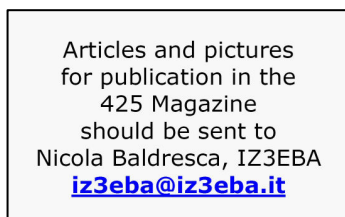

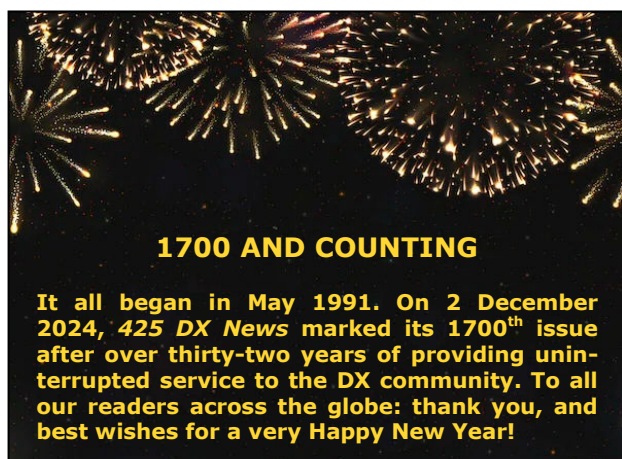

# DX INFORMATION



## 1700 AND COUNTING

**It all began in May 1991. On 2 December 2024, 425 DX News marked its 1700<sup>th</sup> issue after over thirty-two years of providing uninterrupted service to the DX community. To all our readers across the globe: thank you, and best wishes for a very Happy New Year!**



**3B9** - Luca, IV3JVJ and Ivan, IK3ZQA will be active as 3B9AT from Rodrigues Island (AF-017) between 27 December and 6 January. They will operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 80-10 metres. QSL via IV3JVJ and LOTW.

**3W** - Effective 1 December, 3W9T and XV9T are the new callsigns issued to Eddy Visser (ex 3W1T and XV1X). See <https://www.qrz.com/db/XV1X> for QSLing instructions.

**3W** - Look for 3W9IL (JF3PLF), 3W9LSV (JR3LSV), 3W9TXR (JH3TXR), 3W9YAQ (JA3YAQ), XV9HS (JA6FWJ) and XV9KL (JN3JBC) to be active holiday style from Hanoi, Vietnam between 21 and 30 December. They will operate SSB, CW, RTTY and FT8 on 80-6 metres. Check [qrz.com](https://www.qrz.com) for the QSL routes.



**60** - Team 603T will be active from Somalia sometime in early 2024. Plans are to operate SSB, CW and digital modes for a couple of weeks, with a focus on the low bands and 6 metres. Details are expected in due course.



**7P** - The dates for the EI DX Group's DXpedition to Lesotho [425DXN 1689] are 19-30 March 2024. A large multi-national team will be active as 7P8EI on all bands and modes. QSL via M00XO's OQRS. More information is expected in due course.

**9A** - 9A100RKZ is the special callsign celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary since Radioklub Zagreb was founded (24 March 1924). Look for activity throughout 2024. QSL via 9A1ADE.

**9N** - Hoping for «some decent low band runs», Robert, 9N7AA has rented a bungalow over the winter period. It is located «at the edge of Kathmandu valley but much higher, with a clear shot from 270-90 degrees, and far enough not to suffer from the crazy man made noise I have in Kathmandu». He will be there on 8 December for two nights and then during «selected weekends» until the end of February. QSL via LoTW, or direct to S57DX.

**A6** - A60ND is the special callsign for the Emirates Amateur Radio Society to celebrate the UAE National Day (2 December). QSL via EA7FTR. Also expected to take part in the celebrations are the Bahrain Amateur Radio Society as A91UAE (26 November-2 December), the Saudi Amateur Radio Society as HZ1UAE (26 November-2 December), the Kuwait Amateur Radio Society as 9K9UAE (30 November-6 December), and possibly the Royal Omani Amateur Radio Society as A43UAE.

