- HF0 - Rafal, SQ40 is a member of the 50th Polish Antarctic Expedition to the Henryk Arctowski Station on King George Island, South Shetland Islands (AN-010). He will be working there from May to October, and in his spare time he will be QRV as HF0PAS on the HF bands (SSB and CW) and 6 metres (FT8). QSL route TBA.

- UA - A very large number of Russian stations using the special prefix RP81 (where the letter P stands for 'pobeda', i.e. 'victory') will be QRV on 1-9 May to mark the 81st anniversary of the end of World War II.
