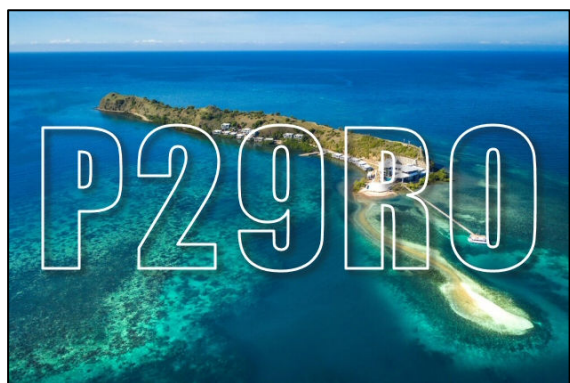

DX INFORMATION

3A - Kasimir, DL2SBY will be active as 3A/DL2SBY from Monaco on 20-23 October. He will operate FT8 and some CW on 30, 20, 17, 12, 10 and maybe 6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct only to home call or Club Log's OQRS. He no longer uses the bureau. [TNX OPDX Bulletin]

3C - Effective 26 September, 3C3CA is the callsign that Ersoy, TA2OM will be using during his stay on Bioko Island (AF-010), Equatorial Guinea. He was previously active as 3C/TA2OM [425DXN 1638]. In his limited spare time he operates mainly FT8, notably on 10131 kHz after 19 UTC (F/H mode). QSL via TA2OM.

4X - Special event station 4X0VK will be active from the historic railway station in Zemach (Samakh) on 14-15 October. The suffix honours the Australian Light Horse brigade that fought in that area during World War I. QSL via 4X6ZM.

4X - Special callsigns 4X01R and 4X02R will be in use on 4-5 November from the historic railway stations of Elroi and Kfar Yehoshua, respectively. These activities are part of the Jezreel Valley Railway project: <https://iarc.org/railway/>. QSLs via 4X6ZM.

Upcoming activities from the Antarctic mainland (AN-016) during the 2022-23 Austral summer season include:

- Oleg, ZS10IN (UA3HK) is participating in the 68th Russian Antarctic Expedition and is active again as RI1ANU - this time from Novolazarevskaja Station - until early March 2023.
- David, F4FKT will be active again from Antarctica between late October and early March 2023. Main activity will be during his spare time as FT4YM/p from Concordia Station, operating SSB and FT8 on 20 and 40 metres. In addition, he plans to be QRV sporadically as IA0/F4FKT/p from Mario Zucchelli Station (for a few days during the last week of October), as FT4YM/p from Little Dome C, as FT4YM/m during the traverse from Concordia to the coast, as FT4YM from Robert Guillard Station at Cap Prud'homme, and finally as as FT4YM/mm from the icebreaker L'Astrolabe. 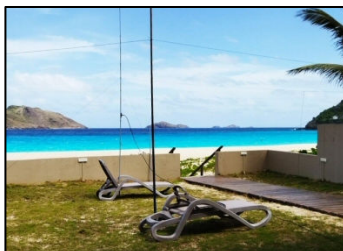

THE TRANSATLANTIC CENTENARY TESTS



The Radio Society of Great Britain will be hosting an international amateur radio activation on the HF bands to celebrate the centenary of the achievement of

amateur transatlantic communication during the Transatlantic Tests that were held between 1921 and 1923. In anticipation of this centenary celebration, the RSGB have renewed five callsigns which they held in the 1920s.

- **G5WS:** used by the RSGB from Wandsworth, South London, 5WS was the callsign of the first European amateur radio station to be heard across the Atlantic during the third Transatlantic Tests (24 December 1922).
- **G5AT:** 5AT was the RSGB HQ callsign, activated in the fourth Transatlantic Tests of December 1923 and successfully heard in North America.
- **G6XX:** activated in the fourth Transatlantic Tests, 6XX was given a special permit to use an input power of 1kW.
- **G6ZZ:** used on 5 July 1924, 6ZZ was the callsign of the Scotch Express on its journey from London to Newcastle; it was the first experiment in operating an amateur radio station from a moving railway train.
- **G3DR:** historic callsign, previously held by the RSGB as GM3DR for use in the Scottish Highlands.

Look for G5WS, G5AT, G6XX, G6ZZ and G3DR (England), GD5WS (Isle of Man), GI5WS (Northern Ireland), GJ5WS (Jersey), GM5WS (Scotland), GU5WS (Guernsey) and GW5WS (Wales) to be activated on 1-31 December. 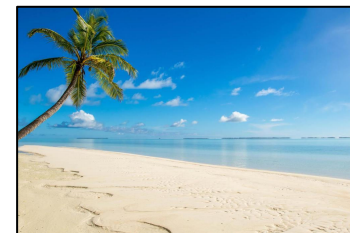

Our location is equipped with an oil-hungry 30kW generator. Electric power in Bangui, as well as the Internet, are available only a few hours a day, day or night with no foreseeable schedule. Obviously, we shall try our best to be available on air, but oil shortage makes any plan most uncertain».

