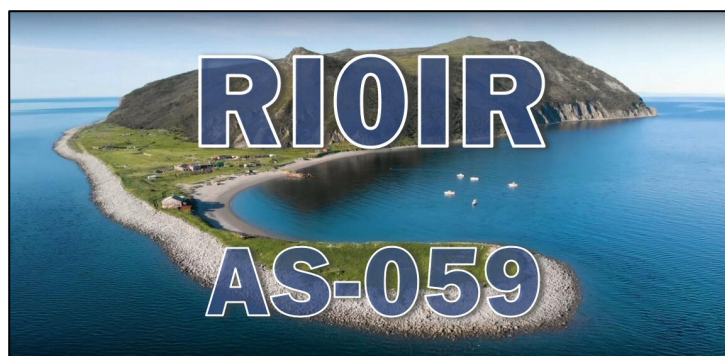
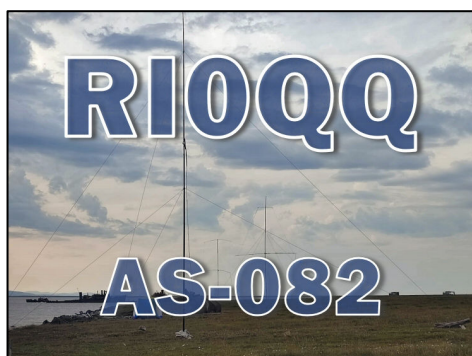

DX INFORMATION



3B9 - 3B8BAN, 3B8CF, 3B8FA, 3B8FV, 3B8GF and 3B8GL will be active as 3B9BAN, 3B9CF, 3B9FA, 3B9FV, 3B9GF and 3B9GL from Rodrigues Island (AF-017) on 5-9 August. They will have three QO-100 satellite stations; in addition, they will be QRV also on the

HF bands (mainly FT8).

4W - Alan, VK1AO (VK2MET) will be active as 4W/VK1AO from Timor Leste between 25 July and 4 August, and again «at least two more times over the next three years». He plans to be QRV on 40, 30, 20, 17, 15 and 12 metres SSB, FT8, JS8 and maybe some CW, and to operate from a couple of POTA parks. He will upload his log to Club Log and LoTW. [TNX *The Daily DX*]



4X - Special event stations 4X21MG and 4Z21MG will be active on 12-26 July during the 21st Maccabiah Games. QSLs via 4X6ZM. First held in 1932, the Maccabiah Games are an international multi-sport event held quadrennially in Israel.

5R - Elvira, IV3FSG will be active as 5R8LH from Madagascar from 1 August to 9 September. Usually she operates SSB and digital modes in her spare time. QSL direct to IK2DUW.

5W - Pista HA5AO, George HA5UK and Paul W7IV will be active as 5W0DX from Samoa (OC-097) sometime in February 2023. They will operate CW, SSB, RTTY, FT8 on 80-10 metres with three stations. See <https://www.ha5ao.com/index.php/dxpeditons/5w0dx-samoa-2023> for more information and updates. QSL via HA5AO's OQRS, or direct to HA5AO; the complete log will be uploaded to LoTW six months after the operation. [TNX HA5AO]

5X - Elvira, IV3FSG has been in Uganda since 23 June, and will remain there until 13 July. In her spare time she operates mainly digital modes and SSB as 5X3R. QSL direct to IK2DUW; plans are to upload the QSOs to Club Log and LoTW.

7Q - Fresh from their recent Z21RU operation from Zimbabwe [425DXN 1623], Russian DXpedition Team's members R7AL, RA1ZZ and RW9JZ will be QRV as 7Q5RU from the Embangweni Mission Hospital in Malawi from 30 June until 10 July. They plan to pay special attention to SSB, as the last time they were there (7Q7RU, November-December 2020) Phone QSOs were only 5,000 out of 47,000. QSL via Club Log's OQRS.

7X - Celebrating the 60th anniversary of Algeria's independence from France (5 July 1962), special



callsign 7V60ID will be active on 4-31 July. QSL via LoTW. Other special callsigns expected to join the celebrations are 7T60I, 7U60I, 7V60I and 7W60I (QSLs via operators' instructions).

9A - Look for 9A/S500/p, 9A/S50X/p, 9A/S53Z/p, 9A/S54ZO/p, 9A/S58MU/p and 9A7YY to be active from Vis Island (EU-016) from 25 July to 2 August. They will operate CW, SSB and FT modes on 80-6 metres, and will participate in the IOTA Contest, possibly using a 9A callsign TBA. See <https://vis-2022.sejmiscce.si/> for more information.

He had hoped to be active as A35JP/p from Niuaotupapu on 10-16 July and from Niuafo'ou on 7-20 August [425DXN 1624]. Masa has been QRV as A35JP from Nuku'alofa on Tongatapu (OC-049) since 22 July, instead. He will remain there until the end of September. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or via the bureau to JA0RQV.

BV - BM2AAV, BV500, BV5PD, BX2AGL, BX3AC and BX3ACH will be active as BP0A from the Penghu Islands (AS-107) from 29 July to 1 August. They will operate SSB and CW on 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres, with main activity during the IOTA Contest. [TNX NG3K]

C6A - Joe, W8GEX and Janet, W8CAA will be active as C6ADX and C6AYL, respectively, from Exuma Island (NA-001), Bahamas for ten days starting on 16 July. They will operate mainly FT8 on 60-6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct to home calls. [TNX *The Daily DX*]



CN - Taking part in the annual Throne Day's celebrations, members of the Association Royale des Radioamateurs du Maroc (ARRAM) will be using the special prefix CN23 between 28 July and 8 August. Throne Day is a public holiday in Morocco that commemorates the enthronement of the incumbent monarch. Since

1999, it has been celebrated on 30 July.

