- While waiting to depart for Annobon Island (AF-039) [425DXN 1788], YL2GM and EA5EL have been active as 3C3W from Bioko Island (AF-010), Equatorial Guinea since 1 September.
 - It has turned out that there are not only ferry services to Annobon, but also irregular flights. Their plan is therefore to be QRV from Bioko until 5 September, and then fly to Annobon (3COW) on the following day barring changes to their flight schedule.
