"There is a forecasted WX window Saturday and Sunday, and if that holds, we will be off air. The wind is still quite strong, around 40 knots, but is expected to decrease. If weather does not permit full extraction, we will remain on air for some more days, as next window maybe Tuesday (uncertain)".

CASS AWARDS ---> The Cass Awards honour the wisdom and spirit of Cass WA6AUD (SK), and encourage DXpeditions to maximize the number of DXers worked with a Plaque for the single-operator DXpedition that works the most unique call-signs within 2 weeks or less, and a Plaque for the "unlimited" DXpedition that works the most unique callsigns within 4 weeks or less, with no limit on the number of operators of the activity.

THE HERITAGE CQ AMATEUR RADIO HALL OF FAME ---> The CQ Amateur Radio Hall of Fame was established in January 2001 to recognize those individuals, whether licensed radio amateurs or not, who significantly affected the course of amateur radio; and radio amateurs who, in the course of their professional lives, had a significant impact on their professions or on world affairs. Following the discontinuation of CQ Magazine, the Heritage CQ Amateur Radio Hall of Fame continues its mission under the stewardship of Hamgallery. Starting in 2025, physical plaques are presented to living inductees, and annual inductions are limited to three individuals, all of whom must hold an amateur radio license.