**A6** - Patrick, A65D says that «planning is underway for an IOTA activation of the UAE coastal islands [AS-021 and/or AS-124, Ed.] by a team of operators from the

Emirates Amateur Radio Society in December 2023 or January 2024». Operations are expected on most HF bands and on the QO-100 satellite, likely over two or three days. Details are expected in due course.

**A9** - Members of the Bahrain Amateur Radio Society will be active as A91CD on 12-18 December. QSL via QSL via EC6DX and LoTW. Bahrain's Commemoration Day (17 December) honours Bahraini fallen servicemen in military, civil, and humanitarian fields.

**A7** - A71QND is the special callsign for the Qatar Amateur Radio Society to celebrate Qatar National Day (18 December). Also taking part in the celebrations are the Bahrain Amateur Radio Society as A91QTR on 12-18 December, the Kuwait Amateur Radio Society as 9K9QATAR on 14-20 December, the Emirates Amateur Radio Society as A60QATAR on 18-22 December (individual operators may append a serial number to the special callsign, and be active as A60QATAR/0, A60QATAR/1, etc.).



**CE0Z** - After the unexpected death of their team leader, Marco Quijada (CE1EW) [425DXN 1698], a few of the remaining CB0ZA team members have resolved to proceed with the expedition to Robinson Crusoe Island (SA-005), Juan Fernandez. It is now their goal «to make his passion, expertise, and contribu-

tions to the team be forever remembered as the cornerstone of this - Marcos' last DXpedition project». Some changes have been made to the original plan: the new operation dates are 10-24 February 2024, the team now consists of seven experienced operators (AB5EB, AD5A, HI3R/NK4DX, N2IC, NP4G, W8HC and XQ3SK), and the new QSL manager is N2OO. Updates will be posted to <https://www.qrz.com/db/CB0ZA>, as with Marco's passing, the team is unable to access the CB0ZA website.

**CY9** - The target date for the CY9C DXpedition to St. Paul Island (NA-094) [425DXN 1668] is now late August into early September 2024. The main island is controlled



by the Canadian Wildlife Service and is off-limits; the team will once again have a helicopter available to access the smaller Northeast Island as there is no dock or landing

area for a boat. This will be an all-mode all-band «tent and generator» DXpedition with nine operators (K4ZLE, K9CT, N2IEN, N2TU, W0GJ, W0PR, W4DKS, WA4DAN and WW2DX). Updates will be posted to <https://t-rexsoftware.com/cy9c/>.

**D4** - Marcus, OE3MCS will be active as D44MCS from Sal Island (AF-086), Cape Verde on 11-22 December. He will operate SSB, CW and possibly FT8 and RTTY «holiday style from the beach» on 40-10 metres and maybe 6 metres. QSL via OE3MCS; he will upload his log to Club Log, LoTW and eQSL.



**DL** - Special callsigns DB100FK, DC100FK,

DD100FK, DF100FK, DL100FK, DM100FK, DQ100FK and

DR100FK - as well as DM100MW and

DR100PE - will be active from 1 January to 31 May to celebrate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the formation of



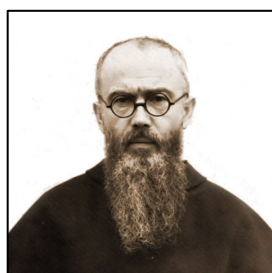
the Deutsche Funk-Kartell (24 January 1924), a federation of clubs of radio enthusiasts during the early days of amateur radio in Germany. QSL «only digital» (via LoTW, eQSL, etc). An award will be available, see <https://100fk.de/> for information.



**EA** - Celebrating Christmas and the New Year, members of Radio Club Liria (EA5RCL) will be active as EH5XMAS from 7 December to 7 January. QSL via the bureau to EA5RCL, LoTW and eQSL.



**F** - Michel, F8GGZ will be active as TM100GE on 22-31 December. QSL via the bureau. The special callsign memorializes the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the death of Gustave Eiffel (27 December 1923), the French civil engineer best known for the world-famous Eiffel Tower, built for the 1889 Universal Exposition in Paris, and his contribution to building the Statue of Liberty in New York.



