU-097. [TNX The Daily DX]

**OH0** - Adrian, KO8SCA will be one of the operators at OF0HQ. After the contest he will remain there «for some extra days» with Martti, OH2BH and activate his new OH0SCA callsign from Brando Island (EU-002). QSL via KO8SCA. [TNX OH2BH]

**OX** - Bo, OZ1DJJ will be active again as OX3LX from Tasiilaq Island (NA-151) between 28 July and 14 August. His main focus will be on 6 and 4 metres, with some activity on the HF bands. He will be QRV in his spare time, typically around lunch time and after dinner (local time is UTC-2), also at night and in the morning hours during the weekends. 
**PY** - Celebrating the Games of the XXXII Olympiad to be held in Tokyo, Mor, PT7ZT will be active as ZV32ZT from 15 July to 13 August. He will operate SSB and digital modes. QSL via LoTW, or direct to PT7ZT.

**SP** - Special callsign SN88LOT will be active from 1 July to 31 August to commemorate the 88<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the ill fated flight of Lithuanian pilots Steponas Darius and Stasys Girenas. On 15 July 1933 they attempted a nonstop flight from New York City to Kaunas in a



small airplane named *Lituanica*. After crossing the Atlantic Ocean, they crashed on 17 July when they were only 650km short of their final destination. QSL via SP1PMY.

**SV** - A large team will be active as SX8T from Amoliani Island (EU-174) on 23-26 July, including an entry in the IOTA Contest. QSL direct to SV2CLJ. [TNX NG3K]



**SV/A** - Monk Iakovos, SV2RSG/A has been active from Mount Athos since 22 July, and reportedly will be QRV for the next few days. He will operate SSB and CW mostly on 40, 30 and 20 metres. QSL direct to SV1RP.

**TK** - Frans, DJ0TP will be active as TK/DJ0TP from Corsi-

ca (EU-014) between 6 August and 14 September. QSL via LoTW, or via the bureau to home call. [TNX DJ0TP]



**UA** - Oleg UA1O (ZS1ANF), Alexei RN1ON, Yuri UA1OC and Alex UA1OJL will be active as RI1OZ from Zhizhiginskiy Island (EU-153) on 4-10 July. They will operate CW, SSB and FT8/FT4 on 80-10 metres. 

They will run two stations on 80-10 metres mainly CW, with some SSB and FT8. QSL via home calls (direct or bureau) and Club Log's OQRS (to be enabled at the end of the operations); the QSOs will be made available for Club Log Matching on the IOTA website.

**UA** - Mikhail, RA1ALA will be active as RA1ALA/p from Volostrov Island (RRA RR-02-49, claimed to count for IOTA group EU-162) from 31 July to 7 August. He will operate SSB and FT8. QSL direct to RA1ALA.



**UA** - Special callsigns R2ORTA, R2ORTM, R2ORTP, R2ORTN and R2ORTT will be active on 1-31 August to celebrate the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Russian Television and Radio Broadcasting Network (RTRN), created on 13 August 2001. QSL via operator's instructions.



**UA** - Special callsigns R1961GT and UE60GT will be active on 2-8 August to commemorate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Gherman S. Titov's flight aboard Vostok 2 (6-7 August 1961). QSL via operator's instructions. Titov was the second human to orbit the Earth, but the first to orbit multiple times, the first to pilot a spaceship and to spend more than a day in space.



**UA0** - R4WAA, R7AA, RM0F and RZ3FW will be active as RI0FWA from Kunashir Island (AS-025) on 23-29 July, including participation in the IOTA Contest. QSL via RZ3FW.



**UA0** - Look for R3RRC/0 (QSL via RZ3EC), as well as R0MR/p, R3BY/0 and RU5D/0, to be active from Furugel'ma Island (AS-066) from 31 July to 4 August. They will operate

CW, SSB, FT8 and FT4 on 40-10m.

**V8** - Celebrating the 75<sup>th</sup> birthday of HRM Hassanal Bolkiah, Sultan and Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei, special callsign V84SKP will be active on 18-24 July on 40, 20, 15 and 10m SSB, CW and FT8. QSL direct to P.O. Box 849, MPC Old Airport, Bandar Seri Begawan BB3577, Brunei Darussalam.

**W** - After being delayed by the pandemic in 2020, the first ever Youth on the Air (YOTA) summer camp for young radio amateurs aged 15-25 in the Americas will be held on 11-16 July in West Chester, Ohio (<https://youthontheair.org/cincinnati-2020/>). Campers will operate special event station W8Y from both the National Voice of America Museum of Broadcasting and




from the camp hotel. Dedicated operating times on the HF bands will be on 12 July (01.00-03.30 UTC) and 13 July (00.00-03.30 UTC and 18.00-21.30 UTC), but W8Y will be on the air also «as campers complete projects, between sessions and during free time». QSL via LoTW or W0AAE.

**W** - Bodo, DF8DX will be active as KT3Q/4 from Santa Rosa Island (NA-142) on 17-19 July. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (bureau or direct).

**W** - N4CW and W4TMO will be active as K1IMI from Bailey Island (NA-137) on 24 July «starting at 1200Z and going until after local sunset». They will participate in the IOTA Contest as a 12-hour entry, and will operate «probably all CW» mainly on 40 and 20 metres. QSL via LoTW or direct to N4CW. [TNX The Daily DX]

**XE** - Once again special callsign 4A2MAX will be activated on 1-31 August in remembrance of St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe. Activity will be on 80-6 metres SSB, CW and
