Several stations participating in the International Lighthouse/Lighthsip Weekend (18-19 August) will be operating from IOTA islands: just to name a few, 7S6LGT (EU-043), 7S6TL (EU-043), 8S6LGT (EU-043), 8S6LL (EU-043), CU8AS (EU-089), GB1SL (EU-124), GC4BRS/p (EU-124), LA1G (EU-061), SK2AU (EU-135), VK2LSB/4 (OC-137), VK3ILH/7 (OC-233), ZS1RBI (AF-064). DPOMSM ---> This is the official callsign of the amateur radio club station on board the "Maria S. Merian", a German research vessel that is currently voyaging from Longyearyben (Svalbard) to Kiel (Germany). The crew includes four licenced amateurs (Frank/DJ3FR, Martin/DL7ARY, Hermann/DH1HP and Steffen/DF1MSM). DPOMSM can be used only when the ship is outside the 12-mile belt of territorial waters, otherwise the crew members have to use their personal callsigns /mm.