**F** - Jeff, F4IIQ will be active as TM130SMK on 5-9 January to commemorate the 130<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the birth of St. Maximilian Maria Kolbe. QSL via F4IIQ. Born on 8 January 1894, Father Kolbe (SP3RN) was killed on 14 August 1941 at Auschwitz.

**F** - Michel, F8GGZ will be active as TM700MP on 5-12 January for the 700<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the death of Marco Polo, the Venetian merchant and explorer who travelled through Asia along the Silk Road (1271-1295) and gave to Europeans the first comprehensive look into China, Persia, India, Japan and other Asian countries. QSL via home call.



**FY** - Pierre-Jean, F4GPK will be active holiday style as TO2FY from Kourou, French Guiana from 29 December to 16 January. He will operate SSB only from the facilities of the local radio club (FY5KE). QSL via eQSL, or direct to home call; he does not use LoTW or Club Log.



**GW** - Kev, GW0PUH will be active as GB9KW on 2-28 January using vintage equipment manufactured by KW Electronics Ltd during the 1960s and 1970s. Main activity will be over the "KW Weekend" (6-7 January). Other special callsigns are expected to be on the air, e.g. GB2KW (Scotland), GB4KW & GB8KW (England).

**HB9** - Members of the Zurich City Police Radio Amateur Club (HB9SP) will be active as HB2OSP throughout 2024 to celebrate their club's 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary. QSOs will be uploaded to LoTW, Club Log and qrz.com; do not send any card via the bureau.

**HH** - Members of the Radio Club d'Haiti (HH2RCH) will be active as HH220Y on 1-31 January to celebrate the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary since the declaration of the former colony's independence (1 January 1804). QSL via N200.

**HK** - Members of the Liga de Radioaficionados de Medellin (HK4LRM) will be active as 5K4YTA (Youth on The Air) on 9-10 December. They will operate SSB and FT8 on 40-10 metres. QSOs will be confirmed via qrz.com.

**HR** - Alex, K6VHF will be active again as K6VHF/HR9 from Roatan Island (NA-057) on 3-10 January. This time he will be joined by Paul, NO0T and Bill, WT0DX. Plans are to operate digital modes, SSB and CW on 80-6 metres, and to participate in the ARRL RTTY Roundup (6-7 January). QSL via Club Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via home call.

**HZ** - HZ30EXPO is the special callsign for the Saudi Amateur Radio Society (HZ1SAR) to celebrate the election of Saudi Arabia as host country of World Expo 2030, which will take place in Riyadh. Look for activity from 30 November to 9 December.



**I** - Members of ARI Padova will be active as II3PUP on 7-14 January. The special callsign's suffix is an acronym for Patavium Urbs Picta (Padua the Painted City), which refers to the fourteenth-century fresco cycles that have been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage list since 2021. QSL via IQ3WW; QSOs will be uploaded to LoTW, Club Log and qrz.com.



**J8** - Gert, PA2LO will be active as J8TT from St. Vincent (NA-109) from 26 December to 5 January. He will operate SSB, CW and digital modes on 40-6 metres. QSL via Club Log's OQRS (preferred), LoTW, or via PA2LO.

**JA** - Take, JI3DST will be active again as JS6RRR from the Miyako Islands (AS-079) between 5 January and 1 April. He will be QRV also as JI3DST/6, JJ5RBH/6 and JR8YLY/6 on SSB and CW, as well as JI3DST/p, JJ5RBH/p and JR8YLY/p on FT8. QSOs will be made available for Club Log and LoTW Matching on the IOTA website.

**JD1\_oga** - Members of the Kansai Okinawa Ham Club will be active as JD1YCE from Ogasawara on 9-19 December. They will operate CW, SSB and digital modes on the HF bands and 6 metres. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS, or direct to JA3AVO.



