EQUATORIAL GUINEA ---> Last week, the Government of Equatorial Guinea temporarily suspended all amateur radio licenses. This decision follows the revelation of a case involving a foreign amateur radio operator who gained

access to sensitive areas with unauthorized equipment. The authorities are committed to establishing a new regulatory framework that guarantees effective control over the use of telecommunications frequencies and equipment, in accordance with national security requirements. The information was reported on 10 September by AhoraEG (https://ahoraeg.com/).
