DX INFORMATION

3B8 - Paul, HB9ARY will be active holiday style as 3B8HC from Mauritius Island (AF-049) from 23 January to 8 February. He will operate slow CW and SSB on 80-10 metres, with a focus on 80m. QSL via NI5DX (direct only).

3B8 - Eric, OE4AAC will be active holiday style as 3B8HD from Mauritius Island (AF-049) from 11 February to 1 March. He will operate mainly CW on the HF bands. QSL via home call, direct or bureau. Logsearch and OQRS on Club Log.

3D2 - Hardy, DF6PW will be active holiday style as 3D2PW (requested call) from Mango Bay (Viti Levu, OC-016), Fiji on 13-19 February. He will operate CW with a focus on 30, 17 and 12 metres. QSL via bureau to DF6PW and LoTW. [TNX DX World]