**JD1\_oga** - Once again Harry, JG7PSJ will be active as JD1BMH from Chichijima (AS-031), Ogasawara from 23 December to 1 January. He will operate CW, SSB and RTTY on 40-10m. QSL via JD1BMH (bureau), or direct to JG7PSJ. Logsearch on <http://jg7psj.starfree.jp/jd1bmh/>. He does not use LoTW or PayPal.

**JW** - Jack, M0PLX will be active as JW/M0PLX from Spitsbergen (EU-026), Svalbard on 1-5 January. He will operate SSB on 160-10 metres. QSL via SP7DPJ and Club Log's OQRS. See <https://www.facebook.com/M0PLX> for updates.

**OE** - Christian, OE5CCN will be active as OE24BI from 1 January until 30 June from the city of Bad Ischl, one of the European Capitals of Culture for 2024. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically



via the bureau and LoTW.



**OE** - Members of the OE3XDC Radio Club will be active as OE205XMAS from 23 December to 6 January. Look for activity on 80, 40, 20, 15 and possibly 160 metres SSB and FT8, as well as via QO-100. The special callsign marks the 205<sup>th</sup> anniversary of *Stille Nacht (Silent Night)*, one of the most popular Christmas carols, composed in 1818 by Franz Xaver Gruber to lyrics by Joseph Mohr. QSL via the bureau, eQSL, or direct.

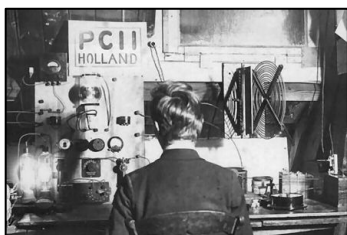


**OH** - Once again Santa Radio, OF9X (Old Father Nine Xmas) will be active on 11-31 December on all amateur radio bands CW, SSB and FT8. QSL via Club Log's OQRS, or via OH2BH. The activity is organized by Radio Club of Pusula (OH9W) and Radio Arcala (OH8X). The operating team includes Timo OH1NX, Raimo OH2BCI, Martti OH2BH, Niko OH2GEK, Arto OH2KW, Erik OH2LAK, Pekka OH2TA, Pauli OH5BQ, Anne OH2YL, Jukka OH2MA, Jorma OH2KI, Jyri OH2KM, Juha OH2LQ, Henri OH3JR, Risto OH3UU, Tapani OH5BM, Alex OH5UY/UT5UY, Veijo OH6KN, Mika OH6NVC and Esa OH8KTN.

**ON** - OR100LGE is the special callsign for members of the Radio-Club de Liege (ON5VL) to celebrate their club's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary throughout 2024. Look for activity on 160-6 metres CW, SSB, FT8 and FT4. QSL via LoTW, eQSL or via ON6YH; QSOs will also be uploaded to Club Log, with plans to enable the Live Stream feature.

**ON** - UBA Section Bruxelles-Est (ON5UB) will be active as OR79NUTS on 16-17 December to commemorate the 79<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge during World War II. The suffix of the special callsign is General Anthony C. McAuliffe's famous single-word reply in response to a surrender ultimatum. All QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau.

**PA** - Look for PC100II to be active throughout December



to celebrate the centenary of the third 2-way contact between Europe and America conducted by Henk Jesse, PCII in the Netherlands and 2AGB in the US during the night of 26-27 December 1923. QSL via Club

Log's OQRS, LoTW, or via PA1AW.

**PA** - Several PA0#MIL special stations (e.g. PA01MIL, PA02MIL, PA03MIL, etc) will be activated on 14 December starting at 17 UTC by teams consisting of one amateur and two military radio operators. They will operate SSB on the HF bands.

**PA** - Celebrating Christmas and the New Year, special callsign PH23XMAS will be active on 6-28 December, followed by PH24HNY from 28 December to 31 January. QSL cards will not be provided.

**PJ7** - Edmondo, VA3ITA will be active holiday style as PJ7/VA3ITA from Sint Maarten (NA-105) on 24-31 December. He will operate SSB and digital modes on 40-10 metres. QSL via LoTW only.

