

# DX INFORMATION

**3D2** - Aki, JA1NLX will be active as 3D2YA from Mana Island (OC-121), Fiji on 3-9 October. He will operate mainly CW on 30-10 metres. QSL via JA1NLX (direct only) and LoTW. An OQRS for direct and bureau cards will be available at Club Log (bureau cards will be sent through Global QSL).

**4K** - Dmytro, UT6UA and Alex, UT5UAS will be active as 4K/UT6UA and 4K/UT5UAS from Azerbaijan (grid LN30gk) between 16 and 20 June. They will concentrate on working EME on 144 MHz (main mode JT65). QSL information on [www.qrz.com/db/ut6ua](http://www.qrz.com/db/ut6ua). Boris, 4K4K and Mamuka, 4L2M will join them and the team will be active on the HF bands (except 80m) as 4J0K and 4K3K. The QSL route for contacts made on the HF bands is via RW6HS. [TNX RW6HS]

**FK** - The website for the TX4A DXpedition to Matthew Island (OC-218) [425DXN 1198] is now up and running at <http://tx4a.yolasite.com>. Cezar (VE3LYC) will be joined by Bob (KD1CT), as PA3EXX is no longer available for the trip. They plan to be active from the island for four days between 1 and 9 September, and to maintain one station on the air around the clock, operating on 40-10 metres CW and SSB. The team will meet in Noumea two days before leaving to the island. Sailing is supposed to take 2-3 days each way, depending on wind and currents. Dan, W4DKS (dan.sullivan[@]verizon.net) will be the pilot station for the operation. QSL via VE3LYC, direct or bureau; logsearch and OQRS on Club Log. This will be a very difficult and very expensive project. The team is looking for financial support from groups and individuals who wish to assist in defraying some of the costs. 


