Gioia Marconi Braga, the younger daughter of Guglielmo Marconi, died at 80 years of age in New York on 15 July. During her lifetime she actively promoted scientific and cultural relations between the United States and Italy, and in 1974 she founded the Marconi International Fellowship Foundation to commemorate the centennial of her father's birth.