**PY** - Daniel, PT7BI and others will be active as PT7AA on 23-30 December from three World Wide Flora & Fauna sites in the Brazilian state of Ceara, namely the Coco State Park and the Environmental Protection Areas of Rio Pacoti and Sabiaguaba. They will operate SSB, CW and FT8 on 80-10 metres. All logs will be uploaded to the WWFF website: <https://wwff.co/>. [TNX PT7BI]

**PY** - Team PV6T will be active from Tinhare Island (SA-080) on 10-11 January. Look for activity on 40, 20, 15 and 10 metres SSB and FT8. QSL via PP2LA.

**PZ** - Nobu, JA0JHQ will be active as PZ5NH from Paramaribo, Suriname on 7-11 December. He will operate CW, SSB and FT8 on various bands, with main activity

during the ARRL 10-Meter Contest (9-10 December). QSL via LoTW, or direct to JA0JHQ. [TNX The Daily DX]

**SM** - SK100FRK is the special callsign celebrating the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary since Falu Radioklubb (SK4AO) was founded. Look for activity from 1 January until 31 December 2024. A very special diploma will be available – see <https://www.grz.com/db/SK100FRK>.

**SM** - SK50B is the special callsign for members of the Botkyrka Radioamatörer to celebrate their club's golden jubilee throughout 2024. The club was founded on 18 January 1974. QSL via the bureau to SK0HB.

**T32** - The Rebel DX Group will be active as T32TT from Kiritimati/Christmas Island (OC-024), East Kiribati starting

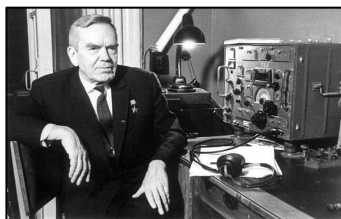

**TR** - Roland, F8EN will be active again as TR8CR from Gabon between 28 December and the end of February. He will operate CW on 30-10m. QSL via F6AJA, logsearch on <http://LesNouvellesDX.fr/voirlogs.php>. [TNX F6AJA]

**UA** - Special callsigns R120RAEM, R120A, R120D, R120I, R120K, R120M, R120N, R120R, R120S, R120T, R120W and R120X will be active on 15-25 December, particularly on 24 December for the annual RAEM Contest (<https://raem.srr.ru/ru/les/>). The special callsigns celebrate the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary since



the birth Ernst T. Krenkel (1903-1971), the legendary Arctic explorer and radioman (callsign RAEM) on various polar stations and on the first drifting ice station North Pole-1. See <https://hamlog.online/club/srr/997/> for the certificate.



**UA** - Special callsigns R2024NY and UE24NY will be active from 30 December to 8 January for the annual "Russian New Year" radio marathon organized by the Miller DX Club. QSLs via RQ7L.

**UA\_ant** - A member of the 69<sup>th</sup> Russian Antarctic Expedition, Igor, RQ8K will be stationed at Progress Station, Antarctica until the end of April 2025. In his spare time he is active as RI1ANE.

**V4** - Once again John, W5JON will be active as V47JA from St. Kitts (NA-104) on 9-18 December. He will operate SSB and FT8 on the HF bands and 6 metres. QSL via LoTW, or direct only to W5JON. [TNX NG3K]

**V5** - Eric, F5LCX will be active as V5/F5LCX from Na-



mibia from 28 December to 11 January. This will be a family trip, and he plans to operate both mobile and fixed for a few hours on a daily basis, probably during his evening hours. QSL via LoTW.



**VK** - Andrey, VK5MAV will be active as VK5MAV/4 from Magnetic Island (OC-171) on 6-11 February. He will operate mainly CW, with possibly some SSB (sked) on 40, 20, 15, and 10 metres. QSOs will be uploaded to Club Log, and made available for QSO matching (free of charge) on the IOTA website one month after the activity. Those who make more than two QSOs, however, will get the Club Log Matching six months later, as Andrey would like «to give a chance of new IOTA to as many IOTA chasers as possible». Paper QSLs will be available only for those who donate USD 10 or more before the operation.

