<<< H40AA, TEMOTU ISLANDS >>>
<<< A NEW DXCC ENTITY >>>

The new DXCC criteria will become effective on 31 March 1998. The Temotu Islands, located in the South Pacific, collectively form the easternmost province of the Solomon Islands, an independent country since 1978. Because Temotu is separated by more than 350 km from the rest of the Solomon Islands, it should easily qualify as a new DXCC entity. The South China Sea DX Team (SCSDXT) has teamed with the Solomon Islands' IARU member organization, SIRS (Solomon Islands Radio Society), in organizing a full-scale DXpedition to Temotu, as well as preparing the application for new DXCC status.

Team members H44GP, H44GR, JA5DQH, N4GN, N7NG, OH0XX, OH1RY, OH2BC, OH2BE, OH2BH, OH2TA, W6OSP and 9V1YC will begin arriving on 21 March and may be found on the air using their individual H44 call signs (QSL via their respective home calls) while making final preparations for the main event. These early operations, which will include all-band activity in the CQ WW WPX SSB Contest (27-28 March) - will count for DXCC credit as the Solomon Islands, under the current rules.

At 23.59 UTC on 31 March, the team will starting operating as H40AA (please note that the Solomon telecommunications authorities have agreed to assign the previously unused H40 prefix to Temotu for all future amateur operations). At this point QSOs will count for Temotu DXCC credit, presuming the application for new DXCC status is eventually approved.

The H40AA operation will continue for approximately two weeks on the following frequencies: 1.824, 3.504, 7.004, 10.104, 14.024, 18.074, 21.024, 24.894, 28.024 and 50.104 MHz CW; 1.824, 3.775, 7.045, 14.195, 18.135, 21.295, 24.945, 28.495 and 50.104 MHz SSB; 14.083 and 21.083 MHz RTTY. Internet log search capability is likely to be made available a few weeks AFTER the operation. QSL H40AA via OH2BN either direct (Jarmo J. - 3D2 - The last stop of the OK DX Foundation's Pacific trip is confirmed to take place from Viti Levu (OC-016), Fiji Islands between 24 March and 1 April [425DXN 355]. Operators OK1TN, OK1KT and OK1VD will be joined by OK1CF and OK1DWC and will be active as 3D2KT and 3D2TN. The side trip to Rotuma has been cancelled. QSL via OKDX Foundation, P.O. - 5W - The cancellation of their Tongatapu operation (see A3 below) caused OK1TN, OK1KT and OK1VD to start their activity from Western Samoa (OC-097) earlier than planned [425DXN 355]. - A3 - The OKDX Foundation operation from Tongatapu (A35KT and A35TN), previously scheduled between 5 and 14 March [425DXN 355], has been cancelled because the operators could not get their visa. <TNX OM3JW>
- JD1_min- Mako, JD1BIY is currently active (6-160 metres, CW and SSB) from Minami Torishima (OC-073) and plans to operate on 160 metres on 15 March: look for him 1907.5 and 1912.5 (he will be listening down). <TNX The Daily DX>
- KH1 - Due to possible worsening seas which might slow their travel to Johnston, the Captain of the SS Midway decided to pick the team up one day early. So the night between 8 and 9 March (KH1 time) was the

last of the operations from Howland for this trip. QSL K4AU/WH1 via K4AU, QSL WA4FFW/NH1 via WA4FFW. <TNX KH7U>

- KH3 - There the possibility that N4BQW, WA4FFW, NH6UY, K4AU and N4DAZ will be able to activate the club station at Johnston Island for whatever time they have between their arrival from Howland (see KH1 above) and their departure from Johnston. In his latest report Kimo Chun, KH7U stated that the team is likely to arrive in the local afternoon of 15 March (very early morning UTC of the 16th). The "current" countries are now 328 and the deleted are 58. The "deleted country" concept will come to an end when the new DXCC 2000 rules are implemented, that is on 31 March 1998. According to the new rules, no new countries will be added to the deleted list in the future. Deleted "entities" simply will be removed.
