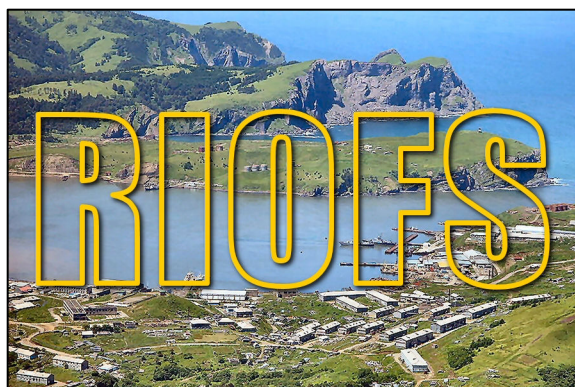
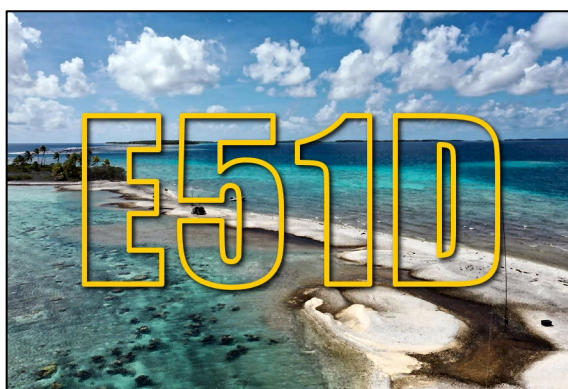

4W - Alan, VK1AO has been active again as 4W/VK1AO from Dili, Timor Leste (OC-148) since 15 August, and expects to remain there until 30 August. He operates mainly FT8 on 40-12 metres. QSL via LoTW, eQSL and Club Log's OQRS.



5W - Mladen 9A2NA, Rolando 9A3MR, Livio 9A7Y and Borut S50B will be active as 5W0LM from Malololelei

near Apia, Samoa (OC-097) on 1-14 October. They will operate CW and SSB (plus FT8 «just for relax») on 160-6 metres with 2-3 stations. QSL via 9A3MR and LoTW.

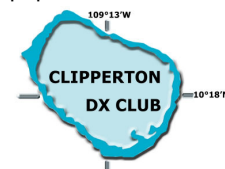

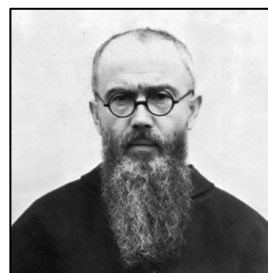

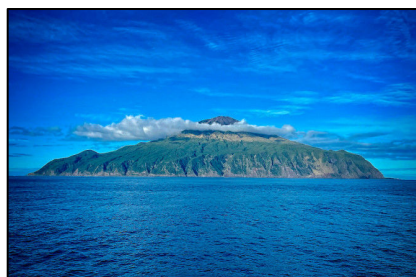

CB0ZA • While plans for the DXpedition «are well underway», Hal, W8HC has joined the multi-national team that will be active as CB0ZA from Cerro Centinela, within the Juan Fernandez National Park on Robinson Crusoe Island (SA-005), on 13-20 February 2024 [425DXN 1675 and 1677]. They have selected the antennas and equipment «taking into account the place and space restrictions». Plans are to have four stations on SSB, CW and RTTY; plus a station for FT8 and another for VHF. QSL via HA1AG, Club Log's OQRS, LoTW. See <https://cb0za.com/> for more information and updates.

INDEXA WORLDWIDE QSO PARTY • Grown from a few people loaning equipment to DX travellers to an organization that has sponsored hundreds of DXpeditions to dozens of DX entities around the world, the International DX Association is turning 40 years old in September.

To commemorate this anniversary, INDEXA sponsors a worldwide on the air celebration, the "INDEXA Worldwide QSO Party". The event will run on 2-10 September on 160, 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres SSB, CW, and RTTY. This event is open to all radio amateurs, INDEXA members and non-members alike. The objective is to work as many INDEXA members, INDEXA Officials, and as many non-INDEXA members as possible in as many U.S. states, Canadian provinces, and DXCC countries as possible.

A user defined contest module is available for use in the N1MM Logger+ logging programme which will log each QSO, track multipliers, and calculate your score. See <https://indexaqsoparty.com/> for detailed information.



T2C • The band plan for the 10-30 October German DXpedition to Tuvalu [425DXN 1679] can be found on https://t2c.mydx.de/?Operating_frequencies. As for FT8, T2C will use MSHV multi-stream (i.e. they will not use the Fox & Hound mode). Six team members will fly back home on 24 October, while the remaining six operators will stay until 30 October. In the last week, they will only be QRV on 40 metres and higher. T2C will also participate in the CQ WW DX SSB contest.



TX5S • The Perseverance DX Group's DXpedition to Clipperton Island (18 January-1 February 2024) [425DXN 1673] will have two operating camps: one for CW/Digital/Satellite/EME and one for SSB/Digital. «The camps will be separated by about 500 meters, with CW located at the main camp-site and SSB being the distant camp. The combination of distance, bandpass filters, horizontal and vertically polarized antennas at both camps will enable simultaneous operation on the same band». The power grid will consist of six generators (five units on-line 24/7 and one spare); WiFi networking will link the camps and TX5S will have at least one Starlink terminal online 24/7, so logs will be uploaded to MOURX.com at least once per day.

The nineteen person team consists of sixteen experienced radio operators, one scientist each from the University of French Polynesia and the University of Orleans, and one environmentalist from the Association la Passion-Clipperton (France).

The fundraising campaign is underway: «our goal is always to split the expedition funding approximately equally between the expedition operators and the DX community - organizations and individuals. At the moment we still have a long way to go to reach that goal», the team's Press Release #5 states. WRTC 2026 • The WRTC 2026 Organising Committee has announced the Selection Criteria for entrants: <https://www.wrtc2026.org/selection-criteria/>. Everyone interested in qualifying for WRTC 2026 must do so by operating in a variety of contests between October 2023 and March 2025. There will be 15 qualifying events (with the 8 best scores counting), and 42 qualifying teams across 30 Qualification Areas. In addition to the geographically selected teams, the Defending Champions, 4 Youth Teams (entrants must be under age 26 at 11 July 2026), at least 2 Sponsored Teams, and at least 1 Wild Card Team will be invited.

WW DIGI DX CONTEST • The fourth edition of the World Wide Digi DX Contest ("WW Digi") will take place on 26-27 August (from 12:00 UTC to 11:59 UTC). The objective is for amateurs around the world to contact as many other amateurs in as many Maidenhead Grid Fields as possible using the FT4 and FT8 modes on 160, 80, 40, 20, 15 and 10m. 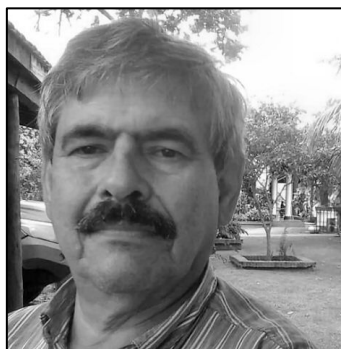

Also reported SK is **Carlos Gustavo Lacarrubba "Laca" Pellon (ZP5CGL)**, who was killed in a work accident on 22 August. Born in 1955, he was a DXer, a contester and an active member of the board of the Radio Club Paraguayo for many years. [TNX ZP5YW]