**VK\_ant** - Norbert, VK5MQ was active as VK0AI from Macquarie Island between late April 2018 and late March 2019. He is now using the same callsign from Casey Station, Antarctica, as time permits. On 25-26 December he was briefly active from a deep-field camp established at Edgeworth David Base in the Bungar Hills, 450 kilometres west of Casey. QSL via home call.

**VP9** - Look for Paul, VP9KF to be active again from Bermuda (NA-005) on 8-22 January. He will operate CW only on 160-10 metres, and will participate in the North American QSO Party (<https://ncjweb.com/naqp/>) QSL direct to Paul Evans, 15 Watch Knob Lane, Swannanoa NC 28778, USA. **VU4** - Krish, W4VKU will be active as VU4N from the Andaman Islands (AS-001) on 16-27 December. He plans to be QRV on the HF bands and 6m SSB and FT8 using MSHV on non-standard frequencies. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS (direct and bureau), or direct to W4VKU.

**VU7** - Krish, W4VKU will be active as VU7A from Agatti (AS-011), Lakshadweep Islands on 4-13 December. He plans to be QRV on the HF bands and 6 metres SSB and FT8. QSL via LoTW, Club Log's OQRS (direct and bureau), or direct to W4VKU.

**W** - He cannot provide specific dates, however Matt, AF2F will be visiting Long Beach Island (NA-111) «quite frequently on business throughout the month of December, probably extending into January with a week-long break for holidays». **W** - Brad, N9EN will be active again as W4A on 16-18 December, commemorating the birthdate of Edwin H. Armstrong, the electrical engineer and inventor who developed FM radio and the superheterodyne receiver sys-

tem. He will operate CW only on 160-10 metres. QSL via home call, direct or bureau.

**W** - Club station W2HRU will be QRV on 1-6 January to mark the 25<sup>th</sup> annual Ham Radio University educational conference. Look for SSB activity on 80, 40 and 20 metres, as well as FT8 on multiple bands. QSL via LoTW, eQSL, the W2 QSL Bureau or direct to KA2D. In addition, a printable QSL Certificate will be available. **W** - The Straight Key Century Club's annual on-air event, commemorating the club's founding in 2006 and celebrating the original instruments of early radiotelegraphy (straight key, bug and cootie keys), will run on 2-31 January. **XW** - Vincent, F4BKV (one of the XW4DX team members) is still in Laos and will remain there for some time. He is QRV as XW4KV on 15 and 10 metres FT8 and SSB. 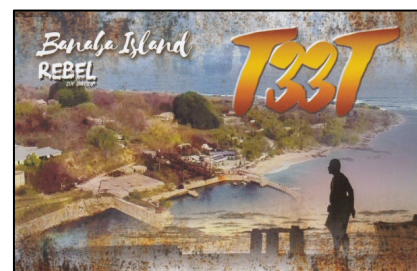
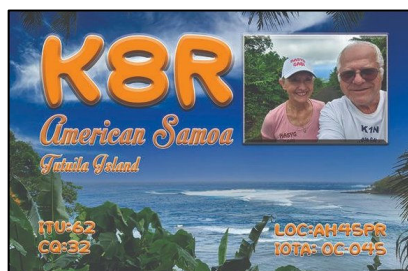
## WORLD WIDE AWARD 2024

## 3Y0K: BOUVET ISLAND 2025



Team 3Y0K will be active from Bouvet Island (AN-002) in January 2025.

- All permits and contracts are in hand. In particular, a contract for 30 days around the island has been signed with a ship owner with proven experience in Arctic and Antarctic waters.
- Plans are for three operators (LA7GIA, WD5COV and DL8JJ) to stay on Bouvet for up to 21 days, assisted by a support crew of four people: «our landing plans have been optimized, and given our previous experience in landing we have a mature and realistic plan to go onshore that again will be a staged landing». This will be a lightweight DXpedition, but will still include

five stations for the local operators, some yagis and amplifiers.

