



DX INFORMATION

3B8 - Paul, HB9ARY will be active as 3B8/HB9ARY from Mauritius Island (AF-049) until 18 August. He operates SSB and some CW on 40, 20, 17, 15, 12 and 10 metres. QSL direct to NI5DX. [TNX The Daily DX]

3D2_rot - Tony, 3D2AG was expected to be active from Rotuma between late July and early August [425DXN 1212]. However, the trip was cancelled because of bad weather on the island and unavailability of flights, and it has been postponed to 12-26 September. Tony will be QRV in his spare time as 3D2AG/p on 40-6 metres SSB and CW using a solar powered station with 3-element Yagi and inverted V. QSL direct to 3D2AG (see qrz.com).

40 - Alex, US0KW will be active as 40/US0KW from Budva, Montenegro from 24 August to 4 September. He will operate CW and RTTY on the HF bands. QSL via home call. [TNX US0KW]

40 - Look for Chab, 40/YT7WA and Boris, 40/YU7MW to be active from Kotor, Montenegro on 9-18 September. They will concentrate their operations on PSK. [TNX YT7WA]

4S - This year the Radio Society of Sri Lanka's annual activity during the International Lighthouse Lightship Weekend (16-17 August) will take place from Point Pedro Lighthouse, on the extreme northern tip of the main island (AS-003). Look for 4S7LGT to be QRV on the HF bands CW and SSB. QSL via bureau. [TNX 4S7JL]

4W - James, 9V1YC and Wibert, PE7T are active as 4W/N1YC (QSL via W5UE with OQRS on <http://w5ue.net/qsq-w5ue-logsrch.html>, and LoTW) and 4W/PE7T (QSL via bureau to home call, and LoTW) from Timor Leste (OC-148) until 26 August. They operate CW and SSB on 80-10 metres.

SSB and RTTY from 22 March to 1 April, including an entry in the CQ WPX SSB Contest. [TNX The Daily DX]

9A - Look for Marco, 9A/IZ3GNG e Joris, 9A/IZ3QHA will be active from Krk Island (EU-136) on 19-25 August. They will operate SSB and digital modes. All of the QSOs will be confirmed automatically via the bureau. [TNX IZ3GNG]

9A - Jan, PA4JJ will be active holiday style as 9A/PA4JJ from Porec (Croatian mainland) on 7-19 September. Expect him to operate mainly digital modes. QSL via home call (OQRS on www.pa4jj.nl). [TNX PA4JJ]

9H - Jose, EA5IDQ will be active holiday style as 9H3JA from Malta on 18-25 September. He will operate SSB and digital modes on 40-10 metres. QSL via home call, direct or bureau (OQRS on Club Log). [TNX NG3K]

A2 - Once again Gert, ZS6AYU will be active holiday style as A25GF from Botswana on 1-3 September. This time he will operate CW on 6 metres only; look for him on 50097 kHz between 13 and 19 UTC. QSL via ZS6AYU.
