





- Azores CQ8, CR1, CR2
- Madeira CQ3, CQ9, CR3

Foreign amateurs who go and operate under a CEPT licence will have to use CT7/homecall from Portugal, CT8/homecall from the Azores and CT9/homecall from Madeira.
