3B7 - Pat, 3B8FA will be active as 3B7FA from St Brandon (AF-015) on 26-31 October. In his spare time he will operate mainly digital modes (SSTV and PSK 93) on 20, 15 and 10 metres. QSL via home call. [TNX 3B8FA]

3B8 - Willi, DJ7RJ will be active as 3B8/DJ7RJ from Mauritius Island (AF-049) on 5-30 October. He will operate CW and SSB on 160-10 metres, with a focus on 160m. QSL via home call (direct). [TNX AA1M]





GOOD TO KNOW

5N1UKO/5U • On 23 April 2015 5N1UKO was active as 5N1UKO/5U and made 31 QSOs on 15 metres SSB, operating "from his mobile setup at a construction site in Zindar, Niger".
