3B8 - Ron, SM7DKF will be active holiday style as 3B8/SM7DKF from Mauritius Island (AF-049) on 10-23 November. QSL via home call, Further information and QSLling policy at <http://www.sm7dkf.se>. [TNX www.rsgbiota.org]



3X - This year the VooDoo Contest Group will participate in the CQ WW DX CW Contest as 3X5A from Conakry, Guinea. The team will include AA7A, G3SXW, G4BWP, G4IRN, GM3YTS, K4UEE, K5VT

and KC7V. As usual, they will enter the Multi-Multi category with mono-band antennas for all six bands and kilowatt amplifiers.