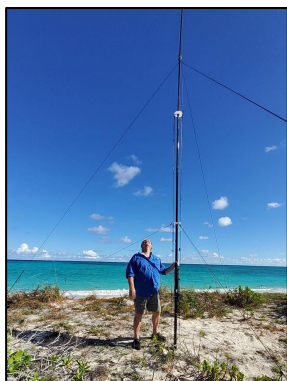

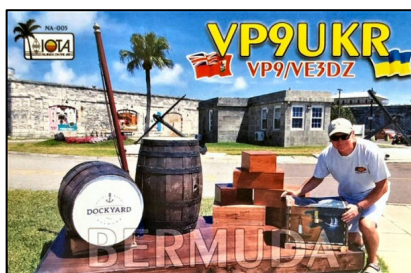

They anticipate to reach Bouvet Island on or around 26 January, and to remain there for at least 22 days. Their budget has increased slightly; now it is around USD \$705,000, which means that they still «only need USD 35,000 to balance. CANCELLATIONS & POSTPONEMENTS

- 5R8CG, 5R8MM, 5R8WG and 5R8WP: the 11-22 October DXpedition to Nosy Be (AF-057) [425DXN #1635] has had to be postponed, as one of the team members tested positive for COVID-19. «The final test result (second) came when we were already driving to the airport», Gerben, PG5M says. «We are hoping to reschedule for late November». Bookmark <http://dx.to/> for updates.
- TX5XG: Haru, JA1XGI had planned to be active from Raivavae (OC-114), Austral Islands on 2-9 November, but has had to cancel the operation and postpone it to sometime in 2023, Updates will be posted to <https://australvacation.amebaownd.com>.
- V3E: An IOTA operation was expected to take place from Turneffe Atoll (NA-123) on 19-23 October. The DXpedition, however, has been cancelled «due to certain circumstances», Hernan, V31DX announced on 26 September. «We need to replan after the hurricane season», he adds, «but on another island under different IOTA reference».



CQ DX MARATHON • Mark Wohlschlegel, WC3W has been appointed as Director of the CQ DX Marathon. He succeeds John Sweeney, K9EL, who has held the post since the programme was reinstituted in 2006. Wohlschlegel will assume the management of the DX Marathon (<https://www.dxmarathon.com/>) on 1 January 2023. He «will lead a team

to continue the development and growth of the DX Marathon», K9EL says. «If you would like to be a part of the DX Marathon team, please contact Mark right away (WC3W at dxmarathon dot com). Mark is looking for a database manager, web site managers, software programmers, etc».



CROZET 2022-23 • Thierry, F6CUK still expects to be at Alfred Faure base on Île de la Possession, Crozet for three months, from late December 2022 to late March 2023. His operations on the HF bands, however, might have to cease on 26 January, and it seems that he will only be allowed on QO-100 after that date. Updates are expected in due course. [TNX Les Nouvelles DX]

CY0S • «A lot of DXers have inquired about Sable Island after Hurricane Fiona made an almost direct hit on the island», the CY0S team posted to the DXpedition's website on 5 October. «Hurricane Fiona had the lowest barometric pressure (931 mb.) ever recorded in Canada during any previous hurricane. Fortunately, the news is better than expected on Sable Island. Parks Canada personnel on the island report some of the buildings lost sections of siding and some roof damage. The Parks Canada personnel described the damage as superficial. The NavCan METAR (Meteorological Terminal Air Report) system was inoperative for 5-6 days until technicians could travel to the island to restore the system. The hurricane caused some erosion and reshaped part of the island. A researcher who has been on the island for almost 50 years reported it was the worst storm she has ever experienced on the island».



The team has also announced that «a well known DXer and DXpeditioner», who wishes to remain anonymous, has offered «to match any donations to the CY0S DXpedition from this point forward until arrival on the island on 20 March 2023. For example, if a contributor donates 100 USD to the DXpedition, this 100 USD will then be matched for a total of 200 USD». Meanwhile, the team is working on the antennas and is «continuing to manage and fine tune gear based on the very strict weight limitations for the DXpedition. The team is limited to a total of 2965 lbs [1345 kg], which includes the weight of the operators, radio gear, antennas, antenna mast, long mast stakes for the loose sand, coaxial cables, food and personal gear. Every pound of weight counts and this is a huge challenge».

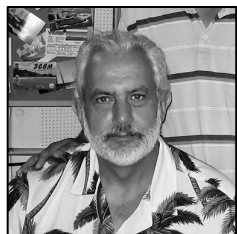

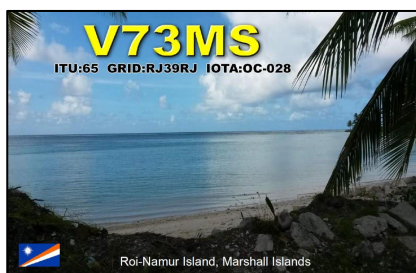
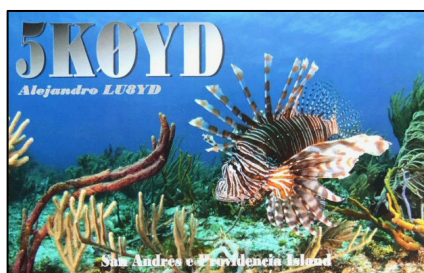