CO - A large group of operators will be active as T41DX from Playa Boca de Galafre on the main island of Cuba (NA-015) on 14-17 July. Look for activity on 80-10 metres SSB, CW, FT8, FT4, RTTY, SSTV. QSL via LoTW, or direct to RW6HS.

CT7 - Special event station CS2Q will be active on 11-17 July for the 40th International Motorcycle Rally in Faro, Portugal. Expect activity on 80-6 metres SSB, CW, RTTY and FT8. QSL via CT1EHX.

CT8 - Jim, W6PQL will be active as CT8/W6PQL from Pico Island (EU-175), Azores from 14 July to 6 September. He will operate SSB and FT8, and will be QRV around 14240 kHz at nighttime, and around 7140-7180 kHz in the

mornings. Between 18 July and 1 September he will operate 2m EME and tropo. QSL via LoTW, or direct to home call.

CY0 - Originally scheduled to take place sometime between October and November 2022, the CY0S DXpedition to Sable Island has been postponed until 20-29 March 2023. «The reason for this significant change is due to a large, six-week project Parks Canada has on the



island beginning on October 1 and going to at least mid-November 2022», the team says. «By moving the DXpedition to March 2023, the team hopes to take advantage of the late winter, early spring band conditions

and improving solar numbers. On a less positive note, Sable Aviation informed us of another increase in the fuel surcharge for our flights to the island. The fuel surcharge has now doubled». If you are willing to contribute, please use the "Donate" button on www.cy0s.com.

DL - Mike, DG5LAC will be active again as DG5LAC/p from Hallig Hooe (EU-042) for the IOTA Contest (30-31 July). Outside the contest he will operate SSB and FT8/FT4. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call. [TNX NG3K]

DL - Six operators from DARC Ortsverband Koenigs Wusterhausen (DL0KWH) will participate in the IOTA Contest as DK1A/p from Usedom Island (EU-129). QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or direct to DL7JOM.

DX0 - DX0NE is the callsign issued for a DXpedition to Kalayaan, Pag-asa Island, Spratly Islands (AS-051) to



take place sometime between 1 August and 31 December. The team includes Ed 4F1OZ, Gil 4F2KWT, Ruel DU1VGX, Mike DU1XX (AE6DG) and Jong DU3JA. They will operate

five stations on 160-10 metres CW, SSB and FT8. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), or via IZ8CCW; full upload to LoTW after 5-6 months. See <https://www.mdxc.support/dx0ne/> for more information and updates.

E5_sc - Pete, ZL4TE will be active as E51RMP from Rarotonga (OC-013) on 14-17 July and again on 20-21 July, and from Aitutaki (OC-083) on 18-19 July. DXCC wise, both count for the South Cook Islands. He hopes «to do some HF QRP and VHF digi modes mainly D-STAR». QSL via home call.

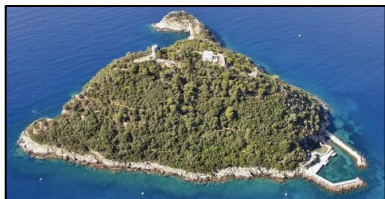

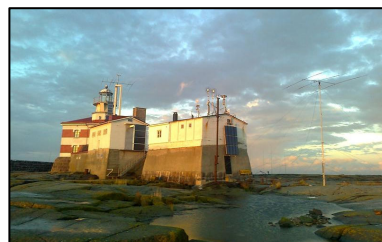

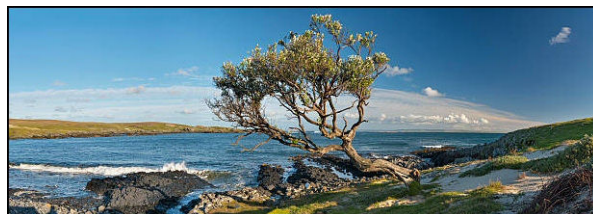

Next to DXCC and IOTA, POTA has become one of the most active worldwide operating award programs. Even more important, though, is that more hams are On The Air, especially hams with modest stations or who cannot get OTA from home for whatever reason. POTA is making it possible for them to have a great deal of fun, be active on HF/VHF/satellites, and learn about radio.



- **Jan Stadman, DJ5AN/PA1TT** - In recognition of his efforts organizing ham radio events. For many years, Jan organized the Dutch HF Convention and the annual European DX Foundation meeting in Bad Bentheim, Germany. Jan also runs the EUDXF booth at Ham Radio in Friedrichshafen. Together with other DX associations he invented and shaped the "DX Plaza" that is now the central meeting point for DXers present in Friedrichshafen. In 2017 Jan joined the organizing committee of the Dutch German Radio Amateur Meeting DNAT and took over as committee chair in 2020, just before COVID. 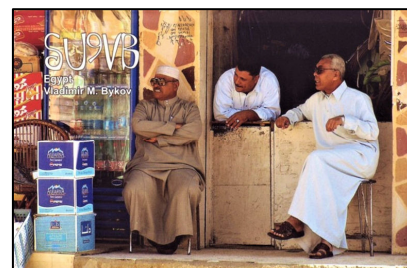
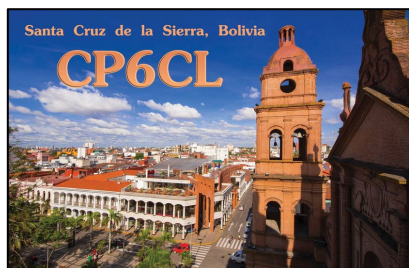