- In addition to the on-site operators, there will be a remote team. AA7JV will design, test, and provide four remote radios that will be accessible via Starlink to any operator worldwide. The search for remote FT modes operators is underway. Candidates should have experience with DXpeditions, and preferably with remote operations. They should be willing to dedicate some of their time to remote operations, and be committed to operating like any other on-site operator as part of the Bouvet team. Remote operators are being sought from around the world in different time zones. They will be subject to a smaller operator fee. For more information, please send your experience and motivation to Ken, LA7GIA (ken-neth@opskar.no).
- In addition to the main camp at Cape Fie, a «dedicated North America camp» will be set up on the top of a small hill 600 metres away. This area «offers low angle take off to NA and will make our signals much louder all over NA compared to previous time». The purpose is for «one operator to run multiple radios – one CW/SSB and one FT8 – and work NA on dedicated frequencies».
- The fundraising for 3Y0K has started. The budget is USD 440,000, with 67% already secured; an additional USD 150,000 in support is needed, «which is significantly less than all previous DXpeditions to Bouvet».
- James Gallo, KB2FMH will be the Media Officer and WW Pilot; Charles Wilmott, M0OXO will once again fulfil his role as QSL Manager.

**4W8X** • The DXpedition shut down for good on 4 December at 04:59 UTC. As for Club Log and OQRS, «we tried our best to find all missing contacts», DL6FBL says. «If you still miss contacts with 4W8X, please use the contact form on our website (<http://www.timor-leste-dx.de/about/contact.php>) to let us know. Despite our huge networking problems, please note that our callsign 4W8X has been pirated every now and then. Thus it might have happened that you didn't work us, but the pirate(s). However, if you once 'saw' your contact in Club Log, and later it had disappeared, of course we should know that and have a look again». As for EME contacts, «there is an issue between Club Log and LotW», and they are working on it.

**CONTEST UNIVERSITY 2024** • Registration is now open for the 2024 Contest University (CTU), to be held on 16 May at the Hope Hotel near Dayton, Ohio. This is the day before the Dayton Hamvention officially opens. See <https://www.contestuniversity.com/> for the details.



**CQ DX MARATHON** • The CQ DX Marathon is a year-long DX hunt, with participants competing to see who can work the greatest number of countries ("entities") and CQ zones during the calendar year. The 2024 edition will start at 00.00 UTC on 1 January and will end at 23.59 UTC on 31 December. See <https://dxmarathon.com/rules/2024/> for the rules. Participants in the 2023 DX Marathon must send their entries by 5 January 2024, preferably using the new online submission tool.



**CQ MAGAZINE** • Reportedly, *CQ Amateur Radio* magazine has temporarily suspended publication. The latest issue sent out was the digital version of the October issue (Volume 79 Number 10). In a message circulated over the Internet, Richard Moseson (W2VU, Editor of *CQ Amateur Radio*) says that «everything is unfortunately on hold» until «the necessary funding to continue operations» is secured. The CQ Contests will continue to be run by the World Wide Radio Operators Foundation (WWROF). As for the DX Marathon, the Programme «will remain viable with or without CQ magazine», because it «does not receive any financial support from them, nor do we draw any resources to operate our program from them», Mark Wohlschlegel (WC3W) states.





**EARLY ANNOUNCEMENT: PACIFIC TOUR** • Hrane, YT1AD and a large team will be active from Fiji (3D2AD), Samoa (5W8A) and Tokelau between 7 February and 1 March 2024. Main activity will be as ZK3M (or maybe ZK3A, as in 2019) from Tokelau (OC-048) on 15-25 February. **POSTAL RATES (DENMARK)** • Effective 1 January 2024, Post Danmark will implement a major postage rate increase. The rate for letters up to 100 grams to all international destinations will be 50.00 Danish Kroner - that's more than 7 US dollars, so keep that in mind if you need to request a direct card from a Danish station.

**QSL E51JAN** • «Probably I will be out of Poland from January until May 2024», Janusz, SP9FIH says. «I will confirm direct OQRS requests received before Christmas, but those received later will wait until the end of May». Operating from Manihiki (OC-014), North Cook Islands, E51JAN made nearly 27,000 QSOs between 12 October and 7 November.
