3B9 - Eric, OE4AAC will be active holiday style as 3B9/OE4AAC from Rodrigues Island (AF-017) on 10-18 February. He will operate only CW. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. Logsearch on Club Log. [TNX NG3K]
